JUMBO SHRIMP FALTER LATE

Durham scored two in the ninth on Thursday to best Jacksonville 7-6. The Bulls got off to a 2-0 lead in the first before ultimately grabbing a 5-2 advantage after three and a half innings. The Jumbo Shrimp tied the score in the fourth, and the game remained deadlocked until Griffin Conine's RBI single in the eighth inning. However, in the ninth, Rene Pinto's RBI double tied things at six before Kameron Misner's bases-loaded walk made it 7-6 in favor of Durham. Conine also homered in the effort and Troy Johnston collected three hits and two RBIs.

ERROR 404: NOT FOUND

Heading into play on Friday, Jacksonville's 30 errors on the season represent the fewest in all of Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp have set a season-high by playing seven errorfree games in a row, going exactly 63 innings without a miscue. Over the last 30 contests dating back to April 26. Jacksonville has committed only 13 errors, also the fewest at the Triple-A level.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 46-for-157 (.293/.443/.567/1.010) with 11 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 29 RBIs, 39 walks and 25 runs scored in 45 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks second in the International League in on-base percentage, tied for third in walks, fourth in OPS, eighth in slugging percentage, tied for 12th in extra-base hits (22), tied for 15th in home runs and 18th in batting average. Among the 124 qualified hitters in the IL, Bride ranks third in swinging-strike rate (4.9 percent) and 4th in line drive rate (28.6 percent).

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 20 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 19-for-hislast-63, slashing .302/.408/.667/1.075 with five doubles, six home runs, 18 RBIs, 12 walks and 13 runs scored. He's driven in at least one run in 12 of those 20 games, with multiple RBIs in four contests.

THE GREAT AWAKENING?

The Jumbo Shrimp were shut out on May 22, marking their 17th loss in 20 games. During that 20-game stretch, Jacksonville ranked 27th in Triple-A in batting average (.233), 29th in OBP (.319), 30th in SLG (.351), 30th in OPS (.670), 25th in hits (157) and 29th in runs scored (75). Over the last seven games, however, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated 48 runs - more than half of what they had compiled in the previous 20 games and tied for the fifth-most in Triple-A - on 73 hits (3rd) with 39 walks (3rd). As a team. over these last seven games, Jacksonville is 73-for-244 (.299/.395/.455/.850) with eight homers and only 53 strikeouts (T-10th-fewest).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late: Sanoja has reached base safely in 19 of his last 21 games, notching 10 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 31-for-84 (.369/.433/.536/.969) with seven doubles, two triples, one home run, 17 RBIs, 11 walks and 12 runs scored. Among the 196 IL hitters with at least 100 PA. Sanoia has posted the highest opposite-field rate (52.1 percent) and the third-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.8 percent).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 34 of Jacksonville's 54 games (63.0 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 16 of the club's last 23 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 16 of its last 19 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 15-19 (.441) in these affairs.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville matched a season-high by issuing nine walks on Thursday against Durham... The Jumbo Shrimp are just 12-27 (308) against the Bulls over the last seven series the clubs have played each other... Max Meyer has yielded two earned runs or fewer in each of his last three starts (0-1, 3.72 ERA, 9.2 IP, 10 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 7 BB, 15 K, .256 BAA).

ABOUT MAX

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2024 SEASON

-Optioned to Jacksonville on April 15.

2023 SEASON

-Did not pitch while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer made his major league debut for the Marlins on July 16 by throwing 5.1 innings with five strikeouts in a game against the Philadelphia Phillies at loan Depot park. He made two starts before undergoing Tommy John surgery on August 9.

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in IP (101.0).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
