2023 vs RailRidars

Last season, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders came to Werner Park to play the Omaha Storm Chasers (August 22-28) for the first time since the Chasers moved to the International League in 2021. The two teams split the series 3-3, with the RailRiders winning the first three, but Omaha taking the last three, including a doubleheader sweep on Sunday, August 28.

Prior to last season, the teams met for 12 games in what was the Triple-A alliance (1988-1991) when the Omaha Royals played in the American Association and the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Red Barons played in the International League.

Omaha played 5 of those 12 games at what was then known as Lackawanna County Stadium, winning 2 of 3 in 1989 and split two games August 7-8 1990. (h/t Adam Marco)

NOTES AND NUGGETS BLAZING BLANCO

With two steals yesterday, outfielder **Dairon Blanco** has 20 steals in 21 attempts this year, tied for the International League lead in steals and he has steals in 5 straight games Blanco's 20th steal of the season last year with the Storm Chasers did not come until July 12, his 46th game of the year ... by the end of the season, he stole 45 bases in 107 games, an average of one steal every 2.38 games.

This year, Blanco's 20 steals in 27 games are an average of one every 1.35 games After being caught stealing on April 22, he's 12 for his last 12, including all 3 of his multi-steal games this season in that span of 12 games.

Blanco is also responsible for the longest active hitting and on-base streaks for Storm Chasers players ... his 5-game hitting streak since May 5 is the only active streak for an Omaha player longer than 1 game, a span in which he's hitting 471 (8-for-17) with a 1.374 OPS ... in his 7-game on-base streak since April 30, Blanco has a .552 on-base percentage, with 9 hits, 5 walks and 2 hit-by-pitches.

SEEING IT LIKE CJ

CJ Alexander's solo home run in the 9th inning yesterday was his 5th of the season but Omaha's first 9th-inning homer of the year as well.

Among 10 Storm Chasers players with at least 60 plate appearances, Alexander's 95.7mph average exit velocity on base hits this season is the hardest ... 4 of the 20 hardest hits for Omaha hitters this year have come from Alexander, the most times any player appears in that group.

CHALLENGING THE SYSTEM

With the ABS Challenge system in place through the end of the series, Omaha will try and improve on its successful challenge rate, just 1-for-8 to begin the year.

Omaha began the season 0-for-5 in challenges, before Brewer Hicklen had the club's first successful challenge last Sunday, May 7, when he challenged a 3-2 pitch called for strike three, that was overturned as ball four.

After the team's first four challenges came in 0-0 or 1-0 counts, all four challenges last Sunday game in 3-2 counts, though the team found itself out of challenges by the end of the fifth inning, the first time this season they an out of challenges.

MANAGER: Mike Jirschele • #23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- From He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.






