Double the Fun in Richmond

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Friday afternoon. Richmond holds the 3-0 edge in this week's series after winning the series in 2023 8-1. Reading was swept in their lone trip to Richmond last season, a series-opening three game series. This is the lone series between the teams this season as their won't be a trip to Reading.

Double Trouble

The Fightin Phils fell at Richmond in both ends of the doubleheader on Thursday night. Richmond dominated game one to a 9-1 victory as Efrain Contreras could not make it out of the second inning, allowing six runs on five hits and fell to 0-3. Matt Russell was strong out of the bullpen in game one with two-scoreless frames on the mound. Jose Rodriguez had two hits, including a double, and run scored in game one. In game two, Reading fell 3-1. Lachlan Wells fell to 1-2 after allowing three runs on six hits, with five strikeouts over five innings. Tyler McKay kept his ERA spotless with a clean sixth inning. Jose Rordigruez had two more hits, including another double. Caleb Ricketts had two hits and a RBI. It marked the second time this season Reading was swept in a doubleheader and the second-straight season they were swept in a twin bill at Richmond.

Double Doubl

Reading set a new season-high with five doubles in Wednesday night's game. It surpassed the Fightin Phils previous season-high of four doubles in a game. Reading's season-high for doubles in a game last season was five, which they did five times. Carson Taylor and Robert Moore each had two doubles in the loss, tying the most by a R-Phils player in a game this season. Moore leads Reading with seven doubles this season, and Taylor is right behind him at six two-baggers. Jose Rodriguez had two doubles between both games on Thursday night to move into a tie for second with six doubles as well.

Carson Crushin' It

Carson Taylor's red-hot season continued on Wednesday night. Taylor had three hits, a run, two doubles and two RBI. His .322 average is fourth in the Eastern League. His 29 RBI also lead the Eastern League and are second all of Double-A. His other Eastern League ranks are third in OBP (.417), fourth in SLG% (.552) and fourth in OPS (.969).

Pinpoint Pina

Robinson Pina pitched six innings for the second time this season, and has now earned a winning decision in his last four starts. Pina is tied for the Eastern League lead in wins with four, which also ranks as tied for second in Double-A. Pina has the best strikeout to walk ratio in the Eastern League by a wide margin at 12, with second place sitting at 6.40. That mark also leads all of Double-A and is tied for sixth in all of Minor League Baseball. Pina's 10.8 strikeout-per-nine ratio also ranks as ninth in the Eastern League. Over his last four starts Pina is: 4-0, with a 2.86 ERA (22 IP, 3 BB, 29 SO).

Noah's Arc-ing Up

Noah Skirrow has put together the two best outings of his season over his last two starts. After a month of April that saw Skirrow go 0-2, with an 11.81 ERA, Skirrow did not pitch for 10 days, as he was on the Development List during Reading's series in Portland from Apr. 30-May 5. Since coming off the Development List, Skirrow has been locked in during his two May starts. Following six-strong innings last night, Skirrow is 1-0, with a 0.82 ERA in May.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 17, 2023: At Somerset, the Fightin Phils ride dominating pitching to a 9-1 morning-game win. The staff combined to strike out 19 Patriots' hitters, which was a season high and most for Reading in a nine-inning game since May 8, 2021. Griff McGarry (5), Cristian Hernandez (5), Adam Leverett (4) and Max Kuhns (5) combined for the effort.

Richmond Roundup

Richmond enters today with a 15-21 record, which is fifth in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels were swept on the road at Erie last week, and entered this week's series on an eight-game losing streak, which was snapped on Wednesday night. After this week, Richmond is back on the road at Bowie. Last season, Richmond finished 74-64 and lost to Erie in the first round of the playoffs. Richmond's roster features seven of the Giants top-30 prospects, including: Hayden Birdsong (6), Grant McCray (13), Vaun Brown (15), Victor Bericoto (19), Adrian Sugastey (23), Jairo Pomares (26) and Carson Ragsdale (30).

Squirrel on the Bump

Lefty John Michael Betrand makes the start this afternoon for Richmond. This season he is 2-1, with a 2.72 ERA over seven games and six starts (36.1 IP, 35 H, 10 BB, 24 SO). He last pitched on May 10 at Erie, suffering the loss after allowing five runs on eight hits over 4.2 innings against the Seawolves. He split last season between Single-A San Jose, High-A Eugene in Richmond in what was his first full-professional season, combining to go 11-5, with a 3.65 ERA over 27 appearances and 19 starts. He made his pro debut in 2022, pitching in five games for the ACL-Giants. The Giants drafted him in the 10th round of the 2022 draft out of Notre Dame. He pitched at Furman from 2017-20, and for the Fightin Irish from 2021-22. He's from the same hometown as R-Phils Andrew Schultz.
