TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play their lone series of the season with the Hartford Yard Goats. Altoona went 3-3 against the Yard Goats in 2024 at Dunkin' Park.

BOMBS AWAY: Altoona matched a season-high with 6 extra base hits in an 11-4 win over the Portland Sea Dogs on Sunday, August 3. Nick Cimillo slugged his second career 2-homer game and Termarr Johnson smashed his 9th homer of the season

Cimillo is the first Curve batter to reach double figures in home runs this season and one of 12 Pirates minor leaguers to hit at least 10 home runs. **Esmerlyn Valdez** (20 w/ GBŎ) and **Javier Rivas** (18 w/ GBO) have hit the most homers by a Þirates minor

EZZY: Outfielder Esmerlyn Valdez has put together back-to-back strong performances to start Altoona's series at Portland. After recording a multi-RBI game in the series opener, Valdez picked up 3 hits in Altoona's 6-2 win over the Sea Dogs on July 30th. In his last 7 games, he is 8-for-26 with 4 RBI and 3 walks (.802 OPS).

MY VALENTIN: Righty Valentin Linarez has turned in one of the best seasons of his professional career in 2025. In addition to holding opponents to a career-low .196 BAA this season and a 1.18 WHIP, since June 10 he's allowed just 3 runs in 18.1 IP (1.45 ERA) and a 0.86 WHIP with 20 strikeouts.

JUSTIN'S MEIS: Since recording a 4.91 ERA in the month of May, Justin Meis has gone 3-2 with a 1.78 ERA with two saves in 16 games for the Curve. In that time he's recorded a 0.87 WHIP and walked just 4 batters in 25.1 innings with 30 strikeouts. Meis' 56 K's this season are 3rd-most by an Eastern League reliever.

WHERE ARE THE BATS: Altoona holds a .198 team batting average in the Second Half (Since June 23) the lowest among 120 full-season clubs, the team also ranks 116th in OPS (.605).

Pitching has been the team's savior of late. Altoona pitchers rank 5th among 120 minor league clubs in WHIP (1.13).

KELLY K'S: Righty Antwone Kelly struck out a career-high 9 batters in 4.2 innings on July 10 at Binghamton. The 21-year-old has struck out 28 batters in 25.1 innings to start July, <u>he holds a 0.99 WHIP which ranks T-9th among qualified minor league</u> pitchers. Kelly's 101 strikeouts this season are 2nd-most in the Pirates minor league system (Bubba Chandler, 106), tied with teammate Wilber Dotel (101).

CLOSE WINS: 16 of Altoona's last 21wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 49 of the team's 101games this year (49%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

THE NEW GUYS WHO THROW HARD: Righty Ryan Harbin has struck out 27 batters in 16.2 innings with Altoona. Harbin ranks 8th in the Pirates system in strikeouts (73) in 47.0 innings, every other pitcher in the top 14 in the system in strikeouts has throwin at least 60.0 IP. Harbin ranks 4th among MiLB relievers with 73 strikeouts.

Righty Brandon Bidois tossed 11.1 scoreless innings to begin his Curve career before allowing two unearned runs on July 19 against Akron. The Austrailian native has been unscored upon in 22-of-26 outings this season, going 1.0+ IP in 17 of his 26 outings, totaling 43 strikeouts in 38.2 innings this year.

CY YOUNG?: Lefty Cy Nielson has struck out 52 batters this season, 8th-most by an Eastern League reliever. Nielson has collected at least one strike out in 40-of-41 career outings with the Curve, racking up 84 in 66.1 IP.

ITALIANISSIMO: Righty Alessandro Ercolani has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 11 of his 20 outings this season, he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under an innings count this year, Ercolani is working on the best walk rate of his career, walking only 27 in 78.1 IP. His 2.88 BB/9 innings is the best mark of his career.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Bingnamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford Pitching Coach 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and ioins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.


