Game crew members will assist the full time grounds crew in maintaining the playing surface before, during, and after games. This includes breaking down the batting practice setup, preparing the field for game play, dragging the infield during games, doing post-game work, etc.

Candidates must be able to carry up to 70 lbs of product, and be willing to work hard in all weather conditions. This includes running and pulling the tarp.

Candidates must be able to take direction in a variety of circumstances and act in a professional manner at all times. Candidates should have a good understanding of the game of baseball.
