FRES-NOTES

GIANT AMOUNT OF HISTORY: The Grizzlies and Giants continue the best-of-five Low-A West Championship tonight at Chukchansi Park. The two teams met 30 times during the regular season or 25% of the schedule in 2021 and now one time in the playoffs. Of their 31 games against one another this year, Fresno holds a 16-15 season-lead with 21 of those contests being decided by one or two runs. The last time that these two teams were in the same league was in 1988. The Grizzlies were known as the Fresno Suns and did not have an affiliate tie. While San Jose were named and associated with the Giants organization, San Jose is still at the same ballpark as the last time these two teams faced off against each other. At the end of the 1987 season, the Fresno Giants were crowned league champions.

LAST TIME THERE WAS A TITLE: Both the Grizzlies and Giants have had recent success in the postseason. Fresno reached the postseason most recently in 2018 when they were affiliated with the Houston Astros organization. That team would end up losing to the Memphis Redbirds in the PCL Championship. Prior to that, the Grizzlies made the postseason in 2015, where they would go on to win the PCL and Triple-A Championships. The Grizzlies were also associated with the Astros system in 2015. San Jose is in the playoffs for the 14th time in their last 17 seasons and in the championship for the first time since 2015. They were swept by the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes that year. The Giants hoisted the California League trophy most recently in 2010 when they beat the Quakes 3 games to 2.

NL WEST AT THE A-LEVEL: There is a lot riding on the line in the next week for the Colorado Rockies and San Francisco Giants organizations. The two systems will meet in both the High-A and Low-A West Championships with Spokane battling Eugene and Fresno taking on San Jose. All four clubs have moved players up and down throughout the season, so the familiarity of the matchups are intriguing. According to MLB Pipeline, the Fresno and San Jose matchup is the most Top-30 prospect laden championship with 18 total players on the two squads. San Jose boasts the most Top 30 prospects on any playoff team with 11 while Fresno has seven Top-30 prospects (Zac Veen, Drew Romo, Warming Bernabel, Julio Carreras, Robby Martin, Gavin Hollowell and Eddy Diaz).

RUNNING WILD: The Fresno Grizzlies ran wild on the basepaths in the regular season. Fresno led the Low-A West and were fourth in all of Minor League Baseball with 221 stolen bases. The 221 swipes are now the Grizzlies' franchise record for the most team steals in a single season, which was initially held by the 2011 team (209). Julio Carreras was the recipient of the record-breaking steal in the fourth inning on September 4th at Stockton. Fresno also had three players that were ranked in the Top Five of the Low-A West leaderboard and one player in the Top Two of Minor League Baseball in swipes. Rockies #30 prospect Eddy Diaz ranked first with 48 stolen bases in 62 attempts (Grizzlies, Low-A West) and tied for second in all of Minor League Baseball with 59 swipes in 78 tries (Spokane and Fresno). Rockies top prospect Zac Veen finished second with 36 steals in 53 attempts and Bladimir Restituyo finished tied for fourth with 31 swipes in 36 tries, all with the Grizzlies.

DIAZ SPRINTED INTO THE RECORD BOOKS: Eddy Diaz swiped one bag September 19th against the San Jose Giants, giving him 48 stolen bases with the Grizzlies in the regular season. Diaz finished in sole possession of second place on the Grizzlies' franchise single-season steals list. Tyler Graham's total of 60 stolen bases back in 2011 still stands as the most steals in a single-season by a Grizzlies player. Diaz's 48 Fresno stolen bases were more than four full season Minor League teams (Rochester, Las Vegas, Portland and Harrisburg) and his 59 swipes between two levels were more than nine full season Minor League teams.

VEEN RACED INTO THE RECORD BOOKS TOO: The Grizzlies stole eight bases on September 3rd against the Stockton Ports, tying a season-high (June 9 at Modesto). Four of the eight stolen bases came from Zac Veen. The Rockies top prospect finished with 36 overall stolen bases on the season, which put him in a tie for fifth place on the Grizzlies' franchise single-season steals list. Veen's four stolen bases on the night also tied him with Emmanuel Burriss (2011) for the most swipes in a single game in franchise history. Burriss is the current hitting coach for the Oklahoma City Dodgers, the Triple-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

ROMO RAN INTO THE RECORD BOOKS AS WELL: Fresno stole seven bases on September 7th against the Modesto Nuts en route to clinching a playoff berth. Four of the seven stolen bases came from Drew Romo. His four stolen bases on the night also tied him with Emmanuel Burriss (2011) for the most swipes in a single game in franchise history. The Rockies #8 overall and top catching prospect had 23 stolen bases on the season, which placed him fourth on the club. Romo's 23 stolen bases are the most ever by a Grizzlies catcher and second all-time on the Fresno catcher leaderboard. The only player still ahead of Romo is Roland LeBlanc, who stole 29 bases in 1955 for the Fresno Cardinals (California League). LeBlanc was converted from an outfielder to a catcher after gaining weight when he returned home from war. During the 1942 season, LeBlanc and the teams catcher Frank Zera joined the Marine Corps. LeBlanc became a pilot with the Flying Tigers and flew the infamous Himalayan route known as "the hump." Zera was killed in the battle of Okinawa as he stood alongside General Simon Bolivar Buckner, who was the highest ranking American officer ever killed in a war. When LeBlanc returned from the War, he had gained a lot of weight. So much that the Cardinals decided his days in the outfield were over and converted him to catcher for the 1947 season at Omaha. From 1950-1957, LeBlanc made a couple stints with the Fresno Cardinals, spending time as both a player and manager.

2021: Struck out four in career-high two innings 5/12 vs VIS...scoreless inning 6/2 vs VIS (1 H, 1 K)...another scoreless frame 6/5 vs VIS (1 BB, 1 K)...two scoreless frames with a pair of punchouts 6/10 at MOD...fanned three over two solid innings of work 6/13 at MOD...struck out two over a scoreless frame 6/16 vs STK...earned first win of season 6/24 at VIS (two perfect innings, four punchouts)...one of three pitchers who combined for two-hit shutout 7/15 at STK, going a career-high three innings, allowing a single and striking out three...made first professional start 7/20 vs MOD, going career-high four scoreless innings, allowing three hits and one walk while fanning four... second pro start only lasted 1.2 innings, striking out three 7/25 vs MOD...career-high 4.2 scoreless innings 7/30 at LE, one of four pitchers who combined on the shut-out (2 H, 3 BB, 4 K)...struck out two over 1.2 innings in last start 8/5 vs SJ...tossed career-high five innings and seven strikeouts 8/11 vs STK...one of four pitchers who combined for three-hit shutout 8/17 at VIS, started and tossed career-high five frames, allowing two hits and three walks while fanning six...exceeded previous outing, dazzling for a career-high seven innings, allowing two runs (zero earned) on one hit, two walks and 10 punchouts (professional best), retired final 17 batters he faced 8/22 at VIS...over his two starts against Visalia, went 1-0 without allowing an earned run (12.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 5 BB, 16 K)... five and two-thirds innings of one-run ball with eight strikeouts to earn third win of season 9/4 at STK...five sensational frames 9/16 vs SJ, allowing one run on five hits and two walks while striking out a career-high 10...the Grizzlies are 20-5 in games pitched by Locey (9-1 as a starter).
