# INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Columbus Clippers countered a three-run, go-ahead home run by Andrés Alvarez with seven homers of their own and a 12-run ninth inning to defeat the Indianapolis Indians 23-5 on Thursday night at Victory Field. Following Alvarez's fourth home run of the season in the bottom of the third to give Indianapolis a 3-2 lead, Columbus tacked on five runs in the fourth and never looked back. The Clippers' scoring was highlighted by the 12-run ninth that included four home runs – two by Bryan Lavastida and the second and third long balls of the night by Johnathan Rodriguez, making him the fifth opposing batter since 1996 to record a three-homer game against the Indians. George Valera and Micah Pries started the onesided slugfest with home runs in the fourth and fifth innings, respectively.

**ABOUT IT ALL:** The 23 runs allowed last night are the most given up by Indianapolis since at least 1996, and the 18-run margin of defeat trails only a 20-1 setback vs. Syracuse on July 15, 2019, for the worst in that time frame. Indy's seven home runs allowed also tied the Victory Field era record, previously reached in the aforementioned game vs. Syracuse. The 12-run ninth inning is the largest inning by an opposing team at Victory Field on record and second-most since 1996, behind a 13-run, third-inning burst at Rochester on July 20, 1998. The Indians' pitching staff allowed 22 hits, matching the amount it surrendered in Tuesday's 15-4 loss to Columbus.

TEAM STATS: As a team, the Indians lead the International League with a .271 batting average (517-for-1910) and 30 sacrifice flies. They also rank among top-10 team leaders in triples (2nd, 16), hits (T-3rd), doubles (6th, 108), on-base percentage (T-8th, .354), OPS (9th, .781) and slugging percentage (9th, .427).

ALL IN FOR ALVAREZ: After going 4-for-5 with three runs and a triple to tie his career high in hits on Wednesday afternoon, Andrés Alvarez launched his fourth home run of the season to give the Indians a 3-2 lead in the third inning. Three of his four home runs have come in his last 12 games since May 23 at lowa, and in that time he has a .311 batting average (14-for-45) with nine runs, four extra-base hits and seven RBI. His four-hit performance on Wednesday was the second of his career, the first coming with High-A Greensboro on July 1, 2021, at Bowling Green. Down 3-0, he jumpstarted the Indians offense with a triple and subsequent throwing error, resulting in a little league home run.

SPEEDY MIKE: Mike Jarvis went 3-for-4 last night with two runs and a double to lead the Indians offense. He doubled in the third inning before coming around to score on Andrés Alvarez' go-ahead three-run home run. He then scored again in the bottom of the ninth on Malcom Nuñez's two-run double. The performance was his second multi-hit game of the series and season, going 2-for-3 in the series-opener on Tuesday with his first triple since June 22, 2023, with High-A Greensboro vs. Winston-Salem. His three hits also tied his career high, which occurred five times during the 2023 season and was last matched on July 27 with Double-A Altoona at Harrisburg.

MATT FOR MORE BASES: Matt Gorski, a native of Fishers, Ind., has carried a scorching-hot May into June, going 1-for-3 with a double and two walks last night. The two-bagger was his 17th extra-base hit since May 16, the most in the International League in that time. On Sunday, he launched his 10th home run dating back to May 16. In that time, he leads all International League batters in home runs, RBI (28), slugging percentage (.829) and total bases (63). He also ranks among leaders in runs (T-4th. 19), triples (T-2nd. 2), OPS (4th. 1.197) and hits (T-5th, 24). Nine of his 11 homers this season came in May, which were the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and are the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007

CELLY WILL WALK (500 MILES): Gilberto Celestino drew three of the Indians six walks last night, coming around to score two runs in the contest. It was the sixth three-walk performance by an Indians batter this season, following Jake Lamb (April 24 at OMA), Nick Gonzales (May 8 at LOU), Malcom Nuñez and Canaan Smith-Njigba (May 21 at IOW) and Liover Peguero (May 22 at IOW). It was also his most individual walks since Sept. 20, 2023, with St. Paul vs. Toledo.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue their 13-game homestand with the fourth game of a six-game set vs. the Columbus Clippers, Triple-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, today at 7:05 PM ET at Victory Field. The Indians went 1-6 against the Omaha Storm Chasers to begin the homestand, and are looking to retie the series tonight against the worst record in the International League. Continuing the series today for Indianapolis is LHP Nick Dombkowski (1-1, 5.56) making his first career appearance vs. Columbus and second start this season with Indianapolis. Countering for the Clippers tonight is RHP Darren McCaughan (2-2, 5.61), making his first appearance against Indianapolis after spending five seasons (2018-23) in the Pacific Coast League

**THIS DATE IN 2019:** With 13 strikeouts at Toledo, Mitch Keller broke his career-record of 11 strikeouts and became just the fourth pitcher in the Victory Field era to strikeouts 13 or more in a game. His Ks were the most since Ian Snell struck out 17 on June 28, 2009 vs. Toledo. The Indians would go on to lose the game, 3-1, at the hands of the bullpen, giving the Pirates No. 1 prospect the no-decision.
