WEDNESDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Sea Dogs, 18-4, setting a new season high for runs scored. Richmond took a 6-0 lead in the second inning. **Adrián Sugastey** opened the scoring with an RBI double, **Christian Koss** hit a ground-rule double, **Carter Howell** added a two-run double, **Will Wilson** doubled in a run and **Brady Whalen** clubbed an RBI single. Portland's Roman Anthony cut the score to 6-1 with a solo homer in the third. The Flying Squirrels added four runs to pull ahead, 10-1, in the fifth. **Victor Bericoto** hit an RBI double, Sugastey was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded, Bericoto scored on a wild pitch and **Brandon Martorano** brought home a run with a sacrifice fly. The Sea Dogs picked up a two-run double by Tyler McDonough and an RBI single by Marcelo Mayer to pull back within six. Richmond scored eight runs in the sixth inning to stretch the lead to 18-4. Bericoto hit an RBI single, Wilson scored on a wild pitch, **Jairo Pomares** hit a two-run homer, Koss belted a three-run double and **Carter Howell** plated a run with a sac fly. **Wil Jensen** started and allowed one run over 3.2 innings. **Eric Silva** picked up his third win of the season with two scoreless innings, striking out three. **Jose Cruz** threw a scoreless ninth inning and struck out the side.

TODAY'S GAMES: The Flying Squirrels face the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, in the third and fourth of a six-game series on the second leg of a 12-game road trip to New England. This week's series is the final road set for the Flying Squirrels this year against the Northeast Division. It is also the only series between these two teams this year. In the Flying Squirrels' only other doubleheader this season, they swept Reading, 9-1 and 3-1, on May 16 at The Diamond.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 4-1 dating back to last Friday. They had gone 4-10 in their previous 14 games from May 29-June 11 and 11-2 in the previous 13 games from May 25-28. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won three-of-their-last-five series, taking five-of-six in back-to-back series against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9 and then winning four-of-six last week at New Hampshire. Over the last seven games since June 12, the Flying Squirrels offense is leading the league in batting average (.318), runs (58), hits (85), RBIs (54), walks (33), OBP (.396), SLG (.502) and OPS (.898) and are tied for first in doubles (20). In those seven games, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 8.3 runs per game and 12.1 hits per game.

THE SEA DOGS are in second place in the Northeast Division, one game behind first-place Hartford with four games remaining in the season's first half. For the season, the Sea Dogs lead the league in batting average (.269), runs (365), hits (585), doubles (155), RBIs (337), walks (271), OBP (.357), SLG (.439) and OPS (.796). Portland's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including OF Roman Anthony (No. 1), SS Marcelo Meyer (No. 2), C Kyle Teel (No. 3), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 5), 3B Blaze Jordan (No. 17), INF/OF Eddinson Paulino (No. 20), RHP Hunter Dobbins (No. 25), RHP Angel Bastardo (No. 26) and INF Kristian Campbell (No. 30). The roster also includes 10 players ranked on MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list, including Mayer (No. 1), Anthony (No. 2), Teel (No. 3), Gonzalez (No. 5), Jordan (No. 19), Paulino (No. 22), Dobbins (No. 25), Bastardo (No. 26), RHP Bryan Mata (No. 27) and Campbell (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Dylan Cumming** makes his third Double-A start in Game 1. He last pitched last Friday at New Hampshire and allowed two runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. On the year, he ranks fifth in the Giants system in strikeouts (63). Among Giants minor league pitchers (min. 40 IP), he leads the organization in K/9 (12.24) and strikeout percentage (33.9%). Cumming began the year with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in nine games (seven starts). He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month in April after going 1-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/18.0 IP) in five games (four starts). On April 17 against Vancouver, Cumming started and threw three innings in a combined no-hitter with Nick Sinacola and Seth Corry. In his final start for the Emeralds on May 22 against Spokane, he set a career high with nine strikeouts over five innings in a win. Cumming spent last year with Low-A San Jose in his professional debut season, going 7-3 with a 2.93 ERA in 34 games (seven starts). He worked as a reliever most of the season before making starts across July, August and September. Cumming began his collegiate career at Chicago State, where he pitched three seasons before the program was disbanded in 2020. He pitched his final two seasons at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va., and was with the Burlington Sock Puppets in the 2022 summer, where he was selected as an Appalachian League All-Star. Cumming signed with the San Francisco Giants as a non-drafted free agent on February 25, 2023. **For more on Cumming, see page two.**

In Game 2, left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his 13th start of the season and the fourth of his career against the Sea Dogs. In his most recent start last Saturday at New Hampshire, Bertrand threw five scoreless innings despite issuing a career-high five walks. It was his seventh scoreless start of the year, all at least five innings. In the Eastern League this season, Bertrand ranks second in groundball percentage (54.0), fifth in ERA (2.91), eighth in BB/9 (2.51), eighth in walk percentage (6.8), ninth in HR/9 (0.66), 10th in innings pitched (68.0) and 10th in WHIP (1.15). Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. He has made six scoreless starts this year, all at least five innings. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Juan Daniel Encarnacion makes his second Double-A start in Game 1. He made his debut last Friday at Reading and was charged with a loss after allowing a season-high seven runs over 2.1 innings. Encarnacion started his season with High-A Greenville and went 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA in nine starts. He also pitched for the Drive last season and went 4-9 with a 6.32 in 24 outings (21 starts). Encarnacion signed with the Red Sox as an international free agent in 2018. He made his professional debut in 2021 with the FCL Red Sox and was named a Florida Complex League Post-Season All-Star that year.

In Game 2, Bryan Mata makes his second start with Portland on a rehab assignment from the Boston Red Sox. He pitched on May 23 against Hartford and allowed three runs in a loss over three innings. Mata has been on Boston's injured list since the beginning of the season with a right hamstring strain. He also pitched with Portland in 2019 and 2022. For his Double-A career, Mata is 9-9 with a 3.61 ERA in 23 games (22 starts). Last year, he made nine appearances (seven starts) for Triple-A Worcester, going 0-3 with a 6.33 ERA while missing time with shoulder inflammation. He missed the 2021 season after having Tommy John surgery.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fourth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,008).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: **Andy Thomas** is batting .309 (30-for-97) over his last 27 games since May 15 with two homers, seven doubles, a triple and 18 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .260. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. Last Wednesday at New Hampshire, he went 3-for-3 with a walk and caught a shutout. He finished the series with seven hits in five games started.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 11 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with three homers, four doubles, five walks and 11 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on Friday night and added a homer on Tuesday. In his last 21 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .313 (25-for-80) with six homers, five doubles, 11 walks and 20 RBIs.

HELLO, JAIRO: In the current road trip, **Jairo Pomares** is batting .419 (13-for-31) with four homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs. Last Tuesday, he picked up a pair of hits, including a double, and set a season high with three RBIs. He matched the three RBIs and homered last Thursday night, adding a double. Pomares homered for the second straight game on Friday night, one of his two hits in that game. He homered again on Sunday, his third homer of the series in New Hampshire. Pomares went 3-for-5 with a double to open the series at Portland on Tuesday and hit a two-run homer on Wednesday.

MARTY PARTY: **Brandon Martorano** hit his first Double-A homer of the year on Saturday night, a two-run shot in the Flying Squirrels' 3-2 win over the Fisher Cats. In his four games with Richmond, Martorano is batting .313 (5-for-16) with the homer and a walk. In parts of four seasons with the Flying Squirrels, Martorano has played 201 games. His 23 career homers are tied for ninth in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with **Tyler Fitzgerald**, **Dylan Davis** and **Hunter Cole** and two behind the next spot on the list, with 25 by **Frankie Tostado** in eighth.

SERVING UP THE DONUTS: On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels threw their ninth shutout win of the season, which is tied with Akron for the most in the Eastern League this season, both one ahead of third-place Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels have pitched shutouts in six-of-their-last-10 wins dating back to May 25. Last week, they started and ended the series in New Hampshire with 5-0 shutout wins on Tuesday and Sunday.

KOSS-OME: In his return to Portland, **Christian Koss** has hit .778 (7-for-9) with three doubles, five RBIs and a steal in the first two games of this week's series. Koss played for the Sea Dogs the last two seasons and was named the team's MVP in 2022. In those two seasons, he played 163 games for the Sea Dogs, batting .252. Koss started the season with Richmond and played three games before an injury placed him on the injured list from mid-April through early-June. In his 15 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, he is batting .415 (22-for-53), which is second-highest in the Eastern League (min. 50 PA) this season, trailing only Portland's Kristian Campbell (.421).

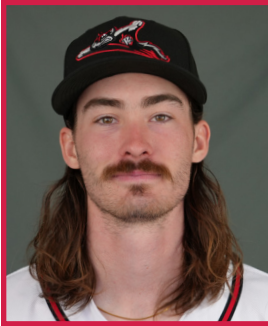
