**This Evening:** Coming off a doubleheader yesterday, the Lugnuts play the third game of a six-game series tonight at the Cedar Rapids Kernels, Lansing's only road trip at a West Division team this season. 23-year-old right-hander **Richard Guasch** makes his sixth start of the season for the Nuts, opposed by 24-year-old Kernels right-hander **Ben Gross** in his eighth start.

**On Deck:** The Nuts and Kernels play night games through Saturday and a matinee on Sunday before Lansing returns home for a six-game series vs. Dayton, concluding on the 4th of July.

**On the Air:** Tonight's game is on MiLB.TV with broadcaster **Chris Kleinhans-Schulz**, and streaming online at <http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing>, with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** on the call.

**Last Night: G1 - Kernels 4, Lugnuts 0.** On a 1-2 pitch with two outs in the bottom of the 6th, Cedar Rapids center fielder **Gabriel Maciel** walked off with a grand slam against Nuts lefty **David Leal**, giving the Kernels a dramatic series-opening win. Leal struck out seven batters in 4 2/3 innings of relief in the loss, with the Nuts' offense held to just one hit - an **Elvis Peralta**, Jr. fourth-inning single.

**Last Night: G2 - Cinco Estaciones 1, Locos 0.** **Spencer Steer** scored the game's only run in the bottom of the 6th on a two-out throwing error by Lugnuts third baseman **Jordan Diaz**, finishing the sweep.

**What's New in 2021:** Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

### LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

**Meet the Boss:** **Scott Steinmann** is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

**Alumni Report:** 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, leads the Majors in OBP (.442), slugging percentage (.664), OPS (1.106) and total bases (172); is tied for 1st in home runs (23) and RBIs (60); and ranks 2nd in batting average (.340). Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** leads the Majors in runs scored (61) with Guerrero, Jr. tied for fourth (55).

**Blanks:** The Lugnuts' last run came in the 3rd inning on Sunday in a 7-1 loss to Great Lakes. Since then, they have held been scoreless for the last 20 innings. In the last three games total, Lansing has been outscored 12-1 with a total of eight hits in 23 innings.

**Man of Steal:** Infielder **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) leads all of Minor League Baseball with 29 stolen bases, one more than South Bend's Delvin Zinn, and eight more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield. Schuemann is tied for second in the Minors with 12 HBPs and is second in the High-A Central with 35 runs scored.

**Costly Mistakes:** The Lugnuts have committed the fourth highest fielding percentage in the High-A Central (.972) with the second-most total chances in the circuit (1583 to the Loons' 1584) and the most assists (388), but Lansing has also committed a league high 14 passed balls, helping to lead to a league high 49 unearned runs, including the only run of last night's Game 2.

**Hail to Arms:** The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.71 earned run average with the second fewest walks in the league (142) and fifth most strikeouts (450). That success has led to the promotion of the team's top two relievers to Double-A, **Jack Weisenburger** and **Aiden McIntyre**.

**Indicator of Success:** When the Nuts outthit the opposition, they are 14-1 this season. When they get outthit, they are 3-20, with two of the wins coming last series vs. Great Lakes.

**Three's the Charm... Right?** This is the fifth time this year that the Lugnuts have lost three games in a row. Each of the prior four times saw the Nuts right the ship, ending the skid at three.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2011:** The Lugnuts opened up the second half with a walk-off, tying the Loons in the eighth on Matt Nuzzo's RBI double and K.C. Hobson's RBI single, and then winning it in the 11th on Hobson's two-run homer, 6-4.

**2012:** The wild Great Lakes Loons issued seven consecutive two-out walks in the top of the fifth, leading to nine Lugnuts runs in the frame. Jose Dominguez gave out the first four, walking in two runs, followed by three walks from Juan Rodriguez. Rodriguez walked two more batters in the sixth, as the Nuts drew 10 walks on their way to a 13-6 victory.

**Major League Lugnuts:** Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18, outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, and pitcher **Tayler Saucedo** '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

**Record-Setting, for Better or Worse:** On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor**'s franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons. On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three home runs served up in a game by giving up four homers to the Loons.

**So Many Starters:** The Lugnuts have now used 13 different starting pitchers this season, namely **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Jeff Criswell**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

**Familiar Settings:** 10 of the 28 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

**A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You:** **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut to hail from Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti. Earlier this season, the Nuts featured two Michigan Wolverines in **Jeff Criswell** (injured) and **Jack Weisenburger** (promoted).

**Finally:** Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Guldborg** are all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

**Front Office Connections:** Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

**Clubhouse of Higher Learning:** The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

**Power Five Baseball:** The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldborg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Dalton Sawyer**, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Cobie Vance**, Alabama, and **Ryan Gridley**, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

**International Appeal:** In addition to 17 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

**Representing His Country:** 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

**Teammates Then, Teammates Now:** Several of the Nuts are more than a little familiar with one another. **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake. Coincidentally, Peluse was hosted on his own Wake Forest college visit by 2019 Lugnuts infielder **Johnny Aiello**.

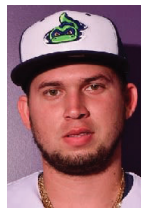

**Personal:** The first letter of Richard's last name is pronounced with an "h" sound, as in "hwahsh"... rated Baseball America's No. 35 Oakland prospect, with his slider rated as the best in the organization.

**Last Outing:** Started June 17 vs. Great Lakes, receiving no-decision... whiffed eight batters in five innings, allowing two runs on four hits, three walks and three HBPs... Lugnuts won, 4-3, scoring four unearned runs thanks to four Loons errors... stranded bases loaded in the 1st, stranded two in the 2nd... stranded one in the 3rd... stranded two in the 4th... finished with a perfect 5th.

### 2021 in the High-A Central:

- Opened the season as the No. 3 starter in the Lugnuts' rotation, working 2 1/3 scoreless innings on May 6th vs. Lake County... struggled with command, working around a one-out walk in the 1st inning with a strikeout of top prospect George Valera... hit a batter and walked a batter in the 2nd inning but stranded runners at the corners... gave up a double and a walk in the 3rd inning, but responded by striking out Valera and cleanup hitter Jonathan Engelmann before he was relieved in favor of Bryce Nightengale, who escaped the jam... departed with the Lugnuts leading, 3-0, only to see bullpen relinquish the lead in a 7-6 loss.

- Relieved Shohei Tomioka in a piggyback assignment on Thursday, May 13th, at Dayton... struck out six Dragons in four innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits and a walk in a no-decision... relieved Tomioka starting the 3rd inning, allowing a home run to Jose Tello, the second batter faced; Victor Ruiz followed with a single, but was erased on a strike 'im out, throw 'im out double play... pitched around singles by James Free and Jonathan Willems in a scoreless 4th... whiffed Quincy McAfee and Ruiz in a perfect 5th... in frustrating 6th, walked Quin Cotton on a 3-2 pitch, Cotton stole 2nd and then stole 3rd on a strikeout of James Free, coming home on a throwing error by catcher Jared McDonald, giving Dayton an enormous insurance run, on their way to a 4-2 win over the Lugnuts.

- Pitched brilliantly in a start Thursday, May 20, at Fort Wayne, tossing five scoreless innings while allowing two hits, two walks, and striking out seven... pitched around an Agustin Ruiz single in the 1st inning... allowed a leadoff double to Justin Lopez in the 2nd inning and wild-pitched him to third, then struck out the side to strand him... walked Adam Kerner and Reinaldo Ibarra to open the 3rd and wild-pitched them to scoring position, but stranded them there... struck out two in a perfect 4th... struck out his seventh batter in a perfect 5th... Lugnuts went on to win, 12-1.

- Disaster on May 27: Richard relieved Seth Shuman with two outs in the 3rd inning, held the Great Lakes Loons scoreless in the 4th and 5th innings, and then was charged with eight unearned runs in the 6th on three walks, three errors behind him, an HBP, a fielder's choice, a dropped sacrifice fly, and zero hits... Charles Hall relieved him and gave up a pair of two-run singles in a nine-run inning, and the Loons went on to win, 10-1.

- Dominance on June 3: Richard mesmerized the South Bend Cubs, posting six scoreless three-hit innings, walking one and striking out eight... departed with the Lugnuts leading 4-0, only to see the Cubs rally for three runs in the 7th and two in the 9th for a 5-4 comeback win... eight strikeouts tied career high for most in an appearance.

- After allowing 1 ER in his first 20 1/3 innings, Richard gave up four runs on nine hits in four innings at West Michigan on June 10, jumping his ERA from 0.44 to 1.85... removed after facing three batters in the 5th and not recording an out; lefty Dalton Sawyer allowed a run on a sacrifice fly but stranded the other two runners... Guasch was charged with the loss as the Lugnuts fell, 10-0.

**2019:** Received one start with the Vermont Lake Monsters on June 19th, going four innings, allowing no runs, with five strikeouts and one walk, spending the rest of his 2019 season in Beloit, where he pitched in 18 games, 10 starts, and finished the year with a 4.53 ERA, 77 strikeouts / 37 walks, and just one home run allowed.

**2018:** Made his professional debut in DSL rookie league as a member of the A's starting rotation, pitching in seven games, starting five, with an ERA of 1.16 in 23.1 IP, walking four while striking out 27 in a stunningly impressive campaign.

**The Road to MLB:** At age 20, signed with the Oakland Athletics as an international free agent on July 13th, 2018... scout: Juan C. De La Cruz, who also signed teammate Rafael Kelly.

**Coming Up in Cuban Baseball:** First gained notice after reached the national championship game while pitching for Santiago de Cuba's 11- and 12-year-old team... pitched in 2013 at the U15 National Championship, where he went 8-0 with a 2.12 ERA and a team-leading 70 strikeouts... unfortunately, this experience damaged his elbow, preventing him from competing in 2014 at the U18 National Championship... appeared in the 2015 U18 National Championship, recording a 5-1 record with a 1.99 ERA in seven outings... went 8-2 with a 0.62 ERA in the 2016 U18 National Championship... member of Cuba's 2017 Pan-American team... also in 2017, Richard's father died, causing him to make the decision to leave Cuba and seek his fortune pitching professionally in MLB... he lived for three months in Mexico, two months in Guatemala, and then formally moved to the Dominican Republic... originally expected to sign with the Philadelphia Phillies, but after complications emerged, signed instead with Oakland. **Santiago de Cuba:** Richard hails from the second largest city in Cuba and the capital city of Santiago de Cuba Province... it lies in the southeastern area of the island 540 miles southeast of the Cuban capital of Havana... historically, Santiago de Cuba has been the second-most important city on the island after Havana, and remains the second-largest (Havana)... the city features a bay connected to the Caribbean Sea and is a major port... total population as of 2020: 1,253,838... also from Santiago de Cuba: Orestes Destrade, Adeiny Hechavarria and Barbaro Garbey.
