### Leading Off

Reading continues a six-game series with game four tonight against Somerset. Reading has a 9-6 edge in the season series.

Reading beat Somerset 5-4 in dramatic fashion last night. Carlos De La Cruz put Reading on the board first with a homer in the first. David Parkinson was strong again, not allowing any earned runs over 5.1 innings. After the Patriots jumped up 3-1, Oliver Dunn crushed a three-run homer to make it 4-3 Reading in the seventh. Somerset tied it up in the top of the eighth, then Max McDowell hit an eventual game-winning home run in the eighth in his first game back with Reading. Orion Kerkering earned his first Double-A save in the ninth to finish off the victory.

#### Gettin' It Dunn

Oliver Dunn has now homered in three-straight games, marking the second time he's done that this season (6/20-22). It's also the third time in 2023 a Reading player has homered in three-straight. Dunn now has 20 home runs on the season along with 73 RBI, both marks are career highs. His previous career highs for homers was seven and RBI was 25. August has treated Dunn was too, as he's slashing .383/.424/.900 with a 1.324 OPS. He's also added nine home runs, 25 RBI and 15 runs over 15 games this month. Dunn's 20 home runs are second on the team and fourth in the Eastern League. His 73 RBI are second, but he holds with active lead with Hunter Goodman now in Triple-A.

#### Parkinson Powers

David Parkinson's run of success continued last night. Over his last seven starts, dating back to July 7, he's 5-0 with a 1.13 ERA, with 41 strikeouts and a .194 average against. Parkinson has climbed up the league rankings as well, holding the following top-10 distinctions: 5th ERA (3.81), T6th Wins (7), 4th IP (99.1), 10th WHIP (1.36) and 3rd WPCT (.636).

#### **Patriots Revenge**

Max McDowell and Oliver Dunn were both teammates in Somerset briefly in 2021 and both have haunted their former teams. Both hit key home runs in last night's victory. In 2023, Dunn is hitting .318 with four homers and 13 RBI against Somerset and McDowell is hitting .368 against his former team. Dunn split 2022 between Somerset and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, while McDowell was with the Railriders last season.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies had the night off last night and begin a three-game weekend series at the Washington Nationals tonight. Lehigh Valley squeaked out a 2-1 win over Jacksonville last night as Nick Nelson was strong again and Brandon Marsh had two hits in his rehab start. Jersey Shore shutout Asheville 4-0 as Mitch Neunborn was excellent and Leandro Pineda had two hits. Clearwater walked off Dunedin 5-4 in 11 innings to complete a perfect night for the Phillies affiliates. Emaarion Boyd tripled and had the wlak-off single in the 11th inning.

### 'Sup Somerset

Somerset enters tonight with the best-overall record in the Eastern League at 65-45, which saw them win the first half title. The Patriots are 23-19 in the second half, which currently sees them in first in the division. Somerset and Binghamton split a six-game series last week in New Jersey. Next up, Somerset returns home and welcomes Hartford. One of the Yankees' top prospects Jasson Dominguez headlines a Somerset team loaded with talent. Ben Rice has been a force since joining Somerset last night and has already left a strong mark on this series through just three games.

Righty Drew Thorpe gets the start tonight for Somerset. It'll be just Thorpe's second start for Somerset and first against Reading. He made his first start in Double-A on Aug. 11 and went eight-shutout innings, with nine strikeouts in a win against Binghamton. Thorpe was called up on August 8 from High-A Hudson Valley, where he went 10-2, with a 2.81 ERA over 18 starts (109 IP, 84 H, 33 BB, 138 SO). He also had a complete game as well for the Renegades. Thorpe was drafted by the Yankees in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Cal Poly and ranks as the Yankee's No. 5 overall prospect. He was named a consensus All-American in 2022 after ranking second in D1 in strikeouts with a school-record 149. Scouts graded his changeup as one of the best in the 2022 draft. He also adds a slider and fastball between 89-92, but peaks at 95.
