SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

<u>SMASHING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS</u>: OF Jackson Chourio hit his 17th home run of the year on Saturday, a 413-foot solo shot to center... Chourio's home run now gives him the most in a single-season by a teenager in Double-A since Delmon Young hit 20 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB) during the 2005 season.

Chourio enters today with 70 RBI, the third-most in the Southern League... He enters today with the third-most in a season in franchise history (since 2015), and four away from the franchise record of 74, set by OF Corey Ray in 2018

<u>ON-BASE MACHINE</u>: OF Jackson Chourio enters today with a 21-game on-base streak, the third-longest active streak in Double-A... Over his on-base streak, Chourio is hitting .424 with six doubles, two triples, seven home runs and 22 RBI... He's also tallied a .480 on-base percentage and a 1.241 OPS.

Entering today, Chourio is among the Double-A leaders since the All-Star Break (July 14) in OPS (1st, 1.221), hits (1st, 37), average (2nd, .425), on-base percentage (3rd, .485) and home runs (T-6th, 6),

FIRST TIME IN A LONG TIME: OF Carlos Rodriguez hit his first home of the year on Saturday night off the scoreboard in right at Blue Wahoos Stadium... The home run was his first since May 29, 2022 with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers at the Cedar Rapids Kernels in High-A, 434 days ago... The home run was his first at the Double-A level.

RACKING UP THE STRIKEOUTS: With seven strikeouts on Saturday night, RHP Tobias Myers is now tied with teammate RHP Carlos Rodriguez for the second-most strikeouts in the Southern League with 118... The pair is also tied for the fourth-most strikeouts in Double-A.

As a team, the Shuckers have struck out 1,034 batters, the third-most in Double-A and the second-most in the Southern League... Of the 11 pitchers that have thrown at least 30 innings for Biloxi, six have struck out at least 50.

IN THE AIR TONIGHT: OF/INF Isaac Collins enters today with a 16-game on-base streak, one of three Shuckers with an active on-base streak of at least 16 games... Over the streak, Collins is hitting .407 (24-59) with 12 walks, nine strikeouts and a 1.195 OPS... Collins' first inning home run on Saturday was his fourth of the streak and his fourth against the Blue Wahoos.

MEET MR. ROBINSON: After a scoreless ninth on Thursday, RHP Cam Robinson enters today with eight saves in 2023, the most out of any player on the Shuckers and tied for the fourth most out of any pitcher in the Southern League.

Since July 6, Robinson has tallied eight scoreless outings in his last nine, including an active 5.2 inning scoreless streak, his longest of the year... His five saves over that span are tied for the most in Double-A.

<u>TODAY'S STARTER // RHP JAMES MEEKER [6-3, 3.31]</u>: RHP James Meeker will make his eighth start of the year and the 10th of his professional career... In two starts against the Birmingham Barons last week, Meeker combined to allow three earned runs over 11 innings, setting a new career-high with six innings on July 25 and 86 pitches on July 30... Today marks his third start against Pensacola, including five shutout innings on July 4 to earn the win.
