FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders swept a doubleheader on Saturday night Joker Marchant Stadium, winning game one 3-2 in eight innings and game two 4-3. In game one, Esmerlyn Valdez and Javier Rivas each homered with Keiner Delgado delivering the go-ahead RBI single in the eighth. In game two, Duce Gourson paced the offense, reaching base four times and going 3-for-3.

RAISE THE JOLLY ROGER: With a win on Sunday afternoon, Bradenton would win their second road series of the season after taking five of six frm the St. Lucie Mets in their last road trip two weeks ago. The Marauders haven't won back-to-back road series since last July when they took five of six games from both the Daytona Tortugas and St. Lucie Mets.

ON A ROLL: Since coming off the injured list on August 2, **LHP Michael Kennedy** has been superb in three starts. The southpaw sports a 1.38 ERA after only allowing two earned runs on five hits while striking out 14 and only walking two in 13.0 innings. Opponents are hitting just .116 off him in August when pitching out of the rotation.

IF YOU'RE NOT FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The Bradenton Marauders' offense has scored in the first inning in four of the first five games this week against Lakeland and have done so in seven of their last eight games.

STAY HOT: 2024 Pirates' 9th round pick **Duce Gourson** is currently riding a six-game on-base streak entering Sunday. During this stretch, the Marauders infielder is slashing .368/.556/.526 with three doubles, four RBIs, six walks, five runs, and two stolen bases.

SECOND INNINGS IS OURS: This season, the Bradenton Marauders have scored 73 runs in the second inning and have done so in three of hte first five games of this week's series in Lakeland. The 73 runs are the sixth-most in Single-A this season and 11th-most among High-A and Double-A teams as well.

ANYBODY BUT LAKELAND PLEASE: Against the Lakeland Flying Tigers in 23 games, the Marauders pitching staff owns a 4.93 ERA. Against every other opponent in the Florida State League (97 games), Bradenton's staff owns a 3.81 ERA. They also hold K/9 of 9.93 and BB/9 of 4.71 compared to 8.85 and 5.66.

SEARCHING FOR A WIN: The Marauders snapped their eight game losing streak at Joker Marchant Stadium on Thursday night. It was their first win in Lakeland since June 25, 2023. Bradenton looks to win their fourth-straight in Lakeland on Sunday afternoon. Last season, the Marauders went 8-3, winning both road series' in Lakeland.

TIGERTOWN BOUND: The Bradenton Marauders make their second and final visit of the season to Joker Marchant Stadium this week. Bradenton's first road trip of the season was in Lakeland back in April, where the Marauders dropped all six games. The Marauders have yet to win a series aganst the Lakeland Flying Tigers having lost two and split another in three series meetings in 2024.

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold three of the top seven home run leaders in the Florida State League, with Esmerlyn Valdez leading the way in second with 18 longballs. Axiel Plaz is currently in fourth with 15 and Javier Rivas is in seventh with 12 Valdez is just two HR sky of tying league leader in Ariel Almonte (Daytona). The 18 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Both wins on Saturday against Lakeland marked the Marauders' 40th and 41st one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 21-20 record in those games. After dropping their previous five one-run games, Bradenton has won three-straight.
