### Syracuse Mets News and Notes

**Wyatt Young Magic:** Wyatt Young has reached base in 17 of the 18 games he has played with Syracuse. The Hawaii native is hitting .343 with seven RBIs, a home run, three doubles, ten walks, 12 strikeouts, 13 runs scored, and a .436 on-base percentage. Young was drafted in the 15th round of last year's draft and played in only five games with High-A Brooklyn before he was promoted to Syracuse when infielder Matt Reynolds had his contract selected by New York. Young's .343 batting average ranks sixth in the International League, and his .436 on-base percentage ranks third.

**A New Hope:** From the start of the season to April 18th, Syracuse was 1-10 with a .187 batting average (20th in League), 35 runs scored (20th), .269 on-base percentage (20th), 34 walks (20th), and a pitching staff ERA of 6.73 (20th). Since April 19th, Syracuse is 8-9 with a .227 batting average (17th in League), 75 runs scored (14th), a .328 on-base percentage (14th), and 70 walks on offense (7th). The pitching staff has a 5.51 ERA (18th).

**Do the Palka:** Daniel Palka has been a man possessed at the plate so far this season. The former Chicago White Sox leads the Mets with 22 RBIs, 13 extra-base hits, and eight home runs. Palka is tied for fourth in the International League with eight home runs, tied for eighth with 22 RBIs, 23rd with a .383 on-base percentage, eighth with a .623 slugging percentage, tied for sixth with a 1.006 on-base plus slugging percentage, and tied for 13th with 13 extra-base hits.

**Saint Nick:** Nick Meyer has reached base in 13 of 14 games since April 9th, hitting .286 (12-for-42) with ten walks and a .423 on-base percentage during that stretch. Meyer also has hits in seven of ten games since April 17th where he has a .333 batting average (10-for-30) with three RBIs, a home run, a double, eight walks, and a .474 on-base percentage.

**On-Base Machine:** Khalil Lee has reached base in 13 of 15 games since April 15th. During the streak, Lee has a .204 batting average (10-for-49) with 20 strikeouts, but the 23-year-old has a .316 on-base percentage that is aided by seven walks and a hit by pitch. Lee does have hits in 9 of his last 15 games after going hitless in his first 5 games. Lee was named a 2021 Triple-A East League Post-Season All-Star. In 2021, Lee set Syracuse's single season franchise record with a .451 on-base percentage, which also led the league. That .451 mark beat out Otto Velez, who previously held Syracuse's franchise record with a .450 on-base percentage in 1973. Lee enters the 2022 season as New York's seventh-ranked prospect, according to MLB Pipeline.

**Untimely Hitting:** The Syracuse Mets are hitting a league-worst .179 with runners in scoring position. Lehigh Valley has the best mark in the League with a .308 batting average with runners in scoring position. This series, Syracuse is 3-for-24 (.125) with runners in scoring position, and Lehigh Valley is 20-for-51 (.392).

**Return of the I.L.:** After one season as the Triple-A East League, the International League (I.L.) has gotten its name back. With the reorganization Minor League Baseball in 2021, the International League was renamed the Triple-A East League for only 2021 while the naming rights to the league were being transferred. The International League is now made up of 20 teams after Minor League Baseball's reorganization. The I.L. had 14 teams before adding four teams from the Pacific Coast League (Iowa, Memphis, Nashville, and Omaha), St. Paul from the Independent American Association, and Jacksonville from Double-A all before the 2021 season. Below are brand-new divisions for 2022:

**International League East Division:** Buffalo, Charlotte, Durham, Jacksonville, Lehigh Valley, Norfolk, Rochester, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Syracuse, and Worcester

- 2022 w/NYM: 4G, 3GS, 1-0, 1.89 ERA, 19 IP, 13 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 8 BB, 16 K, .194 BAA**
- Has not pitched in Triple-A...Spent all of 2019 with Double-A Binghamton...Made his MLB debut for New York in 2020 and has spent the last three seasons (2020-22) pitching exclusively for the New York Mets
- In 2021, went on the 10-day injured list on July 2nd with an oblique strain and then went on the 60-day injured list before he came back after he suffered a Jones fracture of the fifth metatarsal of his right foot that required surgery and kept him out the rest of the season
- Entered 2020, ranked as the Mets' tenth-best prospect, according to MLB Pipeline
- In 2020, led all National League rookies and Mets pitchers with six wins, ranked third among National League rookies with 49.2 innings pitched, eighth with 40 strikeouts, and tied for the MLB rookie lead with six wins
- One of six rookies who finished a season as the Mets' team leader in wins (Tom Seaver-16 in 1967, Jerry Koosman-19 in 1968, Mark Bombardier-10 in 1980, Dwight Gooden-17 in 1984, and Dillon Gee-13 in 2011)
- In 2019, struck out a career-high 122 batters and made a career-high 24 starts while playing the entire season with Double-A Binghamton
- First round pick by the Mets (20th overall) out of Oregon in the 2017 Draft
- Finished his Oregon career ranked second in school history with 273 strikeouts and ranked sixth with 19 wins. Named consensus All-American after junior year (first Oregon player in modern era to earn that honor)
- Attended Regis Jesuit High School in Aurora, CO
- Does everything left-handed, except for golf which his father, who is right-handed, taught him to play
- 15 starts in final season at Oregon, posting an ERA of 3.05 in 100.1 IP. 140 strikeouts, 15 walks


