## AMAZIN' STARTS HERE

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones rallied for their first extra-inning win of the season, besting the Emperors in 10 innings, 6-3. C **Chris Suero** initially provided a go-ahead RBI double in the eighth, but Rome tied it on a fielder's choice RBI in the ninth. Suero delivered the deciding sacrifice fly in the 10th. 2B-RF **Wilfredo Lara** picked up two hits on the night and drove in a pair on a fielder's choice in extras. DH **Ryan Clifford** reached base four times with a pair of hits and walks, adding an RBI in the fifth. RHP **Nolan McLean** tied a career-high with five innings of work, allowing just two runs and striking out five. RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 31 innings of one-run relief before RHP **Victor Castañeda** recorded the final five outs for his second win.

**ONE AWAY FROM 1K:** After Friday's 6-3 win in extra innings over Rome, the Brooklyn Cyclones are now one win shy of their 1,000th in franchise history. Brooklyn holds a record of 999-842 (.543) in 1,841 games since 2001. Tuesday's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021. The Cyclones are 201-211 (.488) in 412 games. Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022. Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

**EXTRA! EXTRA!** Brooklyn's 6-3 win over Rome on Friday night marked the Cyclones' first win in extra innings in 2024. The Cyclones had started the season 0-2, dropping contests on April 7 at Wilmington and May 2 vs. Aberdeen. Friday was Brooklyn's first win in added frames since a 13-12 triumph in 10 innings at Asheville on August 24, 2023. Since the start of 2023, the Cyclones are 7-10 in extra-inning contests.

**PITCHING IN:** The Cyclones have pieced together one of the best pitching staffs in all of Minor League Baseball in 2024. Entering play on Saturday, Brooklyn holds a South Atlantic League-best 3.02 ERA (91 ER in 271 IP). The Cyclones' 117 WHIP and .590 opposing OPS are also the lowest in the circuit. Brooklyn's 3.02 ERA ranks fifth in all of Minor League Baseball. Double-A Birmingham (Chicago-AL) holds the best mark at 2.45. The Cyclones' .590 opposing OPS is the lowest in the minors, while the 117 WHIP is the sixth-lowest. Brooklyn is also tied for third in MLB with five shutouts.

**GATOR-ADE:** RHP **Brandon Sproat** has thrived in his first professional season for the Cyclones. After setting a career-high in innings pitched (52) and matching a career-best in strikeouts (8) on Thursday, the former Florida Gator enters play on Saturday with a 2-1 record and 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP). Sproat ranks fourth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.07), tied for fifth in batting average against (.141), and sixth in strikeout rate (32.4%). Sproat's 11.72 strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio is also good for third-highest in the SAL among pitchers with 25.0+ innings pitched.

**YIPPEE KI-YAY:** TWP **Nolan McLean** has had an incredible start to his Cyclones career. On the mound, McLean had his team-best scoreless inning streak halted at 151 innings in a no-decision on Friday at Rome. Over his last four starts, McLean is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER in 18.0 IP), allowing just 10 hits and five walks (7.81 BB%), adding 21 strikeouts (32.81 K%). On the year, he is eighth in the South Atlantic League in WHIP (1.00) among pitchers with 24.0+ innings. At the plate, the 22-year-old tied a career-high with three hits and collected a pair of extra-base hits with a double and a two-run home run on Wednesday. McLean enters play on Saturday with 11 extra-base hits, tied for ninth in the SAL. The Willow Springs, N.C. native has registered 30 fewer plate appearances (57) than any other player with 11+ extra-base knocks in the circuit and 10 fewer plate appearances with that total across the minor leagues. Among players with 55+ plate appearances, McLean is second in the league in slugging (.611) and eighth in OPS (.909).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** With a pair of stolen bases off the bench last Thursday afternoon, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (58) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50). In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes. Omar is 16 swipes away from tying his previous record and on pace for 89 in 2024. De Los Santos enters Saturday's contest 21-for-22 stealing bases to start the season. The 21 swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for second-most throughout the minors. Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is third across the Minors in steals (128).

**WALK THIS WAY:** 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford** and INF **William Lugo** have accumulated walks in droves in 2024. Clifford's 32 walks are not only the most in the South Atlantic League but the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Clifford also enters Saturday's matchup second in the SAL in on-base percentage (.441). Additionally, Lugo's 25 free passes are tied for third-most in the league. Clifford's 25.2% walk rate is third-best in MLB, while Lugo's 22.5% mark is good for 10th.

**NICK THE STICK:** INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024. The Connecticut native extended his hitting streak to a team season-long nine on Friday. Since April 27, the former Maryland Terrapin is 11-for-35 at the plate, hitting .314/.359/.486 with a .845 OPS. Lorusso has five runs scored, four doubles, a triple, and six RBI in that time. Coming into Saturday's matchup, the 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), tied for third in doubles (8), and tied for sixth in extra-base hits (12) and slugging (.500).

**WELCOME TO BROOKLYN:** OF **Nick Morabito** has reached safely all three games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut on Tuesday night. Entering play on Saturday, the now 21-year-old is tied atop Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.504) and tied for third in batting average (.378). He is also 10th in wRC+ (.94). At the time of his promotion from Single-A St. Lucie, Morabito led the Florida State League in hitting (.397), on-base percentage (.530), and OPS (1.043). He was also third in slugging (.513), hits (31), and stolen bases (11), tied for sixth in walks (18), and seventh in total bases (40). C **Chris Suero**, who also joined the team from St. Lucie, has reached in all four games played. The 20-year-old was tied for the FSL lead in runs scored (18) by the time of his departure and seventh in OPS (.824), tied for seventh in RBI (15), eighth in on-base percentage (.390), and 10th in slugging (.434).

**JONAH'S WHALE OF A START:** RHP **Jonah Tong**'s stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on Wednesday night at 26.0 frames. In seven

**vs. ROME:** Brooklyn opens its only two-week road trip of the season against the Braves' High-A affiliate. The Emperors possess seven of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Spencer Schwellenbach** (3), RHP **Owen Murphy** (5), RHP **Drue Hackenberg** (10), RHP **Jhancarlos Lara** (13), INF **Sabin Ceballos** (18), INF **Ambioris Tavarez** (21), and RHP **Lucas Braun** (24). This marks the first ever meeting between the Rome and Brooklyn franchises since the Cyclones entered the South Atlantic League in 2021. Rome will visit Coney Island from July 23-28.

appearances (five starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 1-0 with a 0.33 ERA (1 ER in 27.2 IP). Tong is tied with High-A Beloit's LHP **Emmett Olson** (0.33) for the lowest ERA among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball. Entering play on Saturday, the Markham, Ont. native is third among qualifiers in MLB in strikeout rate (43.5%) and seventh in strikeout-to-walk rate (32.4%). Tong's 47 strikeouts are ninth-most in the minors.

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process. The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history. In his 49 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.64 ERA (23 ER in 78.1 IP) and 4 saves, walking just 18 and striking out 70.

**FEAR THE HAWK:** RHP **Dakota Hawkins** had his 91-inning scoreless streak snapped in the fifth inning on Thursday at Rome. The stretch was the longest spotless run by a Brooklyn reliever this year. Among South Atlantic League relief arms, Hawkins is tied for third in the circuit in strikeouts (26). He is also tied for eighth in innings pitched (17.0) and ninth in strikeout-to-walk rate (6.50).

**LONG ARM OF THE LAW:** RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang. The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is third in the circuit in saves (4). Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least 15.0 innings pitched, the 23-year-old leads the circuit in ERA (0.59), WHIP (0.72), and fewest hits allowed (5).

**GOING BACK TO BACK:** The Cyclones shut out the IronBirds for the second-straight day with a 4-0 win last Saturday. RHP **Nolan McLean** (5.0 IP), RHP **Victor Castañeda** (2.0), and RHP **Ben Simon** (2.0) combined on a five-hitter. On Friday, RHP **Brandon Sproat** (5.0), RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (2.2), and RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (1.1) united to one-hit Aberdeen, 2-0. The back-to-back shutouts are the first for the Cyclones at the full-season level and the first since Brooklyn blanked the Connecticut Tigers on the road in both ends of a doubleheader on August 23, 2019. RHP **Michel Otañez** (4.1), RHP **Mitch Ragan** (1.2), and RHP **Josh Hejka** (1.0) united on a 4-0 win in Game 1, while RHP **Dan Goggin** (2.0), RHP **Hunter Parsons** (2.0), and RHP **Jared Biddy** (3.0) led the charge to a 5-0 victory in Game 2. It is also the first for Brooklyn in consecutive nine-inning games since August 21-22, 2014, vs. Staten Island and Tri-City. RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (5.0), LHP **Brad Wieck** (2.0), LHP **Kelly Secrest** (1.0), and LHP **Shane Bay** (1.0) twirled the Cyclones to a 2-0 win over Staten Island in the first leg. RHP **Martires Arias** (5.0), RHP **Gaither Bumgardner** (2.0), and RHP **Cameron Griffin** (2.0) provided the zeroes in a 7-0 rout of Tri-City on the back end. Last Saturday's blanking marked the fifth of the season for Brooklyn's pitching staff. The five shutouts are the most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

**KING STANLEY:** With his RBI double in the bottom of the first inning last Friday, OF **Stanley Consuegra** became the first player in Cyclones history to reach the century mark in RBI. The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 67 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 101 RBI. On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23). Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville. The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in last Tuesday's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen. They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24. Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning. The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph. The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high. The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023. It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022. Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022. The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. The Cyclones have five of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 6), **Brandon Sproat** (10), **Nolan McLean** (11), **Jonah Tong** (22), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29). Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), **Wilfredo Lara** (23), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26). MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 87th-best farmhand in all of baseball.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took his second-straight no-decision last Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Allowed a run without permitted a base-hit over 2.2 innings...Walked a season-high-tying three and punched out four...Charged with a wild pitch...Tossed 45 pitches and 23 strikes (51.11%)... Relieved by RHP **Jordany Ventura** with a runner at first and two out in the top of the third inning and Brooklyn leading, 1-0...Bequeathed runner scored on a 2B **Nick Maton** triple...Brooklyn would score three runs in the bottom of the eighth to defeat the IronBirds, 5-2.

**CAN'T TOUCH THIS:** Orellana had his season-high 12.0-inning scoreless streak come to a close last Sunday afternoon against Aberdeen...During the stretch, he surrendered just three hits and four walks, adding 13 strikeouts...The 22-year-old started the season by tossing a bevy of zeroes too...The right-hander did not allow a run over his first two appearances and 8.1 innings...Orellana yielded only four hits and three walks in that span, while striking out eight.

**PIGGYBACK RIDE:** Orellana will make his third start of the 2024 season on Saturday after serving in a relief role through his first four appearances...The 21-year-old worked as a "piggybacker" off RHP **Noah Hall**...Hall was placed on Brooklyn's 7-day injured list on April 26.

**DOOGIE HOWSER:** The Caraças, Venezuela native was untouchable out of the bullpen on April 24 vs. Wilmington...The 22-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced – striking out six – in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito García** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch... LHP **Nelson Pereira** (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

**2023:** Orellana spent the entire 2023 season with current Brooklyn manager **Gilbert Gómez** and pitching coach **Dan McKinney** at Single-A St. Lucie...In his age 21 campaign, the right-hander made 23 appearances and 18 starts, tallying a 4-4 record and a 4.53 ERA (45 ER in 89.1 IP) with one save...Orellana issued 50 walks, but struck out 112 hitters...He finished fifth in the Florida State League in strikeouts and second on St. Lucie's roster behind LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (114)...Orellana finished the season by being named the FSL's Pitcher of the Month for September...He permitted only two runs (one earned) on five hits in 10.2 innings, accruing two walks and 16 K's.
