YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 9-7, for their second straight win. After trailing by five runs early, it was tied for the third-largest comeback win in franchise history. The Curve took a 2-0 lead in the first inning with an RBI triple by Kervin Pichardo and an RBI single by Nick Cimillo. Jackson Glenn hit a solo homer and Cimillo added a two-run shot to open a 5-0 lead. **Jairo Pomares** hit a two-run triple in the third to close the score to 5-2. In the fifth, Pomares and **Victor Bericoto** each hit RBI singles to pull the score to 5-4. **Diego Velasquez** tied the game with an RBI single in the top of the eighth inning. In the bottom of the eighth, Sammy Siani hit an RBI double and Abraham Gutierrez hit an RBI single to give the Curve a 7-5 lead. **Carter Howell** hit a two-run homer in the top of the ninth to tie the game, 7-7. Later in the ninth, **Andy Thomas** hit a go-ahead RBI double and later scored on interference. **Seth Corry** pitched a scoreless bottom of the ninth to pick up his second Double-A win. On his 24th birthday, Pomares went 4-for-5 with three RBIs and scored two runs.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, in the first of a six-game series. This is the only series between the two teams this season. Last year, the two teams met for six games at Dunkin Park in Hartford, with Richmond winning four-of-six. This set is the Flying Squirrels' final series this year against an opponent from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 6-12 in their last 18 games dating back to July 13 after winning their previous four games. They had lost five straight games from Sunday through Friday before beating the Curve on Saturday night and Sunday afternoon. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .228 and averaging 3.75 runs per game (191 runs/51 games) at home compared to a .236 batting average and 4.71 runs per game on the road (240 runs/51 games).

THE YARD GOATS clinched their first postseason appearance in franchise history by winning the Northeast Division in the Eastern League's first half with a 38-30 record, finishing 2.5 games ahead of Binghamton and Portland. The Yard Goats will face the second-half division champ in this year's Eastern League playoffs. For the season, the Yard Goats lead the Eastern League in stolen bases (155). Hartford's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including RHP Chase Dollander (No. 2), OF Adael Amador (No. 3), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 4), INF Sterlin Thompson (No. 7), LHP Sean Sullivan (No. 16), SS Ryan Ritter (No. 25), and RHP Zach Agnos (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list includes nine Hartford players, including Dollander (No. 1), Amador (No. 2), Fernandez (No. 4), Thompson (No. 6), Sullivan (No. 13), INF Warming Bernabel (No. 16), RHP Bradley Blalock (No. 20), LHP Mason Albright (No. 22) and LHP Luis Peralta (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Jack Choate** makes his Double-A debut. He was promoted from High-A Eugene on Thursday. With the Emeralds, he went 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). Choate last pitched last Tuesday at Everett and tied a career high with four walks, allowing two runs over 3.1 innings in a loss. For the season, Choate ranks tied for eighth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (87). Choate was selected in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of NCAA DI Assumption College in Massachusetts. **For more on Choate, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Left-hander Mason Albright makes his 19th start of the season and the first of his career against the Flying Squirrels. Albright last pitched on Wednesday at Reading and allowed four runs (three earned) over six innings. For the month of July, he went 0-1 with a 6.27 ERA (13 ER/18.2 IP) in four starts. Albright is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 21 prospect. He was selected in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Angels out of the IMG Academy in Florida. He signed with the Angels, forgoing his commitment to play at Virginia Tech. Albright was traded to the Rockies at the deadline on July 30, 2023 along with RHP Jake Madden in a deal that sent C.J. Cron and Randal Grichuk to the Angels.

COMEBACK KIDS: On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels came from behind to win after trailing by five runs early. The five-run comeback win was tied for the third-largest in franchise history. They have come back to win after trailing by six runs twice, first on July 28, 2017 against the SeaWolves in a 9-7 win and again on July 24, 2022 against the Baysox in a 7-6 victory. Sunday's 9-7 win was the eighth comeback win after trailing by five runs. The most recent prior to Sunday was on June 23, 2023 in the first game of a doubleheader against the Senators at The Diamond, capped with an eighth-inning, walk-off single by **Wade Meckler** for his team-record-tying fifth hit of the game. Sunday was the fourth comeback win after trailing by five-or-more runs under **Dennis Pelfrey**, this most for any manager in franchise history.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 74 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 70. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11. It is also the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

KING OF THE HILL: **Turner Hill** is batting .367 (11-for-30) with two doubles, a triple and five RBIs in his last eight games dating back to July 23, including three multi-hit games. He went 3-for-4 last Sunday afternoon against the Rumble Ponies, including a double. In his next game played on Wednesday at Altoona, he again picked up three hits, including a double. On Thursday night, he belted a bases-clearing, three-run double. Since his Double-A debut on June 27, Hill is ranked seventh in the Eastern League in batting average (.302).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 43 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .304 (52-for-171) with three homers, nine doubles, eight walks and 21 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 33 games. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 15-of-35 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .302 (41-for-136) in that stretch.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,653), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: There have been 57 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is three shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 28 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes an appearance by Andy Thomas on June 1 against the SeaWolves. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season. In last week's series at Altoona, three players made their Flying Squirrels debuts, including **Zach Morgan**, **Justin Wishkoski**, and **Julio Rodriguez**. Pitcher **Jack Choate** was assigned to the Flying Squirrels last week and is scheduled to make his Double-A debut tonight.

DEADLINE DEALS: The MLB trade deadline was last Tuesday at 6 p.m. and Flying Squirrels reliever **Eric Silva** was traded to the Detroit Tigers for Mark Canha and will join the Erie SeaWolves. Silva became the fifth player all time traded from the Flying Squirrels at trade deadline time. The most recent deadline day trades directly impacting the Flying Squirrels were in 2021. That year, pitcher **Caleb Kilian** was traded to the Cubs as part of a deal for Kris Bryant and reliever **Jose Marte** was sent to the Angels as part of a package for Tony Watson. In 2012, catcher **Tommy Joseph** was traded from the Flying Squirrels along with two other players to the Phillies for Hunter Pence. In 2010, pitcher Daniel Turpen was swapped to the Red Sox for Ramon Ramirez. Current Flying Squirrels catcher **Andy Thomas** was a trade deadline acquisition for the Giants along with reliever **Michael Stryfeler** in 2022 for Matthew Boyd and Curt Casali. In 2022, **Tristan Peters** became the only players sent straight to Richmond after being traded at the deadline when he was picked up from the Brewers for Trevor Rosenthal.

PROSPECT WATCH: One of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, which is SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
