LAST OUTING: Boushley last pitched on September 17 vs. Jacksonville. He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings, holding Jacksonville to four hits and a walk in a quality start. Striking out four, Boushley totaled 56 of 88 pitches for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley is facing Louisville for the third time in his career, with the previous two outings coming at First Horizon Park in May.
