CABRERA LEADS JAX TO EIGHTH STRAIGHT WIN

Edward Cabrera fanned 10 in 6.0 dominant innings on Saturday as Jacksonville blanked Norfolk 8-0. The Jumbo Shrimp grabbed a 2-0 lead in the first on an RBI double by Dane Myers and an RBI single by Troy Johnston. A Tides error in the fourth brought in another run before Peyton Burdick blasted a three-run home run in the fifth to blow the game open at 6-0. Jordan Groshans registered a two-run single in the seventh to set the final tally at 8-0. Enmanuel De Jesus worked 3.0 scoreless innings for the club's second shutout of the season.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 53 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 89-for-225 at the plate, slashing .396/.448/.516/.964 with seven doubles, one triple. six home runs 38 RBIs and 49 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in Minor League Baseball in batting average (.372) and third in the International League in OBP (.443). Among the 317 players in the IL with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023, Edwards has the second-best swinging-strike rate (4.3 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 51 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 52-for-178 (.292/.368/.674/1.042) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 51 RBIs and 35 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season. Allen is fanning just 20.8 percent of the time in 2023.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City. In 16 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 28-for-66 (.424/.479/.742/1.221) with seven doubles, one triple, four home runs and 18 RBIs. Johnston has had at least one hit in every game, including 10 multi-hit contests. Perhaps not coincidentally, since Johnson's return on July 25, the Jumbo Shrimp have posted a 12-5 record. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola in 2023, Johnston has driven in 101 runs, the most of any MiLB player, in 99 games.

CRAZY FIGHTS

By knocking off Norfolk 8-0 on Saturday, Jacksonville earned their eighth consecutive win - the club's longest winning streak since taking 10 straight contests to close the 2014 season (Aug. 22-Sept. 1, 2014). Over this current eight-game stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp offense leads Triple-A in both average (.332) and hits (95), ranks third in both SLG (.531) and OPS (.938), fifth in OBP (.401), tied for fifth in runs scored (60, 7.5 per game) and tied for ninth in home runs (12) The club also ranks second in runs allowed (22, 2,8 per game), walks (25) and ERA (2.63). Only two of Jacksonville's eight wins on this run have come by three runs or fewer.

IT ALL STARTS WITH THIS

Jacksonville's current eight-game winning streak has seen the club's starting pitcher surrender three runs or fewer in all eight contests. During this run, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have worked 44.0 innings out of the club's 72.0 innings thrown (61.1 percent). Jacksonville starters had tossed 52.2 percent of the team's innings prior to this run. Additionally, during this eight-game roll, Jumbo Shrimp starters are 6-0 with a 2.05 ERA (11 R, 10 ER in 44.0 innings). They have combined for 40 strikeouts (8.2 K/9) against only 10 walks (2.0 BB/9) and 35 hits allowed (7.2 H/9).

HOW SWEEP IT WOULD BE

The Jumbo Shrimp head into play on Sunday gunning for the club's first sweep since taking all four games at Chattanooga from July 18-21, 2019, when the club was still in Double-A. Jacksonville has not earned a brooming at 121 Financial Ballpark since July 8-11, 2018, when they took all four games also against Chattanooga. The last time the Jumbo Shrimp swept a six-game series was August 21-25, 2017, when they broomed Birmingham at 121 Financial Ballpark.

SHRIMP BITES

In this series against Norfolk, Jacksonville relievers have vielded only two runs on 11 hits in 16.0 innings (1.13 ERA)... The Jumbo Shrimp enter play on Sunday just a half-game out of first place. Outside of starting the second half of the season 2-0, the club has not resided in first place all season. Jacksonville hasn't been in first place this late in a campaign since 2013, when they were 30-20 and 2.5 games up on Mississippi in the Southern League South Division.

ABOUT DEVIN

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.

-After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eligible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9–3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer committed to transfering to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.

2023 SEASON

2022 SEASON

-The Twins promoted Smeltzer back to the major leagues on May 14, 2022.[18] On October 11, Smeltzer was sent outright to Triple-A and chose to elect free agency and landed in Jacksonville.

2021 SEASON

-On July 17, 2021, Smeltzer was placed on the 60-day injured list with left elbow inflammation. Smeltzer made one appearance for the Twins in 2021 and was outrighted off of the 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.

2020 SEASON

-Smeltxer made Twins Opening Day roster, the first of his career.

-Four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more. Went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances. Held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Smeltzer ttended Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, NJ before pitching two seasons at San Jacinto College in Houston, TX.

-Smeltzer had his picture posted on the school's Wall of Legends.
