WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Washington poured on 13 hits and scored 13 runs in a blowout win over Colorado last night...LF **DAYLEN LILE** picked up an MLB career-high five RBI, going 3-for-5 with his 18th homer of the year, a double, and a pair of runs scored.

HOMEWARD BOUND: Looking to win back-to-back games and take five of six games in the series, the Rochester Red Wings did so against the Omaha Storm Chasers, cruising to a 9-0 victory...1B **YOHANDY MORALES** went 3-for-5 with two singles and four RBI, including his 24th home run of the season...3B **CAYDEN WALLACE** hit a three-run insurance blast in the ninth, while CF **TREY LIPSCOMB** extended his International League-leading hitting streak to 19 games...on the mound, LHP **JARED SIMPSON** continued to dominate as an opener, turning in 3.0 innings to kick off the shutout...the Red Wings return home tonight for a six-game set against Buffalo, looking to keep pace atop the International League second half standings...RHP **ZAK KENT** will take the mound for Rochester against Bisons RHP Grant Rogers... Sunday marked the Red Wings seventh shutout victory of the season and second against Omaha (7/15/2022) since they joined the International League in 2021.

YOU KENT SEE ME: RHP **ZAK KENT** will open things up for the Red Wings tonight, his third start of 2026...the 28-year-old Virginia native allowed one earned on two hits across 2.2 innings of work in his previous start against OMA on 8/20, adding five strikeouts without allowing a walk...across 13 appearances (1 GS) at ESL Ballpark, Kent is 2-0 with a 2.16 ERA (4 ER/16.2 IP) with a 0.90 WHIP and .183 BAA...tonight will mark his 99th career appearance at the Triple-A level, and he is one shy of tying his career-high in wins with six.

ICE TREY: CF **TREY LIPSCOMB** laced a seeing-eye single up the middle Sunday to extend his hitting streak to 19 games, finishing 1-for-5 with a run scored...this is tied for the longest hitting streak in the International League this season (OMA OF Gavin Cross, 19 G; 7/2-28), and ties Derek Hill's 19-game stretch in 2023 for the longest by a Red Wing since Danny Valencia in 2010 (20 G, 4/24-5/16)...since the streak began, the Tennessee product leads the International League in hits (33), XBH (14), and runs scored (22, T-1st with **SEAVER KING**) while ranking second in homers (9) and RBI (24)...heading into this week's home series against Buffalo, Lipscomb carries a .316/.352/.607 slash line with 27 XBH (15 HR, 12 2B) and 42 RBI across 56 games at ESL Ballpark...

Lipscomb is just three games short of becoming the third Red Wing since 2015 to appear in at least 300 games with the club, joining Darren Baker (318) and Kennys Vargas (315).

RED HOT WINGS: Sunday night's victory moved the Red Wings to a season-high 28 games over .500, their first time reaching that mark since 8/27/1997...Rochester's 76 wins are tied with High-A Bowling Green for the most in Minor League Baseball and are one shy of matching the club's highest win total since its 80-win season in 2017 (77 wins in 2024)...dating back to 7/10, the Red Wings are 25-11 and tied with Indianapolis for the International League second-half lead...over that span, Rochester's offense ranks second in Minor League Baseball in RBI (230) and third in runs scored (243)...the Wings also lead the IL in OBP (.371) and total bases (612), while ranking second in SLG (.494) and OPS (.865)...

The Red Wings have homered in 17 consecutive games for the first time since 2019, tying St. Paul (5/19-6/6) for the longest streak in the International League this season.

SIMPLY DOMINANT: LHP **JARED SIMPSON** opened Sunday's 9-0 shutout with 3.0 innings of one-hit ball, allowing one walk and striking out two...he matched his Triple-A career high in innings and set a Triple-A career high with 42 pitches, recording five groundouts...Simpson has not allowed a run in nine consecutive appearances dating back to 7/26, posting a 0.72 WHIP and .091 BAA with 21 strikeouts across 16.2 innings...Sunday marked the ninth start of his professional career, all this season, and he has yet to allow a run in 15.0 innings in the role, surrendering four hits and seven walks with 17 strikeouts...among full-season Minor League pitchers with at least 15.0 innings as a starter, Simpson is the only one with a 0.00 ERA and ranks first in BAA (.083) and sixth in WHIP (0.73)...

Over the six-game series in Omaha, Rochester's starters posted a 0.51 ERA (1 ER/17.2 IP), 0.57 WHIP and .109 BAA, allowing six hits and four walks while striking out 15...among all 120 full-season Minor League teams during the series, they ranked first in ERA, WHIP, BAA and H/9 (3.06), and sixth in BB/9 (2.04).

MOR(ALES) POWER TO YOU: 1B **YOHANDY MORALES** went 3-for-5 with a two-run homer and a two-run single in Sunday's win, producing the first three-hit, four-RBI game of his professional career...his third-inning homer traveled 414 feet at 107.0 MPH, and Morales added a 102.4 MPH single in the fifth, averaging 99.4 MPH across his three balls in play...the four RBI raised his season total to a professional career-high 74, surpassing the 71 he collected between Double-A Harrisburg and Rochester in 2025, while his 24 homers are nine more than his previous career high and fourth-most in the International League...the Miami product also ranks third in the International League in runs (77), fourth in RBI and total bases (202), and seventh in hits (111)...Sunday's homer was his 35th as a Red Wing, moving him into sole possession of third place in the Nationals era (since 2021), behind Travis Blankenhorn (49) and **TREY LIPSCOMB** (42).

KING ME: SS **SEAVER KING** logged his ninth multi-hit game of August in Sunday night's series finale in Omaha, going 2-for-4 with his second triple as a Red Wing, while adding an RBI, a walk and a pair of runs scored...the Wake Forest product leads the team and ranks third in the International League with a .378 batting average across the month...he is also tied for the league-lead in runs scored (22) with **TREY LIPSCOMB**, and ranks second in the IL behind his teammate in total hits (28).

CAY-D IN FULL: 3B **CAYDEN WALLACE** reached base four times for the first time as a Red Wing in Sunday night's win, going 2-for-3 with two walks, a stolen base and three RBI...his three-run homer in the ninth traveled 439 feet at 108.3 MPH off the first pitch of the at-bat...the blast was his sixth with Rochester and 24th between Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg, tied with **YOHANDY MORALES** for the second-most among all Nationals Minor Leaguers...the run scored gave Wallace a career-high 76, surpassing his 2023 total of 75...

Wallace slashed .320/.393/.680 with two homers, six RBI, six runs and 17 total bases during the six-game series in Omaha.

Entering his ninth professional season, first with the Nationals organization after he was claimed off waivers on 5/3/2026...originally selected in the ninth round of the 2019 MLB Draft by Texas, out of Virginia Military Institute...named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 7/18/2018 and 8/8/2018 with High-A Hickory (TEX).

- Slated to make his third start of the campaign this evening against Buffalo, he holds a 2.13 ERA in 16.2 innings pitched inside of ESL Ballpark this season.
- Recalled by Washington on 5/6 before appearing in a game for the Red Wings...appeared in four games in relief with the Nationals (6.35 ERA, 4 ER/5.2 IP), striking out five without allowing a walk...optioned to Rochester on 5/15...recalled by Washington a second time on 6/26...appeared in four additional games with the Nationals before he was optioned on 7/5.
- Through 13 games following a win this season with the Red Wings, Kent carries an ERA of 4.07 (7 ER/15.2 IP) and a WHIP of 1.02 with a .175 BAA.
- Recorded seven consecutive efforts with no earned runs from 7/12-8/1...also allowed just three hits over the span.
- With a record of 4-0, holds the team lead in wins without a loss of any Red Wings pitcher on the current active roster.
- Opened the 2026 season with Minnesota, appearing in two games out of the bullpen before being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on 4/5...made eight relief appearances to a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP) before being designated for assignment on 4/28...claimed off waivers by Washington on 5/3 and assigned to Triple-A Rochester.
- Split the 2025 season between Triple-A Columbus (34 G) and Cleveland (12 G), posting a 2.84 ERA (12 ER/38.0 IP) with 50 strikeouts and 21 walks with Columbus, and a 4.58 ERA (9 ER/17.2 IP) with Cleveland.
- Pitched to a 1.00 ERA (2 ER/18.0 IP) over his first 13 Triple-A appearances in 2025, earning a save and striking out 29 to just nine walks.
- Has appeared in 14 MLB games between Cleveland (12 G) and Minnesota (2 G), holding a 4.64 ERA (11 ER/21.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts, 13 walks, and a 1.59 WHIP.
