TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue their first series of the season with the Erie SeaWolves, the team's play three 6-game series' this season against the 'Wolves.

LAST TIME OUT: The Curve swatted a season-best 5 home runs in an 11-5 win over Erie.

A GOOD DAY FOR THE STICKS: Altoona set season-highs in runs, hits, runs in an inning, hits in an inning, home runs in a game and in an inning in an 11-5 win over Erie on May 23. With a six-run second inning, Altoona cruised to their second straight win, just the second time this season (April 9/10) they have won back-to-back wins. Both **Dustin Peterson** and **Joe Perez** finished a triple shy of the cycle.

SULLY DOMINATES: Righty Sean Sullivan has picked up right where he left off in 2023 in the Curve rotation. Sullivan has tossed 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings (5/7 - Present) after firing six scoreless frames at Erie on May 22. In his time with Altoona he has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 19-of-29 starts and his 2.66 ERA ranks 10th in the Eastern League, he´also ranks 9th in WHIP (1.11).

BEER'S ALL AROUND: Infielder Seth Beer has been one of the Curve's most consistent hitters this season. Beer's 12-game on-base streak came to an end on May 21 at Erie, during which he batted: .326/.397/.419 with 2 2B and 1 3B.

NO HITS FOR YOU: Since joining the Curve, right-hander Thomas Harrington has tossed 7.0 no-hit innings and struck out 9 batters with just 1 walk. Harrington is ranked as one of the top prospects in the Pirates organization, ranking in the top-6 in both Baseball America and MLB Pipeline's pre-season lists. He joined the Curve after missing the first month of the season with right shoulder

WHAT A FELLOW: Righty Drake Fellows has become one of Altoona's most reliable arms since arriving from Greensboro. He's recorded a 1.69 ERA (3 ÉR / 16.0 IP) in his 4 outings, 2 starts with 16 strikeouts.

A GOOD START TO THE WEEK: Altoona starting pitchers turned in a brilliant start to their week in Akron as Braxton Ashcraft, and Sean Sullivan each spun seven scoreless innings. Combined, Curve starters have recorded a 3.33 ERA (10 ER / 27.0 IP) with just 16 hits allowed, and 26 K's.

A 'CRAFT FIT TO CARRY THE CURVE: Right-hander Braxton Ashcraft turned in the team's best performance in recent memory with a career-best 7.0 scoreless innings with 10 strikeouts against the Akron RubberDucks on May 14. Ashcraft set career-high's in innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (10), his 10 K's were the most by a Curve pitcher since May 2, 2023 when **Kyle Nicolas** struck out 10 Richmond Flying Squirrels. Ashcraft had 14.2 consecutive scoreless inning streak end in his last outing.

Entering play on Tuesday, May 21, Ashcraft is fourth in MiLB in swinging strike percentage (total number of whiffs divided by pitches thrown, 16.3 percent) and has the fifth-lowest walk rate among MiLB pitchers (3.4 percent) with at least 30.0 innings pitched.

NOWHERE TO GO BUT UP: Entering play on Friday, May 24, Altoona has the worst record among professional baseball teams with an 12-30 record. The Curve were the last team in the affiliated minors to win 10 games.

Altoona's 12-30 start is the worst record for the club through 42 games in franchise history, surpassing the 2009 Curve who started the season 14-28. The 5 wins in the month of April were the fewest for the team in a calendar month in which they played at least 15

POWER OUTAGE: Altoona's 27 home runs hit through 42 games ranks T-24th among 30 Double-A teams.

THE 'WOLVES OF THE SEA: Gabe Alvarez helms the SeaWolves for a third straight year, after leading them to an Eastern League Championship in 2023 where they defeated Somerset. Top Tigers prospects on their roster according to MLB Pipleline include: No. 1 RHP Jackson Jobe (IL), No. 10 RHP Troy Melton, No. 13 INF Hao-Yu Lee, No. 27 RHP Tyler Mattison and OF No. 30 Trei Cruz.

THE FIRST HOWLER: Austin Bergner takes the ball on Friday night for Erie. Bergner has shifted back to the rotation after working as a reliever in 2023. Bergner was Detroit's 9th round selection in 2019 out of the University of North Carolina and has recorded a 3.15 ERA in 50 games, 24 starts for the SeaWolves since the 2022 season. The Windermere, Fla. native was considered the No. 1 RHP prospect in Florida according to Perfect Game, he played with USA Baseball from 2014-16 where he was a Pan-Am Champion and World Cup Champion. Austin's father, Mark, played professional beach volleyball and coached volleyball at Duke.


