The Lugnuts cruised last night, giving the Nuts three wins in the first four games of the series and five of their last six.

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, Dragons 1. 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria** tossed five scoreless innings, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** went 3-for-5 with a two-run single, and the Nuts knocked off the orange-clad Dragons in a brisk two hours and 28 minutes in front of 7,786 at Day Air Ballpark.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Dragons conclude their series tomorrow, enjoy a day off on June 9, and then the Nuts return to Michigan's state capital to welcome in the archrival West Michigan Whitecaps for a six-game series at Jackson Field from June 10 - June 15.

Fountain of Youth: Lefty **Rich Hill**, who pitched for the Lugnuts in 2003 (0-1, 2.76, 15 G, 4 GS, 29 1/3 IP, 14 H, 0 HR, 36 BB, 50 K, 9 WP), receives the start today for Omaha against Iowa, working his way toward a potential Major League return with the Kansas City Royals - who would be his 14th different Major League team. Hill is 90-74 with a 4.01 ERA in 386 career appearances, 248 MLB starts, spanning 1,409 innings from 2005-2024.

A Gauge on Gage: 2025 Lugnuts Opening Day starter **Gage Jump** jumped into MLB Pipeline's Top 100 prospects yesterday at No. 100, replacing Baltimore's Coby Mayo. Jump also joined Baseball America's Top 100 prospects, going from being unrated to coming in at No. 71, and was named Minor League Baseball's May Pitcher of the Month for the Texas League, going 4-0 in four starts with a 0.72 ERA: 25 innings, 15 hits, 2 runs, 5 walks, 29 strikeouts, 0.80 WHIP, .176 avg. Overall for the year, Jump is 8-1 with a 1.61 ERA and 74 K / 10 BB in 56 innings. He starts tonight for the RockHounds vs. San Antonio at 8:05 p.m..

Midwest League Outlook: With 11 games remaining in the MWL's first half, first place West Michigan leads Lansing by seven games in the East Division, 38-17 to 31-24. Next week, the Whitecaps travel to Lansing for a pivotal six-game series before the Lugnuts wrap up the first half at Quad Cities while West Michigan hosts Wisconsin.

In a Nutshell: Enters second season in the Midwest League... started Lugnuts' third game of the year, April 6 at Fort Wayne, and fanned eight TinCaps in four hitless innings... April 19 at Wisconsin: tossed the first complete game of the season in the Midwest League, firing six innings in the series finale, : 75 pitches, 47 strikes, seven hits, two runs, one walk, one strikeout, in a 2-0 loss – the Lugnuts' only loss of the series.

No-No History: Facing the Cedar Rapids Kernels on June 13, 2024, relieved Jake Garland to open the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 combined no-hitter of the Kernels... it was the 4th no-hitter in franchise history as well as the first home no-hitter since 2003.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the 2017 Big Ten season ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.
