'CAPS TAKEN DOWN BY SATURDAY SLAM: One night after scoring 15 runs on the Fourth of July, the West Michigan Whitecaps found themselves struggling for offense in a 7-3 loss to the Great Lakes Loons in front of 5,234 fans on Saturday night at Dow Diamond. A 3-2 Whitecaps deficit was extended in the sixth inning when Zyhir Hope, the Los Angeles Dodgers' No. 2 Prospect, according to MLB Pipeline, smashed an opposite-field grand slam, sending the Loons to their third win of the series. One night ago, the Whitecaps came mere outs away from their most lopsided shutout in franchise history as part of a 15-1 win in Midland. On Saturday, the 'Caps went 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position.

POSTSEASON PLANS: The 'Caps will host a playoff game the second week of September, scheduled for Thursday the 11th at 6:35 pm against the second-half Midwest League Eastern Division champion. Individual tickets will go on sale July 8 at 10:00 am on whitecapsbaseball.com.

A GRAND SEASON: The Whitecaps have shattered their franchise record for grand slams (5) in a season, last established with 6 with 7, the most recent of which came by Andrew Jenkins in the 1st inning of a 15-1 win over the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond on July 4.

CLINCHING WITH FLARE: The Whitecaps broke or tied several records in their historic 20-6 Eastern Division clincher on June 13, including breaking the single-game hits record (26 vs. 25), and most at-bats in a nine-inning game (52 vs. 51). Moreover, the club tied the franchise's high-water mark for runs in an inning with 13 in the third, and 3 HRs in the frame.

FUTURE STARS IN WEST MICHIGAN: For the first time in franchise history, the West Michigan Whitecaps will send three active players to Atlanta for MLB All-Star Weekend, as Max Clark, Kevin McGonigle, and Josue Briceño are slated to represent the Detroit Tigers and the American League in the 26th MLB Futures Game in Atlanta, scheduled for Saturday, July 12 from Truist Park at 4 pm.



PEPPERING THE LEADERBOARD: The Whitecaps are the only Midwest League team ranked in the Top 3 in all three team categories, as they sit 1st in hitting (.267), 1st in pitching (3.21 ERA), and are 3rd in total defense with a fielding percentage of .978.

A LOT TO A LITTLE: The Whitecaps currently have the second-best run differential in all of Minor League Baseball at +184, trailing AAA Las Vegas (+187) & ahead of the Tigers Double-A affiliate, the Erie Seawolves (+172).

TOP DOG IN THE MILB: The Tigers had the No. 1 farm system in baseball heading into the 2025 season according to MLB Pipeline, and currently boast five prospects in MLB Pipeline's updated top 100: IF Kevin McGonigle (No. 7), OF Max Clark (No. 12), IF Bryce Rainer (No. 41), C/IF Josue Briceño (No. 58), and C Thayron Liranzo (No. 88).

FOR WEST MICHIGAN: LHP Andrew "Psycho" Sears makes his 12th start of the season and his 16th appearance overall in game-one against the Loons after five scoreless innings of work back on July 1st - while striking out two in a 14-9 loss to the Loons to begin this series on July 1 at LMCU Ballpark. Sears has found his stride in High-A - posting a 5-2 record with a 2.72 ERA including a 22/67 walk-to-strikeout ratio and holding opposing hitters to a 196 BAA. Sears has also had an outstanding month of June - giving up just three runs through 17.2 innings pitched while striking out 21 hitters and walking just eight.

FOR GREAT LAKES: RHP Christian Romero makes his sixth start with the Loons and his 14th appearance overall after giving up three runs through four innings pitched in a 14-9 Loons win to begin this series on July 1 at LMCU Ballpark. Romero - who is a native of Hermosillo, Sonora, Mexico - had a rough month of June - giving up ten runs through 15.2 innings pitched - but has been able to control the zone - allowing just four walks in that stretch while registering 12 strikeouts.
