- Dunedin's offense racked up nine runs on 10 hits to take the series opener from the Threshers, 9-4 at BayCare Ballpark Monday.
- Joey Votto lined a 5th inning RBI single, marking his first regular season hit as a member of the Blue Jays organization.
- Arjun Nimmala went 2-4 with 2 RBIs his first multi-hit game with Dunedin since returning from FCL last week.
- Blue Jays pitching worked out of bases loaded jams twice: once in the third with Nolan Perry on the mound, and again in the seventh with Juanmi Vasquez on the bump.
- Clearwater stranded 13 runners on base tying a season high by a Blue Jays opponent.
- Dunedin won despite issuing 12 walks, tying their season-high.

EIGHT OR MORE MEANS WINS GALORE

Including Monday night's 9-4 victory, the Blue Jays are 15-1 when scoring eight runs or more this season.

NICE TO SEE YOU. NIMMALA

In four games since his return to Dunedin from the FCL Blue Jays, Arjun Nimmala is 5-14 (.357) with three extra base hits. Nimmala was placed on Dunedin's development list on May 14, and then was assigned to the FCL Blue Jays on June 3. Nimmala was the Blue Jays first round draft pick last season, and is the organization's third-ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

REUNITED WITH ROJAS

Blue Jays No. 10 prospect Kendry Rojas returns to Dunedin this evening on a rehab assignment from A+ Vancouver. Rojas has spent each of the last two seasons with the D-Jays, posting a 3.86 ERA in 123.2 innings of work. Rojas started the Blue Jays' combined no-hitter on September 2nd last season, firing six frames.

FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

It was announced Tuesday that Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez would represent Toronto in the All-Star Futures game on Saturday July 13 in Arlington. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.60), Ks (76), innings (70), and WHIP (1.04). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016.

TAKE A WALK

Last night's 12-walk performance from the Blue Jays pitching staff tied a season high in walks issued. Dunedin is second in the league with 380 walks, behind St. Lucie's 383.

HELLO, JOEY

17-year MLB first baseman, six-time All-Star, and 2010 National League MVP Joey Votto continues his rehab stretch with Dunedin today. Votto suffered a severe ankle sprain during Spring Training after signing with Toronto on March 8. The Toronto native is MLB's active walks leader with 1,365, and his 356 home runs are third most among active players.

REHAB CITY, USA

With Kendry Rojas' rehab start today, Dunedin has hosted 14 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Joey Votto's rehab assignment continues today. Other notable rehabs include No. 1 prospect Ricky Tiedemann, Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).

ROAD COOKING

Dunedin's pitching staff has proved to be more effective on the road than at home. At TD Ballpark, the Jays have posted a 4.30 ERA in 343 innings. On the road, the staff's ERA stands at 3.54 in 3110 innings - the second best road ERA in the FSL.

THE MONTH THAT WAS

Dunedin finished June with a 12-13 record. The Blue Jays' pitching staff had its best month of the season thus far, posting a 3.35 ERA (the fourth best in the FSL) after struggling with a 4.70 ERA in May (second worst in the league). At the plate, the Blue Jays' .614 OPS in June was their lowest by month this season. After leading the league with 27 home runs in May, Dunedin only hit 13 in June.

SERIES SUCCESS STYMIED

Last week's four-games to two series loss to Lakeland snapped a streak of six straight sets with at least a split for the D-Jays. The team's last series loss came on the road at Fort Myers, May 7-12.

TOUGH STRETCH

The Blue Jays are in the midst of perhaps their toughest stretch of the year, scheduled to play nine games in eight days. All nine games are against the two best teams in the FSL in Lakeland (48-27) and Clearwater (47-29).
