The 'Caps took a 4-0 lead with a four-run second inning against Lugnuts starter Jeff Criswell, only to see the Lugnuts' relief trio of José Mora, Brandon Withers and Leudeny Pineda twirl seven scoreless innings of three-hit ball, striking out ten, and the Nuts' offense rallied with six unanswered runs for the win.

Off the Field: Tonight is Fan Appreciation Night and the final LAFCU Fireworks show of the year! Tomorrow is Big Lug's Birthday / Capital City Market Kids Day to end the season.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

#### Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Alumni Report, MLB: 2017 Lugnuts star Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., ranks 1st in the Major Leagues in batting average (.318), 1st in home runs (46), tied for 4th in RBIs (104), 3rd in on-base percentage (.408), 2nd in slugging percentage (.615), 2nd in OPS (1.023), 1st in hits (175), 1st in total bases (338) and 1st in runs scored (118). Fellow 2017 Nut Bo Bichette is 2nd in runs scored (112) and 3rd in base hits (171).

Alumni Report, MiLB: 2015 Midwest League MVP Ryan McBroom thumped his 31st home run of the season last night for Triple-A Omaha, setting a Storm Chasers single-season franchise record.

Comeback Nuts: Yesterday's victory marked Lansing's largest comeback this season, rising back from four runs down.

**Down the Ladder:** In the Low-A West last night, the Stockton Ports were no-hit in two hours and six minutes by Modesto, 7-0, averting a perfect game thanks to two errors and a walk drawn by Kevin Richards.

Welcome to Lansing: 20-year-old Jalen Greer made his debut yesterday with a walk and a run scored in four plate appearances. Greer joined the Lugnuts from the Arizona Complex League Athletics, becoming the 859th player in franchise history as well as the record-setting 55th different Lugnuts player to see action this season.

Land of Lincoln... and Lugnuts: Greer is a native of Chicago. He becomes the seventh player on the Lugnuts' roster from Illinois, joining Garrett Acton, Reid Birlingmair, Jonny Butler, Charlie Cerny, Brett Harris and William Simoneit, plus pitching coach Don Schulze.

Tough Actin' Acton: Reliever Garrett Acton struck out the side Thursday night in the 9th, continuing a remarkably impressive run: In his last six relief appearances, batters are 0-for-19 with 18 strikeouts against Acton. In total, he has whiffed 33 batters while walking just three in 16 1/3 innings with the Lugnuts after a call-up from Low-A Stockton. In Acton's last 36 innings, spanning two levels and beginning on June 4, he has limited the opposition to 14 hits and five runs (1.25 ERA), with 61 strikeouts against only nine walks. Acton was signed as an undrafted free agent in 2020 after serving as closer at the University of Illinois, where he led the nation in saves in 2019 and set the Illinois career record for saves in 2020.

Truth in Advertising: Shortstop Drew Swift has lived up to his surname with 11 steals in 12 attempts in just 29 games with the Lugnuts, matching his college total of 11 steals in 172 games spanning four seasons at Arizona State University.

Finishing Strong: Catcher William Simoneit went 1-for-3 with a walk and a crucial go-ahead two-out, two-run single in the seventh inning last night, continuing two patterns: hitting effectively against the Whitecaps this season (16 games, 19-for-59, 3 doubles, 3 homers, .322/.359/.525) and finishing the year strong (12 games, 12-for-39, 2 doubles, 2 homers, 14 RBIs, 8 walks, .308/.417/.513 in September).

Withers vs. Cancer: Reliever Brandon Withers is working with Vs. Cancer, with an official <u>Pledgelt.org</u> page to raise money to battle against Pediatric Brain Cancer with every strikeout he records in September. So far: four appearances this month, 8 2/3 innings total, 12 strikeouts recorded.

New Talent Infusion: The Lugnuts have five 2021 Athletics acquisitions on their roster in infielders Brett Harris (drafted in the 7th round, Gonzaga) and Drew Swift (8th round, Arizona State), outfielder Jonny Butler (14th round, North Carolina State), and pitchers Kyle Virbitsky (17th round, Penn State) and Jack Owen (undrafted free agent, Auburn).

Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vecas.

**Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland**, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Six former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher Ty Tice '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder Josh Palacios '16-17 (Toronto), pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-17 (Toronto), pitcher Conner Greene '15 (Baltimore), pitcher Kirby Snead '16-17 (Toronto), infielder Otto Lopez '19 (Toronto) and infielder Kevin Smith '18 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Snead most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Welcome to the Pros: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Jack Owen, Kyle Virbitsky and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, infielder Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their professional debut with the Lugnuts this season.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 19 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Osvaldo Berrios, Reid Birlingmair, Charlie Cerny, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Jorge Juan, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Jack Owen, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka, Kyle Virbitsky and Brock Whittlesey.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher Drew Millas and pitchers Richard Guasch and Seth Shuman were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher Yan Gomes and utilityman Josh Harrison.
