TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Your first-place Quakes continue a six-game set against the San Jose Giants (SF) today with game four of the series. Tonight is our first Family RV Family Feast Night of the year, as fans can enjoy \$2 hot dogs, \$1 Pepsi products and \$1 ice cream sandwiches. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the fourth of 18 games against the Giants and the fourth of 12 here at home. The Quakes are currently 2-1 against the Giants. Rancho was 7-5 against the Giants in 2024, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: The Giants earned their first road win of the year, taking a 13-6 decision over Rancho on Thursday night at LoanMart Field. Jakob Christian drove in a career-high six runs, hitting a tie-breaking three-run homer off Quakes' starter Aidan Foeller (0-1) in the fifth. San Jose reliever Nikolas Herold (1-0) struck out six over two hitless innings to nail down the win. Rancho's offense collected just six hits, with Mike Sirota and Jose Meza each picking up two hits and three RBIs. The loss for Rancho matches their largest defeat of the year, having dropped a 12-5 game in Stockton last week.

EVERYTHING THAT HAS A BEGINNING, HAS AN END: The Quakes saw a pair of streaks end last night, as their perfect run at home ended at five straight wins to open the year. Thursday's loss also ended their second three-game win streak of the year. Rancho is still in first place in the South, two games up over Inland Empire.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a pair of roster moves on Wednesday, as INF Joendry Vargas and LHP Jakob Wright were both placed on the Injured List. No moves have been made to fill those respective spots.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes have welcomed back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

PROSPECT HEAVY: According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

SEAN PAUL LINAN: Right-hander Sean Paul Linan makes his third appearance and second start of the year, his first against the Giants. In his last outing, he suffered a tough-luck loss, allowing just one run on three hits with one walk, striking out eight over 4.2 innings in a loss at Stockton on April 12th. Linan opened the 2024 season with the ACL Dodgers, going 3-0 with a 2.08 ERA over six games (one start) before joining the Quakes, where he'd go 6-2 with a 4.89 ERA over 13 games (four starts). Linan signed with the Dodgers in January of 2022 out of Cartagena, Columbia.

GREG FARONE: Lefty Greg Farone goes for San Jose tonight, making his first appearance against the Quakes and his third start overall. In his last outing, Farone allowed just three hits and two walks, while striking out eight batters over four scoreless innings in a no-decision against Visalia on April 11th. Farone played college ball at Alabama and was drafted by San Francisco in the seventh round of the 2024 draft.
