THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On May 12, 2016, Renato Nunez hit an inside-the-park grand slam in the top of the 6th inning off Jean Machi in a 7-2 win at Iowa. Matt Olson, Joey Wendle and Max Muncy scored on the play.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds host the Memphis Redbirds tonight in the second of a six-game series. Memphis scored 18 runs and had 20 hits as they cruised to a 18-6 victory in Nashville's home opener. Left-hander Aaron Ashby makes his second start for the Sounds against left-hander Matthew Liberatore for the Redbirds. Ashby is ranked as the No. 7 prospect in the Brewers organization and Liberatore is listed as the Cardinals best prospect according to *MLB.com*.

Aaron Ashby: 22-year-old Aaron Ashby starts for the Sounds tonight. He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in his last start of May 7 in game one of a doubleheader at Toledo. He gave up just one hit with four walks and six strikeouts. In Ashby's 2019 campaign, he went 5-10 with a 3.50 ERA in 24 games (23 starts) with Advanced-A Carolina and Single-A Wisconsin. He was named the Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a Mid-Season Midwest League All-Star. He spent 2020 at the Brewers Alternate Training Site. The Missouri native was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 4th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

Matthew Liberatore: 21-year-old Matthew Liberatore gets the ball for the Redbirds tonight. He makes his second start of the season for Memphis. Liberatore was tagged with the loss despite allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings of work. He struck out five and walked none. Liberatore spent the entire 2019 season with Single-A Bowling Green, he went 6-2 in 16 games (15 starts) with a 3.10 ERA and struck out 76 in 78.1 IP. The Arizona native was selected by the Tampa Bay Rays in the 1st round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft. He was traded by Rays to the Cardinals in exchange for outfielder Randy Arozarena and the Cardinals Comp. A draft pick on January 9, 2020.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 0, Second: 0, Third: 1, Fourth: 5, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Power Surge: Nashville's powerful swing continued in Tuesday night's 18-6 loss with two home runs (Zach Green, Tim Lopes). Through the first six games of the season, the Sounds have clubbed 14 home runs, tied for fourth-most in the Triple-A East. 11 different Sounds have homered, led by Green with three.

Hit Parade: The Sounds surrendered 20 hits last night for the first time since May 3, 2019 (vs. Memphis, 24) and at 18 runs for the first time since April 28, 2019 (at Iowa, Game two, 19). The 20 hits is a single-game high in Triple-A this season. Nashville starter Thomas Jankins gave up 12 hits and 11 runs, both career-highs.

The Grass is Greener: Nashville infielder Zach Green has hit safely in five consecutive games. He is batting .400 (8-for-20) with 3 runs, 1 double, 3 home runs and 10 RBI during the streak. Green is tied for fifth in RBI (10) and tied for sixth in home runs (3) in the Triple-A East.

Start the Streaks: Three active Sounds have modest on-base streaks of five games - Dee Strange-Gordon, Zach Green and Derek Fisher have all reached base safely in five straight.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

There's History Here: The Sounds enjoyed 10 years as the Brewers' top affiliate from 2005-14. The 2005 season culminated with the Sounds winning the Pacific Coast League Championship - the City of Nashville's most recent championship in any sport. Nashville compiled a 723-713 (.503) record during the 10-year stretch and made three consecutive postseason berths from 2005-07. In 2007, the Sounds won 89 games, the second-most in franchise history (97 in 1980).

Top Prospects: Nashville opened the 2021 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 5 prospect, left-handed pitcher Aaron Ashby is the No. 7 prospect, outfielder Corey Ray is the No. 24 prospect and left-handed pitcher Clayton Andrews is the No. 25 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,034-1,924. The 2,034 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

That Doesn't Hurt So Bad: The Sounds have four Major League rehabbers on the roster. Right-hander Josh Lindblom (April 24 - right knee effusion), outfielder Derek Fisher (April 1 - strained left hamstring), infielder/outfielder Jace Peterson (April 23 - cryotherapy on left thumb) and infielder/outfielder Tim Lopes (March 8 - right oblique) are all on the current roster.
