History vs. Dayton

The Lugnuts are 209-169 all-time vs. the Dayton Dragons, their best winning percentage against any team in the Midwest League. They are 109-87 all-time at home against Dayton and 100-82 in the Gem City.

Last year, the Nuts went 5-6 vs. Dayton in Michigan's state capital, but took five of six games at Day Air Ballpark for a 10-7 record.

Today: Coming off a 7-5 homestand against Fort Wayne and Great Lakes, the Lansing Lugnuts open a six-game series at the Dayton Dragons, completing a home-and-home 12-game season series with the Dragons. The Nuts lost four of six games at home against Dayton in early May, with both of their victories attained via walk-off. This is the penultimate road trip of the Lugnuts' 27th season in the Midwest League.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 10, Loons 7. The Nuts became the first Midwest League team to win a home series against Great Lakes, scoring four runs in the 6th and three in the 7th to turn around a 6-3 deficit. Lansing finished the season series with a 12-9 record vs. the Loons, the only team in the league with a winning season record against their intrastate rival. **Junior Pérez** doubled and homered for a second straight game and reached four times to lead a 14-hit, 8-walk offensive effort.

On the Air: Tom Nichols and Patrick Geshan call the action on Bally Live and MiLB.TV, with an audio-only call with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** available via StreamGuys.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play Dayton through Sunday, return to Jackson Field to host the West Michigan Whitecaps from August 29 through September 3, and then conclude the 2023 season with a six-game series at Lake County from September 4-10.

Among the League Leaders: Daniel Susac is second in batting average (.301), tied for third in hits (103), ninth in slugging percentage (.444), tenth in OPS (.811) and tenth in total bases (152). Junior Pérez is fourth in steals (39) and tied for seventh in doubles (24). Danny Bautista, Jr. is tied for third in hits (103) and is eighth in batting average (.278).

An Offensive Statement, But Not the Most Offensive: The Lugnuts' offense ranks second in the Midwest League in batting average (.2487 to West Michigan's .2488), tied for second in base hits (918 to Beloit's 919) and second in stolen bases (168 to Great Lakes' 174).

Pitcher's Best Friend: After turning another double play Sunday, the Nuts lead the league with 108 double plays turned, 14 more than second-place Beloit.

Saving the Day: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 15 in 18 games played in August (83%).

Turnaround: Outfielder Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .279 (82-for-294). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - .328/.416/.567, .983 OPS. He has reached base 43 times in the last 21 games thanks to 29 hits and 14 walks.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euriel Angeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); Gunnar Hoglund (Toronto Blue Jays, 3/16/22, for Matt Chapman); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has three current first-rounders: the A's last two first-round selections in catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, and shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, plus the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, opened the year on the Lugnuts' roster and is now with Double-A Midland.

Big League Nuts: Eight Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts in 2023, totaling 181 all-time. Those eight: Ryan Noda on March 30; Hogan Harris on April 14; Mason Miller on April 19; Garrett Acton on May 14; Samad Taylor on June 18; Tyler Soderstrom on July 14; and Lawrence Butler and Hagen Danner on August 11. Davis Schneider, who debuted with Toronto on August 4, played for the Nuts in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

1996: The Lugnuts became the first Class-A team to ever break the 500,000 attendance mark in their first season.

2016: The Skunk Game! The Dayton Dragons trailed the Lugnuts 10-3 entering the bottom of the seventh at Fifth Third Field, scored five runs in the 7th to make it 10-8, and then made it 10-9 on a Zach Shields RBI single in the 8th. With one out in the bottom of the 9th, a skunk emerged from near the groundskeeper's tarp beyond the Lugnuts' dugout on the first-base side. It scampered to second, wandered into right-center and explored the warning track toward left-field before the grounds crew corralled it (and were sprayed for their trouble) at the left-center fence in a hamper. The game was delayed eight minutes. With two outs, James Vasquez tied the game with an RBI single to center off Dan Lietz, and Chris Okey followed with a game-winning RBI single to right-center for an 11-10 Dayton win.

Home Cooking: Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

Glory Days: Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

Minor League Path: Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

Bagels in April: Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.

Rave Reviews: Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13 to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martin Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."

Life in Lansing: This is Dicochea's second start on Tuesday; he has made one start on Wednesday, three starts on Thursday, three starts on Friday, one start on Saturday and one relief appearance on Sunday... has a 6.32 ERA on the road in four MWL starts (11 ER in 15 2/3 IP) compared to 4.57 at home (11 ER in 21 2/3 IP).
