### TODAY'S HEADLINES

## Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 281-260 LAST TIME OUT: Andrew Morris turned in a strong start in his Triple-A debut, but the bullpen could not hold on in a 5-4 loss in Indianapolis on Tuesday. Morris allowed only two hits, one of which was a home run, over his 6.0 innings. The Saints scored three runs in the fourth inning, getting an RBI double from Jair Camargo, a sacrifice fly from Diego Castillo and a run scoring on a double play. The Saints took a 4-1 into the seventh, but Indianapolis jumped in front on a grand slam Billy Cook to take the lead and hold on for the win.

**DK DRIVES THEM IN:** With his RBI single in the fifth inning on Tuesday, DaShawn Keirsey Jr. set a new career-high with 62 runs driven in. His previous high was 61, set last season between Wichita and St. Paul. His Tues 10-10 62 RBI this season are tied for the fifth-most in a single season in franchise history and 13 short of the record 75 set by Chris Williams last season. His 97 hits are also the fifth-most in a single season, putting himself three short of becoming the fifth Saint to collect 100 hits in a season. The most recent to do so was Andrew Stevenson, who had a franchise-record 132 hits last year.

vs. East.....12-13 BANNON ON THE BRINK: Rylan Bannon is looking to break a streak of 27 hitless at-bats, dating back to his final at-bat on August 1. It is the longest streak for the Saints this season, as is his eight-game hitless streak. Both franchise records are held by Daniel Descalso, who went on an 0-for-30 on a nine-game skid from May 18-28, 2021.

44 FOR CW: Chris Williams clubbed his 13th home run of the season on Sunday and the 44th of his Saints career, giving him the Saints Triple-A career home run record, surpassing the 43 Mark Contreras hit from 2021-23. His 44 long balls since his debut on August 11, 2022 are the ninth-most in the International League. His 434-foot home run on Sunday is his longest registered home run of 2024 and tied for the third leaguest. is his longest registered home run of 2024 and tied for the third-longest home run of his Saints career.

JULIEN JUMPING ON BASE: Edouard Julien has reached base in 37 consecutive games, riding the Saints' longest on-base streak this season. It is the second-longest franchise history trailing only Jake Cave's 49-game streak in 2022. It is the longest active streak and second-longest streak in the International League this season, trailing only Buddy Kennedy's 45-gamer. During Julien's 37-game streak, he is hitting .270/.438/.453 (.891 OPS).

WINK WINK: Patrick Winkel has been locked in since the start of July, hitting 309/.347/.500 with a .847 OPS His .976 OPS in July was the second-best of his career (min. 20 PA's), trailing his 1.024 OPS in August of 2023. Winkel has hit safely in 12 of his 19 games since July 1, collecting multiple hits in seven games, including six of his last 12

**ELECTRIC EELES:** Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .413 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 25 of the 29 games he's played in, drawing 16 walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is fourth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .440 across three levels. Of the three players ahead of him, only one has played in Triple-A.
