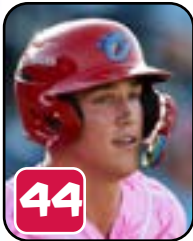

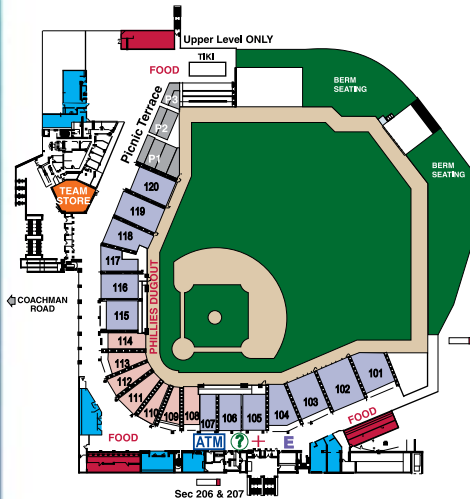

BAYCARE BALLPARK INFORMATION



FIRST AID

The First Aid office is located on the first base side of the main concourse behind section 106. Guests can either report to this office or contact an usher if in need of medical assistance.

FOOD AND DRINK POLICY

No food, bottles, coolers or cans may be brought into the ballpark. The Threshers reserve the right to search any medical or diaper bags entering the ballpark.

FOUL BALLS

Any foul ball hit into the stands may be kept. Guests are not permitted on the field or to reach into the playing area. Foul balls may be dangerous, so please be alert at all times and aware of the potential hazards.

GATES OPEN

Ballpark gates will open one hour prior to scheduled game time.

HANDICAPPED SEATING

Disabled seating is available all throughout the ballpark. Limited wheelchair seating is available through the ticket office in person or on the telephone. One companion seat is available for purchase with each wheelchair space. An elevator is available for disabled use on the first base side of the stadium (South Parking Lot). Drop-off is available on the West Side of the ballpark (no elevator access here). Please contact an usher for assistance entering and exiting the ballpark.

KIDS ZONE

The left-field concourse features a playground and Kids Zone for our younger guests.

LOST AND FOUND

Located at Customer Service behind Section 106.

SENIOR TICKETS

Seniors 55+ may purchase discounted tickets.

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited in most areas of the ballpark. Special smoking sections are marked. Smoking is permitted only at the Tiki Pavilion in left field. For resources to help quit smoking, call 1-877-U-CAN-NOW (1-877-822-6669).

TEAM STORE

The Threshers Team Store, Diamond Outfitters, is located next to the ballpark's west entry, and features hats, apparel and collectibles to satisfy Threshers fans of all ages. Merchandise available 24 hours a day on-line at ThreshersBaseball.com.

TIKI PAVILION

The Frenchy's Tiki Pavilion is located beyond the left field wall. It features a variety of mixed drinks, beer and wine for guests 21 and over. Seats in this section are first-come, first-serve during Threshers season.

WEAPONS

Firearms, weapons, knives, tasers and other dangerous or hazardous devices or substances (collectively "weapons") are prohibited at BayCare Ballpark, unless carried by an on-duty police officer or otherwise expressly approved by The Threshers. Anyone bringing such a weapon to the premises must return it to their vehicle immediately.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

PA and video board announcements can be arranged for a nominal fee by visiting Guest Services behind Section 106 before the end of the second inning.

ATM

The ATM is located on the first base side of the concourse behind section 105.

BAGS & BACKPACKS

Bags can be no larger than 16"x16"x8" and will be subject to inspection upon entry in accordance with Major League Baseball security regulations. Guests may discard or return the prohibited items to their vehicle.

BATS

Full-size baseball bats are prohibited from entry by guests to the ballpark.

BERM SEATING

Berm seating is limited and ticketed. Blankets are permitted to be brought into the park for berm seating. Chairs, folding chairs, camp chairs, and the like, are not permitted to be brought into the park.

CHILD TICKETS

Children 13 and younger qualify for the child's ticket price. For children 4 and younger, please see the BayCare Box Office or a ballpark gate attendant for a complimentary ticket.

CUSTOMER SERVICE & ADVANCE TICKETS

The Customer Service/Advance Tickets window is located on the first base side of the main concourse behind Section 106. Guests can report problems, check for lost and found items and claim prizes at this location. Tickets for future games may also be purchased here.

Resides: Santa Rosa Beach, FL... Former pitcher. Entering his fifth year in the Phillies organization and his first as a manager. Joined the Phillies player development staff midseason in 2022 as bullpen coach/assistant pitching coach for Lehigh Valley (AAA) and rehab pitching coordinator.

Had the responsibilities of minor league complex pitching coordinator added to his title for the 2024 and 2025 seasons. Originally selected by the Washington Nationals in the ninth round of the June 2010 draft out of the University of Mississippi, where he earned a bachelor's degree in liberal arts. Pitched 11 seasons, including parts of four in the majors with Washington (2014-15 & 2019-20), before ending his career with Lehigh Valley in 2022.

SHAWN WILLIAMS BENCH COACH

Born: Salt Lake City, UT

Resides: Palm Harbor, FL... Former infielder. Debut season as Threshers bench coach. Named the Florida Complex League (R) manager in 2023, his fifth managerial stop in the Phillies system. Returned as FCL manager 2024-25.

Previously served as manager for Reading (AA, 2019-22), Clearwater (A, 2017-18) and Lakewood (A, 2015-16) after joining the Phillies player development staff in 2014 as

manager for Williamsport (A). Also spent April 2014 as a fill-in bullpen catcher for the Phillies. Served as a player/coach for Williamsport in 2013. Played four seasons (2007-10) in Tampa Bay's minor league system and also played independently in the American Association (2006), Can Am League (2010-11) and Atlantic League (2010 & 2012). His father, Jimmy Williams, managed the Toronto Blue Jays, Houston Astros and Boston Red Sox and was the Phillies bench coach for two years (2007-08).

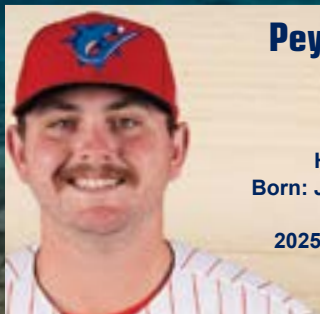

HOW TO KEEP SCORE

Scoring Basics...

Different fans have different methods of keeping a scorecard, and many use their own notations. But here's a simple method...

If the hitter grounds out to shortstop, for example, write in "6-3," which shows the shortstop threw him out at first base. If the hitter flies out to left field, write a "7."

If the batter gets a hit, write in the hit according to which base he reached. Each corner of the box represents a base, with the lower-right corner being first.

If he singles, put a "-" in the lower right. If he doubles, write a "-" in the upper right, and so on. For a walk, use "BB" in the lower right. As the runner advances, mark the appropriate symbol in the appropriate corner.

If a runner scores, put a circle at the bottom of the box, and inside the circle put the symbol of the play and/or the player that drove him in. For example, if the No. 5 hitter drives in two runs with a single, mark his single in the bottom right of his box and mark a circle with the number "5" in it in the boxes of the runners who score (Some people like to use uniform numbers here, so you can tell who did what, even after lineup changes).

At the end of each inning, total the hits and runs for that inning only. At the end of the game you'll be able to add the innings total to get the game score.

Player Spotlight: Tanner Gresham

Tanner Gresham's Experience as a Military Police Officer and Pitcher

For more than two centuries, the United States Military Academy at West Point has developed the leaders of our nation's armed forces. The school known as Army also contends within Division I athletics and has one of the best baseball programs in the Patriot League. The team has won 13 baseball championships in the conference, more than any other team since the Patriot League Tournament was first held in 1993.

From 2018-2024, the Army Black Knights won six-straight Patriot League titles, and Threshers' right-hander Tanner Gresham was a part of four of those championships between 2021-2024. Signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Phillies in 2024, Gresham had to wait over a year to make his professional debut as a pitcher due to mandatory service that is required for all West Point graduates.

Now entrenched as a professional pitcher, Gresham gave us an inside scoop on what it's like to try and become a professional athlete with some military responsibilities as well.

Like many young American children, Gresham was introduced to baseball at an early age, beginning with tee ball at age three. His brother, who is two years older, was in a league and their father made sure Tanner was able to play with his older siblings. Kris Gresham, Tanner's father, was intent on getting his kids into baseball at a young age, as he had an eight-year career in the minor leagues as a catcher after being drafted by the Orioles in 1991. Though Tanner started out as an infielder, he had an excellent receiver whenever he wanted to pitch or play catch.

"That's pretty much how I learned how to pitch," said Gresham of playing baseball with his father while growing up. "He would always get back there and do as best as he could to try and teach me about pitching. Even now, when I'm home during the offseason, he'll still get behind the plate for a few pitches."

Tanner's father will turn 56 in August but still makes time to be his son's favorite bullpen and catch partner. In high school, Gresham played shortstop and pitched, maintaining a .340 average at Hopewell HS in North Carolina. As good as he was at the plate, his arm began to stand out as he was recruited to play college ball.

At a fall tournament in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, in Gresham's junior season of high school, West Point's pitching coach saw him in a travel ball game at shortstop, but after he saw him pitch, Gresham got a call the next day to set up a recruiting visit to West Point. Gresham had military history in his family,

as his beloved grandfather was a member of the Marine Corps. Initially, Gresham was much more focused on his baseball future than a potential one in the military, but he was warming up to that possibility as he met Army's coaching staff and took a visit to West Point's campus.

"My grandfather was a Marine for 21 years, so the military lifestyle was always a huge part of my family," said Gresham of the military influence on his upbringing. "Just being around him my whole life growing up, he taught me the right way to act, the right way to treat other people. I think once the introduction of West Point came around, I thought that this is something I could pursue." He ended up committing to West Point, in some ways, as a tribute to his late grandfather, who passed in 2013, but also because working in the military would help set him up for his life after baseball.

“I had a few Division I and Division II offers, and I think what separated it was the fact that West Point could pretty much set me up for the next 40 years of my life rather than the next ten,” said Gresham of his decision to commit to West Point and its required military service. The advice of his parents and his instant chemistry with the coaching staff certainly helped, but Gresham felt that Army was the best choice for him to set up his baseball future, and that of his eventual life after baseball.

One of the most distinct aspects of West Point is the discipline instilled in every student, athlete, and cadet who attends the US Military Academy. There was a strict schedule that began with a 6 a.m. wake up. Breakfast was also mandatory, beginning at 7 a.m. and going until classes started 45 minutes later. Classes would go until 3:30 PM, and then the student athletes would begin practicing. Gresham added that some baseball practices wouldn’t even begin until 8 p.m. Through it all, it was that discipline that has helped Gresham most in his transition to professional baseball.

“Had I gone to a ‘normal’ school, I don’t think I could have developed the same habits of having a daily schedule and having that discipline to wake up and do the same thing every day,” said Gresham of how helpful the strict schedule for student athletes was at West Point. “You wake up, do the same thing, have to be better the next day...so, ultimately, I think West Point gave me a lot of those skills and tools to be prepared for the pro level.” That discipline continues to prove helpful now that Gresham is in the minors, as Single-A players have a relatively set schedule to follow as well.

Gresham left Army with a ton of success, winning the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year in 2023 and won the Patriot League Championship with Army in each of his four collegiate seasons. An injury late in his junior season impacted his draft stock, but Gresham was still able to pitch in all four years and then the MLB Draft League with the Trenton Thunder following his final collegiate season. However, his military service came first. Gresham went from the Draft League to Philadelphia to sign with the Phillies before pausing his professional career to train as a military police officer in August of 2024.

How he found out about his signing is a testament to his dedication to his military service. Gresham was unable to complete some of the military exercises required for all West Point students before his senior year due to his injury, and they overlapped with the beginning of his professional baseball career.

“At that time, I was actually getting ready to start a ten-day exercise living in the woods for ten days,” recalled Gresham of where he was when he got the call from the Phillies. “As the first day started, the Phillies called me. I was

out in the woods covered in sweat and mud and dirt, and luckily, I had my phone on me. And that's when my agent called and told me the Phillies were going to sign me."

As surreal as the feeling was, Gresham still knew he had at least a year left before he would be on a baseball field again, and he had nine more days surviving in the woods to complete before any of it. Instead of reporting straight to the Carpenter Complex after his signing, he reported to a military base with no baseball fields in site.

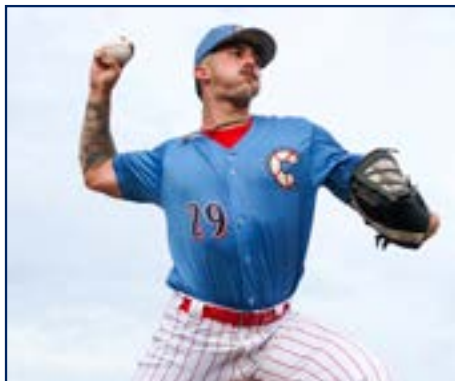
Gresham described his time at the base as a lot of training and paperwork, but he still found a way to stay in shape as a pitcher as well as a Military Police Officer. Lucky for him, there was a place for him to pitch very close to where he was based. "I got lucky enough that there was a gym located right outside the base that had a batting cage inside of it," said Gresham of his baseball training while deployed with the Military Police.

"For roughly a year and a half, I was in that batting cage almost every day, throwing into a net with a poked radar behind me." He also applied for the World Class Athlete Program through the Army to train as an Olympian.

In this program, Gresham was permitted to participate in activities with the Phillies and train for the 2028 Olympic Baseball team. After 15 months of training with the military police and a short stint at US Olympic headquarters in Colorado, Gresham returned to the Phillies full time in January of 2026 to officially begin his career in professional baseball.

It was an adjustment getting back to baseball full time for Gresham, but after his first professional win came along with eight strikeouts in a combined no-hitter, it's safe to say that he has enjoyed his return to the game. He still has some meetings to attend with the Military Police that he completes via zoom, but he can fully focus his energy on being the best pitcher he can be.

"It hurt my heart a little bit to be gone for that long and away from the game," said Gresham of missing baseball while completing his military service. "But, as of right now, I'm a baseball player, and that's the way I like it." Tanner Gresham knows that his time at West Point shaped his journey to professional baseball and will shape his future, but at least for now, he can focus on the present whenever he gets on the mound.

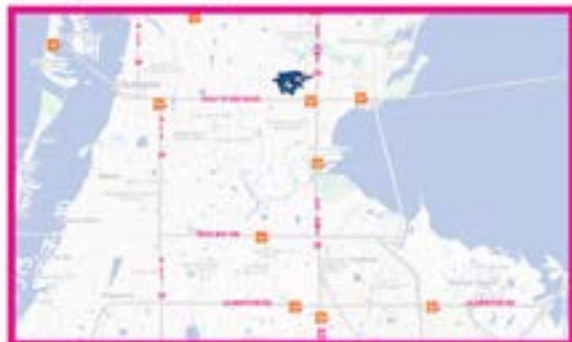
