LET'S BOUNCE BACK: After dropping the first three games of this series with Kannapolis and a season-worst five in a row overall, the FredNats need a bounce back on Firework Friday against the Cannon Ballers, Single-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox. Tonight, RHP Jarlin Susana will try to build on the best start of his professional career last week. Susana pitched five shutout innings with a career-high nine strikeouts last week against Down East. He allowed just two base runners - one hit and one walk. He faces Kannapolis righty Grant Taylor, who, like many of his starting rotation mates, has been excellent this year for the Cannon Ballers, who have won 12 out of their 13 games and have a 6.5 game lead in the South Division with 12 to play in the first half.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cannon Ballers scored three runs in the first two innings - only one earned - against the rehabbing Seth Shuman and Kannapolis didn't look back en route to their 8th straight win, 9-2 over FXBG. Kannapolis has out-hit Fredericksburg 40-13 in this series so far. Roismar Quintana and Sammy Infante drove in the two runs for FXBG.

ROSTER MOVEMENT: Prior to the start of this series and during the series, the FredNats made several roster moves. Carolina League save leader Thomas Schultz was promoted to High-A Wilmington after posting a league-best eight saves and an ERA of 1.82 in 24.2 IP. Returning to the FredNats from Wilmington is infielder John McHenry, who appeared in three games with FXBG prior to an early-season promotion to Wilmington. Reliever Anthony Arguelles returns to Fredericksburg from the Complex after four early-season appearances with FXBG. Wilmington IL guys Sammy Infante and Jared McKenzie - both former successful FredNats - start rehab assingments with FXBG

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 21-4 this season when scoring first, including 18 out of the last 19 wins. Two of the four losses did come last week in Kinston against the Wood Ducks. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses in their last home series aginst the Lynchburg Hillcats, and Kannapolis has scored first in all three games of this series so far.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. So far this season, the bullpen has pitched 277.1 innings this year and allowed 87 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.89, which is the best in the Carolina League. The Freddies are also 14/15 in save opportunities, and prior to his promotion, Thomas Schultz was first in the Carolina League and T-4th in MiLB with eight saves. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (23-0), and 8 (24-0) innings this season as well.

RBI KING: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 48. This year, Pimentel is hitting .375 with runners in scoring position, and is 11-for-22 (.500) with runners in scoring position and two outs. Pimentel continues to be one of the best situational hitters in all of MiLB.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 170-144 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Jarlin Susana is set to make his 10th start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a sinker, a tight slider, plus a curveball and a changeup.

EARLY-SEASON HIGHS: After an up-and-down April last year, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

LATE-SEASON LULL: Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

LAST TIME OUT: Susana delivered his best start of the year last week against the Down East Wood Ducks. Jarlin spun five shutout innings for his longest start of the season, while striking out a career-best nine men and walking just one batter.
