TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue the second half of their season with a three-game set with Harrisburg.

LAST TIME OUT: Po-Yu Chen fired another terrific outing to lead the Curve to a 4-3 win over Harrisburg.

QUITE A START: Since June 21 (14 games) Altoona starters have been the backbone of the team's success. Seven times in the last 14 games, a Curve starter has thrown a quality start (6.0 IP+ and 3 ER or fewer) with five outings lasting 7.0 innings or longer. Altoona's 3.21 ERA since June 21 is 5th-best among Double-A teams. Curve starters have gone 6-5 with a 2.79 ERA (26 ER / 84.0 IP) allowing 58 hits, 24 walks (0.97 WHIP) and 75 strikeouts in the last 14 games

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as the calendar flipped to June. Chen fired a career-high 8.0 innings and struck out 9 on June 7 at Richmond to lead the Curve to a 3-1 win. Chen allowed just one run four times in his last seven outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.64 ERA (14 ER / 47.2 IP) with 31 strikeouts.

THOMAS' ENGLISH MUFFINS: Righty **Thomas Harrington** matched his career-long with 7.0 scoreless innings on July 4 against Harrisburg. Since June 16 (4 starts) Harrington has gone 1-1 with a 1.57 ERA (4 ER / 23.0 IP) and allowed a 0.87 WHIP with 20 strikeouts. Harrington has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 8-of-10 outings with Altoona this year.

BUBBA'S BURGERS: Bubba Chandler has hit his stride since returning from the injured list on May 29. Chandler has walked just 4 batters in 37.0 IP with 45 strikeouts, recording a 4-2 record with a 2.19 ERA [9 ER / 37.0 IP) with a 0.76 WHIP. Chandler was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23), the first to receive the honor since Mike Burrows and Quinn Priester took home weekly honors during the 2022 season. Since June 1, his 42 strikeouts are the most by a Double-A pitcher and he ranks second in WHIP with a 0.73 mark.

Also of note, Chandler had consecutive 10 strikeout games on 6/21 at Bowie and 6/27 vs Akron. It was just the third time in franchise history that a Curve pitcher had struck out 10-or-more batters in back-to-back outings joining **Tyler Glasnow** (7/21/15 vs Erie, 7/26/15 vs Akron) and **Roansy Contreras** (5/4/21 vs Bowie and 5/11 at Binghamton). Chandler and **Braxton Ashcraft**'s combined four 10-strikeout games this season make the Curve one of six teams, and the lone team at Double-A or Triple-A, to have two pitchers strikeout 10 or more in a game twice.

Chandler is also the 22nd player in franchise history to be selected to the MLB Futures Game which will take place on July 13 at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers. Altoona has had 21 players previously selected to the MLB All-Star Futures Game since its inception in 1999. C Henry Davis (2022), and RHP Roansy Contreras (2021) were the most recent players selected to the roster, 3B Ke'Bryan Hayes was the last Curve player to participate in the game, doing so in Washington, DC in 2018. Chandler would become the first active Curve player to pitch in the Futures Game since RHP Dovydas Neverauskas pitched in 2016 at Petco Park in San Diego.

MY KIND OF FELLOW: Right-hander Drake Fellows has hit his stride in Altoona's rotation, tossing a career-long 7.0 innings and striking out a career-high 9 in a tough-luck 2-1 loss at Harrisburg on July 1. Fellows has allowed 2 runs-or-fewer in 7-of-9 outings with the Curve.

HE WILL McADOO: Infielder Charles McAdoo made his Double-A debut with a bang on Saturday, June 23 at Bowie. McAdoo made a terrific play in the first inning in the field and then went 2B, BB, 2R HR in his first three at-bats for the Curve. McAdoo homered in each of the first two games he played for Altoona. He's reached base in 10-of-12 games joining the Curve, batting .275/.408/.600/1.008 with 2 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 4 RBI, 9 BB, and 11 K. He ranks 1st among PIT MiLB in H (86), 2B (17), RBI (56), T-1st in SB (15), and 2nd in OPS (.980), min. 150 AB's in minor leagues.

A BIG ADDITION: Utilityman Yoyner Fajardo has reached base safely in 18 straight games, during which he's batting .343/.434/.400 with 4 2B, 5 RBI, 11 BB, 9-10 SB. Since June 1, his .322 batting average is 9th in the Eastern League.

K SPELLS TROUBLE: Altoona has struck out at least 10 times at the plate in a game 38 times this season in 80 games.

THE MEN FROM THE UPPER CHAMBER: Delino DeShields is back for his second season managing the Washington Nationals Double-A affiliate. Harrisburg features the next wave of Nationals stars highlighted by outfielders Robert Hassell III (IL), and Brady House. OF Dylan Crews was promoted to Triple-A with 6 games remaining in the first half and the Senators narrowly missed out on the SouthWest Division title.

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Samuel Reyes starts a bullpen day for Harrisburg tonight, A 28-year-old from Bajos de Haina in the Dominican

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Drafted by the San Diego Padres in the 6th round in 2019 out of Vanderbilt... Traded to the Pirates in the 3-team deal between San Diego, the New York Mets and Pirates that netted RHP David Bednar, LHP Omar Cruz, OF Hudson Head and C Endy Rodriguez that sent RHP Joe Musgrove to San Diego and LHP Joey Lucchesi from San Diego to New York...

CURVE CUTS: Drake Robert Fellows... Went 13-2 with a 4.09 ERA in his final season for the NCAA Champion Vanderbilt Commodores... Majored in sociology at Vandy... At the time of the draft MLB Pipeline wrote: "His pitches may be better, but Fellows hasn't harnessed them as well as he had previously. He has been hit harder and battled his control more than in his first two seasons. He'll need to regain his previous command to reach his ceiling as a No. 4 starter, but teams do value his competitiveness and long track record of success in the Southeastern Conference"...
