NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- The 2026 season has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha won 10 of 15 from May 9 to 24 but have gone 2-7 in the last 9 games since May 25.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Omaha has been under .500 following 34 of their last 35 games (since April 24) and the Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days at or above .500.

SERIES SPEAKING

- Last week's series loss was Omaha's 3rd of the season and the team's first since dropping back-to-back series to Toledo and Louisville from April 21 to May 3.
- The Chasers have won 5 of their 9 week-long series this season - taking series against Buffalo (4-2), Iowa (3-2), Indianapolis (4-2), Toledo (4-2) and St. Paul (4-2).
- In 4 of this season's 5 series wins, Omaha won the series opener ... in 3 of the series wins - against Buffalo, Toledo and St. Paul - the clubs split the first four games before the Storm Chasers took both remaining contests to claim the series.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in each of their last 10 wins, with Thursday's 6-4 victory representing Omaha's 17th overall comeback win this year.
- Omaha's 17 comeback wins rank tied for the 2nd-most in the International League and tied 5th at the Triple-A level ... the Chasers' 101 comeback wins since 2024 rank 2nd-most in the International League and 3rd-most in Triple-A.
- On the flip side, Omaha has lost 17 games in which the team led, tied 4th-most in the league ... the Storm Chasers have led at some point in 5 of their last 8 losses.
- In the last 24 games (since May 9), Omaha is 12-12 ... they have trailed at some point in 10 of 12 wins and led at some point in 7 of 12 losses, meaning 17 of Omaha's last 24 games have been a comeback win for one of the two teams.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

- Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.
- Omaha's 84.2% success rate (64-for-76) ranks 3rd in the IL and 5th in Triple-A.
- John Rave leads Omaha in steals (14) ... Gavin Cross has 11 steals in as many tries, the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... Kameron Misner has swiped 9 bags, while Drew Waters has 6 steals and Peyton Wilson has 5.

COLUMBUS DAY SALE

- The Chasers have had good success against the Columbus Clippers, specifically at Huntington Park since Omaha joined the International League in 2021.
- Since joining the International League in 2021, Omaha has won 55 of 93 games against the Clippers (.591) ... it is the club's 3rd-best winning percentage against any IL opponent (min. 12 games) and 12th-best among all IL team matchups with at least 80 games against a single opponent (of 55 matchups).
- At Huntington Park, the Chasers are 32-25 (.561) since 2021 ... it is Omaha's 2nd-best road winning percentage at any IL ballpark (min. 12 games).

ROJAS TO THE RESCUE

- Josh Rojas hit in two different states on Thursday, starting with Omaha in Columbus before finishing the night as a Major League hero in Minneapolis.
- Rojas went 1-for-3 with a double and a run scored for the Chasers before being pulled in the 5th inning, missed his first flight out of Columbus, and waited 4 hours at the airport before landing in Minnesota mid-game.
- Rojas Ubered to Target Field, arrived nearly 3 hours after the game began, and entered as a pinch-hitter with the bases loaded in a tied game in the 9th ... on his second swing as a Royal, he sent a 2-run single up the middle to give Kansas City an 8-6 win over the Twins.

VETERAN SAVVY

- A trio of veteran Storm Chasers infielders have combined to be remarkably productive over the last three weeks.
- In 15 games since May 18, Kevin Newman, Josh Rojas and Abraham Toro have combined to hit .339 (41-for-121) with an .851 OPS ... they've combined for 12 multi-hit efforts in 32 combined games, with 4-hit games from Rojas and Toro.
- The trio entered this year combined for over 16 years of MLB service time: Newman (7 years, 3 days), Rojas (5 years, 104 days) and Toro (4 years, 106 days).

- ✓ Mitch Spence is making his **9th start** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **10th overall appearance** of the season.
- ✓ Playing his **7th professional season** this year ... the Royals are his 3rd Major League organization, after being drafted by the Yankees and spending the last two years with the Athletics.

A NEW SPENCE OF PURPOSE

- ✓ **QUALITY CONTROL:** Spence threw consecutive quality starts, accounting for 2 of Omaha's 4 this season ... his outing on May 7 @ Indianapolis (PIT) was the team's first quality start of the season ... has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 5 of 8 Triple-A starts with a 2.86 ERA (9 ER in 28.1 IP) in those 5 outings.
- ✓ **START ME UP:** Spence spent **2021-2023** almost exclusively as a starter in the Yankees' Minor League system before bouncing between roles in the A's organization ... he began both **2024** and **2025** in Oakland's bullpen before transitioning to the rotation each June ... he remained a starter after being optioned to Triple-A last year, though 2 of his 3 MLB appearances in September came in relief.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, MAY 31 vs. MEMPHIS

- ✓ Bounced back from a career-worst outing against Memphis five days prior ... picked off the only runner he allowed in the 1st ... allowed a sacrifice fly in the 2nd and worked a scoreless frame in the 3rd ... stranded two after allowing an RBI single to Colton Ledbetter in the 4th ... surrendered a run in the 6th on an RBI single by Ramon Mendoza before Genesis Cabrera relieved him with two outs in the 6th.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Was designated for assignment by the Athletics on February 10 and traded to Kansas City on February 12 in exchange for RHP A.J. Causey.
- ✓ Worked back-to-back quality starts for the Storm Chasers on May 7 and May 15, allowing 6 hits and 4 walks over 12.2 innings (0.79 WHIP) between the two games.

- ✓ Spent much of the year in the Major Leagues with the Athletics, splitting time as a starter and reliever ... made the A's Opening Day roster for the second straight year and opened the season as a reliever, making 22 relief appearances with a 4.38 ERA (19 ER in 39.0 IP) and 37 strikeouts before June 2.
 - ✓ Made his first start of the year June 5 and worked a 1.20 ERA (2 ER in 15.0 IP) in his first three games as a starter ... optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 10 and pitched in 8 games (7 starts) before the Athletics recalled him on September 10 for the remainder of the season.

- ✓ Was the 1st overall pick by the Athletics in the Rule 5 Draft on December 6, **2023** ... spent all of **2024** in the Major Leagues with Oakland and posted a 4.58 ERA (77 ER in 151.1 IP) with an 8-10 record and 126 strikeouts to 44 walks (2.86 K/BB) across 35 games (24 starts).
- ✓ Pitched part of **2022** and all **2023** in with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (AAA) in the Yankees organization, producing an 11-10 record with a 4.33 ERA (103 ER in 214.1 IP) and 201 strikeouts to 69 walks (2.91 K/BB) across 39 Triple-A starts.
