

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped consecutive games for the first time in 2023, falling to the Dash, 12-7, on Wednesday night...Brooklyn rallied from down 4 to take the lead with a 5-run top of the 5th...LF Alex Ramírez roped a RBI double and DH Stanley Consuegra brought him home with a game-tying, 2-run home run...1B Warren Saunders put the Cyclones ahead with a single to right... Winston-Salem grabbed the lead for good with a 6-run top of the 6th...2B Loidel Chapellí produced a go-ahead, 2-run single and 1B D.J. Gladney followed with a 2-run knock of his own....RHP Trey McLoughlin hurled 2.1 scoreless frames of relief for the 'Clones to close out the night.

FULLY LOADED: Prior to Opening Day, Baseball Amer*ica* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball... The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

KING CÉSAR: INF César Berbesi has been celebrating well before his birthday on Thursday...The now-23year-old has reached base in each of his first 4 games in 2023...Berbesi is 5-for-13 (.385) at the plate with 5 runs scored, a triple, and a team-high-tying 4 RBI...Berbesi enters Thursday's game tied for the South Atlantic League lead in walks (7)...He is also tied for 5th in OBP (.600) and 10th in batting average (.385)...Berbesi has walked 73 times compared to only 80 strikeouts in 100 career games.

DE CAN'T STOP HIM: OF Omar De Los Santos is on a 5-game hitting streak to begin his Cyclones career... During the streak, the 23-year-old is 8-for-23 (.348) at the dish with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, and 2 RBI...The Dominican native has also picked up mul-tiple hits in 3-straight affairs (6/12, 2 R, HR, RBI, BB, 2 SB)...De Los Santos is also 3-for-3 on stolen base at-tempts and holds a .940 OPS...Entering Thursday, the fifth-year pro is tied for 2nd in the SAL in hits (8), tied for 3rd in total bases (13) and extra-base hits (3)...De Los Santos was tied for 3rd in Minor League Baseball in 2022 with 70 stolen bases and was named Florida State League MVP.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACES: LHP Quinn Brodey and RHP Manny Rodriguez made their Cyclones pitching debuts on Saturday afternoon...Brodey yielded one run on one hit, striking out a pair, in 2.1 innings...Rodri-guez did not permit a hit or run over 1.2 frames...As an outfielder, Brodey led Brooklyn in RBI (30) in 2017...Rodriguez appeared in 51 games as a shortstop with the franchise in 2018.

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn travels to North Carolina for their first matchup against the White Sox' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast nie of the Pale Hose top 30 prospects per Baseball America...RHP Norge Vera (8), RHP Jonathan Cannon (11), RHP Kohl Simas (13), OF Wilfred Veras (17), INF Wes Kath (18), OF Terrell Tatum (24), and INF Loideli Cha-pellí (26) are all on Winston-Salem's active roster...INF Col-son Montgomery (1) and RHP Jared Kelley (14) are currently on the injured list...The Cyclones went 7-5 in their first 12 matchups against the Dash in 2022...Brooklyn won 4-of-6 from Winston-Salem at Truist Park from September 6-11, the final series of the regular season.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)...Holds a career record of 105-92 (.533).

NEW DRAFT CLASS: The New York Mets' 2022 MLB draft class brings six arms and three bats to Coney Island in 2023...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2nd round), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6th), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (8th), RHP **Paul Ger**vase (12th), RHP Cameron Foster (14th), and RHP Jordan Geber (UDFA) all begin the season on pitching coach Victor Ramos' staff...C Kevin Parada — the No. 11 overall pick — joins INF Chase Estep (9th) and INF Brad Malm (UDFA) headlining the offensive firepower.

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America...*They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipe*line/No. 4 Baseball America), OF Alex Ramírez (4/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (7/9)...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.


