**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones picked up their 15th straight home win in a 4-2 victory over Asheville on Wednesday night...The Brooklyn bullpen was untouchable, as RHP **Brian Metoyer**, RHP **Raimon Gomez**, LHP **Ryan Ammons**, and RHP **Ben Simon** combined on 4.2 scoreless innings...The quartet permitted just 1 hit, while striking out 7 and walking only 2...Ammons collected the win, while Simon picked up his first save of his pro career...Offensively, 1B **Jacob Reimer** and 2B **Marco Vargas** finished with multi-hit days, while SS **Boston Baro** drove in a pair...The 'Clones broke a 2-2 tie with a couple of runs in the 8th on RBI extra-base knocks from Reimer and RF **Carson Bengé**.

**THE NUMBER ONE SPOT:** The Cyclones are mired in a 3-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Tuesday, Brooklyn holds a 1.5-game lead on Greensboro for 1st place in the division...The Cyclones are 5.5 games up on 3rd-place Hudson Valley with 7 games remaining in the first half...Brooklyn's magic number to clinch the first half division crown is 6...Any Cyclones wins or Grasshoppers losses will decrease the number...Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half...Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./at Aberdeen).

**HORSES IN THE 'PEN:** Brooklyn relievers have been exquisite as of late... The Cyclones' bullpen arms have given up only 2 ER through the first two games of this week's series against Asheville...Since June 1, Brooklyn holds the 3rd best bullpen ERA in the South Atlantic League at 2.95...During that same span, the bullpen has accrued a 4-2 record, is a perfect 3-for-3 in save opportunities, and has garnered 55 strikeouts to just 19 walks...On the year, Brooklyn's bullpen holds a 3.30 ERA, 2nd behind only Hudson Valley (2.71).

**CAN'T TUCC THIS:** LHP **Jonathan Santucci** has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 4-0 over his last 5 outings (3 starts), including a career-high tying 5.1 scoreless inning performance in a no-decision last Wednesday at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.72 ERA (2 ER in 25.0 IP) with 13 hits allowed, 9 walks, and 26 strikeouts...Santucci saw his scoreless inning streak come to an end at 18.0 frames in Tuesday's win over Asheville...The south-paw's streak spanned from the 2nd inning in game one of a doubleheader on May 23 at Jersey Shore until the top of the 7th with two outs on Tuesday...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (0.72), is tied for 1st in wins (4), 3rd in batting average against (.149) and WHIP (0.88), and 6th in innings pitched (25.0).

**NOAH'S ARC:** After being limited to just 13.0 innings in his first professional season in 2024, RHP **Noah Hall** has found a new gear in 2025...The 24-year-old registered his 1st pro save on Thursday night at Wilmington, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...The save was Hall's first since April 30, 2021, vs. the University of Louisiana at Monroe, while pitching for Appalachian State University...Entering play on Thursday, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 4th in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.56), 10th in batting average against (.211), and 6th in innings pitched (56.1).

**HOME COOKING:** Brooklyn continued their dominance at Maimonides Park in Wednesday's victory against Asheville...Wednesday's triumph was the Cyclones' 15th-consecutive home win...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Thursday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 24-5 (.828)...Greenville is second best (21-13)...The 24 home wins are tied for the most home wins in all of MiLB with Miami's Triple-A Jacksonville and the Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas...Brooklyn's .828 home winning percentage is the best in MiLB...San Francisco's Single-A San José (.720) is 2nd.

**GARCÍA LATER:** RHP **Saúl García** has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2025...Entering Thursday, the 21-year-old is tied with Bowling Green's RHP **Jack Snyder** for the South Atlantic League lead in saves (6)...Among SAL relievers with 15.0 or more innings of work, García paces the circuit in strikeouts-per-9-innings (16.80)...That total is 2nd-best at High-A (Toronto's High-A Vancouver RHP **Nate Garkow**, 17.28)...It is also the 5th-best in Minor League Baseball...Los Angeles-NL's High-A Great Lakes RHP **Alex Makarewicz** (18.32) is 1st...García also leads the SAL in batting average against (.085) and hits-per-9-innings (2.40), and is 10th in ERA (1.20).

**KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING:** The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 57 games of the 2025 season with Saturday's win at Wilmington, ultimately earning a series split...Through Brooklyn's first 10 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 7-0-3 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 4-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 9-0-3 in a series of any length...Additionally, the Cyclones' 41-18 record is the franchise's best record through 59 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn went 42-17 through 59 contests in their inaugural season in 2001.

**REIMER SHINE:** INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Entering play on Thursday, Reimer is tied for 10th in Minor League Baseball in runs scored (48)...The former 4th-round pick also leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (48), is tied for the league lead in slugging percentage (.565) and paces the circuit in OPS (.977)... He's also tied for 1st in doubles (17), 2nd in batting average (.311) and total bases (109), and hits (59), tied for the league lead in extra-base hits (29), tied for 4th in RBI (38), and 6th in on-base percentage (.412)...Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

**ALL BÁEZ ON ME:** After recovering from knee surgery, INF **Jesús Báez** has slowly returned to form...Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (27), is 3rd in on-base percentage (.418), 9th in batting average (.303), 10th in OPS (.886), tied for 11th in hits (33) and walks (20), and tied for 13th in runs scored (21)...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the May 20-25 series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit .647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for

**vs. ASHEVILLE:** After splitting a 6-game series in Wilmington, Brooklyn returns home for their final homestand of the season's first half...Asheville enters the series after splitting 6 games in at home against Winston-Salem...The Tourists are 13-17 on the road this season...Brooklyn and Asheville split a 6-game series at McCormick Field from May 6-11...The Tourists boast 8 of the Astros' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: C **Walker Janek** (3), RHP **Anderson Brito** (5), OF **Joseph Sullivan** (11), INF **Chase Jaworsky** (12), OF **Kenni Gómez** (16), RHP **Juan Bello** (21), RHP **Bryce Mayer** (26), and INF **Alejandro Núñez** (28)...In 25 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 15-10 (.600)...Brooklyn is 6-2 (.750) against the Tourists in 8 games at Maimonides Park.

the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF **A.J. Ewing** won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history...Báez also was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" for his efforts...On May 20, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF **Ryan Clifford** on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore.

**BENGE IT LIKE CARSON:** OF **Carson Bengé** has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Thursday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (44), tied for 1st in doubles (17), 4th in extra-base hits (25), 3rd in on-base percentage (.421), 4th in OPS (.924), tied for 5th in walks (34), tied for 3rd in hits (58), 5th in total bases (95), tied for 3rd in batting average (.307), and 5th in slugging percentage (.503)...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting .412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore from May 20-25.

**EWING-ING IT:** IF/OF **A.J. Ewing** has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Thursday, the Springboro, Ohio native is tied for 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball in triples (7)...He is also 3rd in stolen bases (43), and 4th in batting average (.347)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (29 - 8 more than anyone else), is 2nd in hits (44), tied for 2nd in triples (3), 5th in batting average (.321), 4th in runs scored (29), and 6th in on-base percentage (.409)...Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in stolen bags (29)...The 2023 4th-round pick was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF **Nick Lorusso** and LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024.

**SWIPER KEEP SWIPING:** Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Thursday with 138 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (140)...The 138 steals are tied for 7th in Minor League Baseball...Los Angeles' (N.L.) Single-A Rancho Cucamonga leads MiLB (167)...Brooklyn already has 6 players with 10-or-more steals on the season...The 138 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 59 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 51 swipes...The 2005 club is 2nd with 87 steals through 59 games...The Cyclones are 44 steals shy of breaking their single-season franchise record of 181 steals set in 2024.

**IT'S A WALK-OFF:** C **Chris Suero** provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in Sunday's 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B **Anderson De Los Santos** enabled the winning run to cross...On Saturday, C **Ronald Hernandez** helped Brooklyn complete another come-from-behind win, clobbering a walk-off solo home run with 1 out in the 9th in a 5-4 Cyclones win...The walk-off homer was Brooklyn's 1st since 3B **Jefrey De Los Santos** hit a game-tying 2-run blast and LF **Omar De Los Santos** smashed the game-ending solo shot on July 28, 2024, vs. Rome...Hernandez also delivered a walk-off winner with a run-producing fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th on May 18 vs. Winston-Salem...2B **Marco Vargas** collected Brooklyn's 1st walk-off win of the year, slapping a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th on April 29 vs. Wilmington.

**MAGIC 8 BALL:** Brooklyn erupted for a season-high 8 runs in the 3rd inning in Tuesday's 12-3 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones scored 8 runs on 8 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate...The 8-run frame was Brooklyn's biggest offensive outburst this year...The previous high had been 6 runs on 3 occasions, most recently on May 14 vs. Winston-Salem in the bottom of the 4th...The 8-run inning was the 'Clones largest frame since scoring 9 runs in the bottom of the 2nd inning in an 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on July 27, 2023...Brooklyn scored 9 runs on 6 hits in that inning, sending 12 to the dish...It was the Cyclones' biggest offensive inning on the road since tallying 10 runs in the top of the 6th in a 20-6 rout on May 27, 2022, at Bowling Green.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Bengé** (3), INF **Jesús Báez** (7), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (12), INF **Boston Baro** (13), INF **Marco Vargas** (14), RHP **Nate Dohm** (18), INF **Jacob Reimer** (20), C **Chris Suero** (21), OF **Eli Serrano III** (22) and C **Ronald Hernández** (26), OF **A.J. Ewing** (27), and RHP **Will Watson** (29)...The Cyclones also possess 11 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (6), Bengé (7), Ewing (8), Reimer (10), Vargas (11), Baro (17), Santucci (18), Suero (19), Serrano III (20), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (21), and Dohm (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from **Joe DeMayo**...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Collected the first win of his High-A and Cyclones career last Thursday night at Wilmington...Did not allow a run on 2 hits over 5.0 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 6...Induced a double play...Retired the final 9 batters he faced in order...Threw 64 pitches and 43 strikes (67.19%)...Relieved by RHP **Noah Hall** to start the bottom of the 6th inning with the Cyclones leading 1-0...Brooklyn stranded the bases loaded in the 8th plus the tying and winning runs in the 9th en route to a 1-0 win over the Blue Rocks.

**2025:** Broke camp with Single-A St. Lucie...Suffered the loss as the Opening Day starter on 4/4 vs. JUP (3.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 2 K)...Earned his 1st win of the season on 4/18 vs. TAM (5.0 IP, H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...Struck out a season-high 7 in a no-decision on 4/22 vs. Daytona (4.0 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 7 K)...Earned the victory, tossing a career-high 5.1 innings on 5/3 @JUP (5.1 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...At the time of his promotion, Dohm was tied for 5th in the Florida State League in strikeouts (34) and tied for 7th in innings pitched (28.1)...Transferred to Brooklyn on 5/12...Took a no-decision in his Cyclones and High-A debut on 5/15 vWS (3.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 4 K)...Tossed 3.2 innings of shutout ball in a no-decision on 5/30 vABD (3.2 IP, 3 H, BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st win of his Cyclones career with 5.0 shutout innings on 6/5 vWIL (5.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 6 K).

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Dohm is ranked as the New York Mets' No. 24 prospect in 2025 per *Baseball America*...He entered 2025 ranked as the Mets' No. 23 prospect by that publication...He is considered New York's No. 19 farmhand by MLB Pipeline and the organization's No. 20 prospect per SNY's **Joe DeMayo**.

**STARKVILLE SUPERSTAR:** The 22-year-old had a marvelous final collegiate campaign at Mississippi State in 2024...Dohm composed a perfect 4-0 record with a minuscule 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 29.1 IP), 23 hits allowed, 4 walks, and 37 strikeouts in 8 appearances (6 starts) for the Bulldogs...Served as Mississippi State's Opening Day starter on 2/16/24 vs. Air Force...Struck out a season-high 10 on 3/8/24 vs. Evansville...Pitched a season-high 7.0 innings on 2/29/24 vs. Mount Saint Mary's...Had 8 or more strikeouts in 3 contests...Held opponents to a .217 batting average...Sidelined for most of March and April with an arm injury.

**BALL HARD:** Dohm started his collegiate career closer to home at Ball State University in Muncie, Ind...The university was located roughly 66 miles southeast of Zionsville (Ind.) High School...About a one-hour and 17-minute drive on I-69...Pitched one season with the Cardinals in 2022...Accrued a 4-3 record with a 5.71 ERA (26 ER in 41.0 IP), 2 saves, 32 hits allowed, 26 walks, and 56 strikeouts in 15 appearances (3 starts).

**WHO TO ROOT FOR?:** It isn't just New York sports fans who have to decide on which baseball team to root for...It can happen in Chicago, as well...Dohm grew up on both the north and south sides of Chicago before moving to Zionsville, Ind...As a result, Dohm grew rooting for both the Chicago Cubs and Chicago White Sox...However, Dohm became more of a Cubs fan while a student at Zionsville High School.
