THREE CLAPS AND A BIG WOO: RHP Brandon Woodruff will see his first game action since June 3rd when he took a line drive off his right elbow in a rehab start against Gwinnett in Nashville. Sunday's start will be his 10th rehab start between Nashville and High-A Wisconsin this year. He enters the game 3-1 with a 2.11 ERA over 38.1 IP with 34 strikeouts to nine walks.

QUALITY TIME: For the second time this series, both starting pitchers earned a quality start on the hill. RHP Tobias Myers worked his third quality start of the month in his five games. He has now gone 6.0 IP in four of the five with the only exception being the five scoreless innings he threw last Sunday against Iowa in his second start of the series. Garrett Stallings began the series with his first quality start after making his fifth start and Bruce Zimmermann worked a quality start for the Sounds on Thursday.

PARTNER UP: Brewers no. 2-rated prospect **Jeferson Quero** had his first multi-hit game since last Tuesday's series opener against Iowa and his fifth multi-hit game of the season after going 2-for-4 with a double. He was 1-for-13 in the series entering Saturday. **Oliver Dunn** bounced back from an 0-for-4 day on Friday night to go 2-for-3 with a double as well for the Sounds on Saturday night. It was his eighth multi-hit game this season and second of the series after going 3-for-4 on Thursday. Dunn is hitting .429 for the week (6-for-14, HR, 3B, 2B, 3 RBI, BB, HBP, 2 R, 4 K). He continues to produce extra-base hits with his 18th in 57 games played. Nearly half of his hits this season have been an XBH (18/42).

OUTBURSTS: The 15 runs allowed by the Sounds on Friday night were the most the team has allowed in a game this season. The previous high was 11 runs which had been done twice including the third game of the year against the Jumbo Shrimp on March 29th. Charlotte also had 11-runs in a 14-11 Nashville win on April 20th. The 17 hits allowed Friday night also match the Charlotte output from that April 20th game. **Over the last two games Jacksonville has tagged the best pitching staff in Triple-A for 23 runs and 30 hits. Nashville still owns the best ERA in Triple-A at 3.52.**

OH NO-NO: Nashville was no-hit in a game for the seventh time in franchise history on Friday night in Jacksonville. The last came on May 3, 2024, in Nashville against the Norfolk Tides (3 pitchers used). Jacksonville used four pitchers for their combined no-hitter on Friday night with Matt Pushard earning the win after working a team-high 3.0 IP with five strikeouts and one walk allowed. All four of the Jumbo Shrimp pitchers issued at least one walk with George Soriano issuing two walks and hitting another two batters in the ninth inning. Friday night was the second time Nashville has been no-hit against Jacksonville after Jeff Cornell threw one on May 16, 1981, in Nashville.

ON-BASE STREAKIN: Despite not getting a hit, **Bobby Dalbec** drew a walk and collected a RBI for the Sounds on Friday night. His walk in the top of the second inning extended his on-base streak to six games. **Freddy Zamora** and **Jared Oliva** have each reached base in their last five games after both recorded a hit in the Sounds loss on Saturday night.

POWER SURGE: After not having a home run in seven straight games, Nashville ended their drought with three home runs in Thursday's win. It was the seventh game this season with 3+ home runs and first since the three home runs hit against Iowa before going seven straight games without a home run. **Bobby Dalbec** launched his 11th of the season (7th w/ NAS) in the second inning and was followed by **Oliver Dunn**'s fourth of the year. **Andrew Vaughn** got in on the action with his fourth of the season and second in eight games played with Nashville.

QUALITY ZIMM: Bruce Zimmermann's quality start on Thursday was his first since last April when he worked 6.0 IP and allowed three earned runs on April 24, 2024, against Gwinnett while with Norfolk. Thursday night was his 16th career Triple-A quality start and 43rd as a pro. When going at least 6.0 IP for his career, he has had a quality start in all but six of those starts.
