FISHER CATS TAKE GAME THREE 10-3: Tanner Kirwer went three-for-five including an inside-the-park home run, and Ryan Gold and Demi Orimoloye also went deep as the New Hampshire Fisher Cats (Toronto Blue Jays Double-A affiliate) rolled past Binghamton 10-3 on Thursday at Delta Dental Stadium. Nick Fraze (W, 1-0) allowed one run in five innings to earn his first win since joining the Fisher Cats (46-48). He allowed five hits, walked one, and struck out four.

2022 SCHEDULE RELEASE: The Fisher Cats released their 2022 schedule, featuring home matchups on Father's Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day Weekend. New Hampshire opens up the year on the road at Portland before their home opener on April 12th against Hartford. New Hampshire will also host Richmond, Erie, and Altoona for inter-divisional play.

GROSHANS/YOUNG STAY HOT: Jordan Groshans had two more hits last night to extend his hitting streak to a seasons-best eight games. The 21-year old, selected by the Blue Jays in the first round (12th overall) in the 2018 draft, has slashed .331/.407/.492 in 34 games since July 10. Reigning Double-A Northeast Player of the Week Chavez Young has followed up his 10-for-21 week at Hartford with a 4-8 to start this Binghamton series. Young has hits in 12 of his last 13 starts, including 3 HR and 12 RBI.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: August 27, 2017—Jon Harris improved to 7-10 with a 4-2 win over Hartford in Manchester. Harris allowed two runs on four hits over seven innings striking out eight. The Fisher Cats broke a 1-1 tie with a pair of runs in the bottom of the fifth inning. Alex Monsalve had an RBI single and Richard Urena drove in a run with a sacrifice fly.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays gave up four runs in the first and lost 5-2 to the White Sox. Lourdes Gurriel Jr. had a pair of hits and knocked in a run...Triple-A Buffalo lost 4-2 at home to Worcester. Danny Jansen, on a rehab assignment, knocked in a run with a sacrifice fly. He also had a hit...Hillsboro beat Vancouver 8-2. Lakeland handled Dunedin 12-2, and FCL Tigers won 6-4 over the Blue Jays with Brock Lundquist homering for a second straight day.

STARTERS:

Reilly Hovis starts tonight for the Fisher Cats. It will be his 10th start since joining the Fisher Cats – and second start against Binghamton. On July 9, allowed three runs in four innings in a game when also matched up against Cole Gordon. Did not factor in the decision in game New Hampshire won 7-3. Hovis, who's 27, joined the Fisher Cats from independent Gastonia. Despite a career mostly as a reliever, has been in New Hampshire's rotation since the end of June.

Binghamton's Cole Gordon was selected in the 32nd round of the 2019 draft out of Mississippi State. The 25-year old RHP has been in the rotation for the Rumble Ponies since June 5 when he started against the Fisher Cats here at Delta Dental Stadium. He allowed homers that night to Gabriel Moreno and Samad Taylor in a game New Hampshire won 8-3. Allowed two runs on July 9 in a start against New Hampshire in Binghamton. Went seven innings scoreless in Portland last Saturday to earn the win. Has allowed only five hits total in last four starts (24 innings). Over that span has struck out 32.
