LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox walked off the Altoona Curve, for the second-consecutive night, by a 6-2 final on Saturday night at Prince George's Stadium. Jud Fabian launched a grand slam home run in the ninth to clinch the win and series win for Bowie. Frederick Bencosme drove in the other two Baysox runs, via a solo home run in the second inning and a go-ahead single in the sixth. The Baysox defense turned four double plays behind right-handed starter Trace Bright, who allowed one run across his five innings.

SEASONING FROM BEYOND THE WALL

The Curve sport a well-seasoned roster to open 2024, with 20 players who share previous Double-A experience with Altoona. The Curve are 4-4 to open the series after taking three of five from their opening home series against Harrisburg last week. Altoona's roster includes seven of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (two Top 100), per MLB Pipeline - LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4/No. 75), RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 5/No. 85), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 6), RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 7), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 9), OF/1B Jase Bowen (No. 20), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Anthony Solometo gets the ball in the series finale for Altoona. The No. 4 Pirates prospect and No. 74 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has allowed three runs in seven innings through his two starts this season. Solometo spent the later half of 2023 with the Curve, posting a 4.35 ERA in 12 starts (51.2 innings) with 50 strikeouts and 14 walks. The 2nd round pick of the Pirates in 2021 out of Bishop Eustace High School in New Jersey features a fastball, sinker, slider and changeup.

HEY JUD!

The last two games for **Jud Fabian** have been ones to remember for the Orioles No. 12 prospect. On Thursday, Fabian recorded his first four-hit game at Double-A with a 4-for-4 performance. Last night, Fabian cranked his first walk off homer of his career with a grand slam to win the game for Bowie in the ninth. It's the outfielder's second career grand slam and his first at Double-A.

TERRY HITS TATERS

OF/1B **TT Bowens** is off to a solid start in his second season at Double-A. The 25-year-old first baseman is second in the league in slugging percentage (.675), is tied for the league lead in RBI (14), leads the league in OPS (1.147) and is fourth in total bases (26). The Connecticut native is also on a 11-game on-base streak, which is tied for the longest active streak in the league with Dylan Beavers and Portland's Marcelo Mayer.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is swinging the ball well in his second stint with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect extended his on-base streak to 11 consecutive games last night, which is tied for the longest active on-base streak in the league with TT Bowens and Portland's Marcelo Mayer. During this on-base streak, Beavers is hitting .357 with 15 hits in 42 at-bats. The 2022 first-round pick hit his first homer of the season on Tuesday in the first inning.

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Samuel Basallo** hit his first Double-A homer on Tuesday with a line drive shot in the seventh to put Bowie ahead for good. The 19-year old is coming off a monster season in 2023 where he finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

READY, FREDDY

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has enjoyed his start to life in Double-A. Bencosme has hits in 10 of his first 13 Double-A contests, including seven multi-hit contests. Although his six-game hit streak ended yesterday, the middle infielder is still batting .365 (19-for-52) with three homers and 12 RBI and has only struck out six times. Only 21 years old, Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.

2023: Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made one start on June 26. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on June 28 to continue rehab assignment. Made one start and went 3.0 scoreless innings. Assigned to High-A Aberdeen on July 4 to continue rehab assignment. Made two starts and struck out 11 over 7.0 innings, giving up just one earned run. Sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

2022: Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

2021: Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went three innings and gave up four runs (three earned) with four strikeouts in his Double-A debut against Akron. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 strikeouts over 60.2 innings and an ERA of 3.86.

2019: Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

Personal: Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.
