ABOUT LAST NIGHT: For the second-consecutive game, RHP **Garrison Bryant** tossed a quality start leading to a Brooklyn win. Saturday night, the Cyclones beat the Jersey Shore BlueClaws 6-2 in front of 4,837. Bryant struck out four and allowed two runs, both solo home runs, and three other hits over six innings. Offensively, the Cyclones scored two in the bottom of the first on a two-run single from OF **Tanner Murphy**. OF **Matt Rudick** added two more runs on a single in the fourth. RHP **Grant Hartwig** tossed a scoreless ninth, lowering his Brooklyn ERA to 0.69.

FIVE MILLION: Yesterday, Catherine Bruning was celebrated as the five-millionth fan. The Cyclones crossed over the plateau into 5,000,000 on Friday night. Bruning threw out a ceremonial first pitch, received a special Brooklyn jersey, and joined the Brooklyn Cyclones Radio Network for a mid-game interview.

SECOND HALF START: Thursday, June 24th, marked the start of the second half of the season in the South Atlantic League. Brooklyn finished the first half 30-36 and, while the full season record is still kept, all 12 teams' records reset to 0-0 to begin the second half. Aberdeen won the North Division, while Bowling Green won the South. The final 66 games of the season determine the next two teams to make the playoffs.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 28 home runs in the past 34 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

JT JOLTING!: 1B **JT Schwartz** clobbered a three-run home run on Sunday at Wilmington, his second

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia farm system returns to Maimonides Park for the first time since the opening home series of the year April 12-17. This season, the Cyclones have won 12 of the 17 games in the series. Jersey Shore hosts nine of Philly's Top 30 prospects, including No. 1 and No. 2 prospects RHP Andrew Painter and RHP Mick Abel. OF Johan Rojas is the No. 4 prospect in the organization.

of the season. During June, Schwartz is hitting .309 with a .356 on-base percentage. The No. 19 New York Mets prospect, according to MLB Pipeline, is slugging .460 after slugging just .317 in May and .362 in April. During this month, Schwartz has hits in 14 of 19 games.

THE GRANT POOBAH: RHP **Grant Hartwig** earned his sixth save of the year earlier in the week, sitting one off the the league leader (Jason Ruffcorn -- Jersey Shore -- 7). Hartwig is a perfect six for six in saves and owns a staff-best 44% strikeout rate. The former Miami RedHawks pitcher has allowed just one run in 13 innings.

ARMS STRONG: Brooklyn arms have posted a 3.37 earned run average in 25 games with 15 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

MURPHY'S NEW LAW: OF **Tanner Murphy** has been on a tear over his past nine games, going 12-25 (.480) with a double, triple, and two home runs -- good for an .840 slugging percentage over the stretch and a 1.392 OPS. Murphy is hitting .267 over 26 games with Brooklyn this year. Last year, Murphy hit just .181 through 23 High-A games.

MORE-ENO: Luis Moreno makes his third start at High-A and fourth South Atlantic League appearance.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on Wednesday, June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as “quality starts.”

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

ELIMINATING HOMERS: Moreno’s 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
