LAST OUTING: Lindblom last pitched on May 15 in his first relief appearance of the season. He went 5.0 innings in relief of Alec Bettinger (2.0 IP) and Luke Barker (1.0 IP). Lindblom yielded two runs on four hits and two walks to go along with five strikeouts. He did not factor into the decision of Nashville's 11-6 win, and he threw 50 of his 75 pitches for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Lindblom made four starts against Louisville last year and went 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA (21.1 IP/12 ER). He allowed 20 hits and 8 walks to go with 22 strikeouts. Two of the four starts were at First Horizon Park and two were in Kentucky. He made two relief appearances against the Bats in 2017 with Triple-A Indianapolis.
