TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve hook up with Erie for the second week-long series between the clubs this season. The Curve are 2-6 against the SeaWolves this season.

On the mound, Garrett Burhenn suits up again for the 'Wolves, he tossed 5 innings of 2-run ball against the Curve on May 8 at UPMC Park. Detroit's 9th round pick in 2021 out of THE Ohio State University, Burhenn hails from Indianapolis, IN where he attended Lawrence North HS which is about a 20 minute drive to Victory Field, the home of the Pirates Triple-A affiliate. Burhenn told OSU Sports Information that he'd like to begin a career in acccounting or finance when his baseball career wraps up. He started 3 times against Altoona last season and allowed 6 runs in 16.0 innings.

WE BANG WE BANG: The Curve rocked three homers in their 10-6 win over Erie on Thursday, June 12 at PNG Field. Imanol Vargas and Hudson Head hit their first homers of the season after Jack Brannigan started the scoring in the third inning. Coincidentally, all three homers hit by the Curve were two-run shots. Thursday's outburst was the most home runs by the club since May 23, 2024 at Erie when the team rocked five homers in an 11-5 win.

THE TERMINATOR AGES: Infielder Termarr Johnson, who has not yet faced a pitcher younger than him in his professional career, has reached base safely in 43-of-56 games played this year. Johnson has pickéd up a hit in 22-of-36 games since May 1 recording 11 extra-base hits and 13 RBI in that time.

Prior to turning 21 on June 11, Johnson played 67 games at Double-A, the third-most by a player under the age of 21 in fran-chise history. Andrew McCutchen (138 games) and Jose Tabata (83 games) are the only players in franchise history to play more games than Johnson before their 21st birthday.

TAKING IT ON THE CHIN: Altoona was shutout in four straight games, a franchise record, to begin their series at New Hampshire from June 3-7. A run of 37 consecutive innings without a run ended when Termarr Johnson hit his 7th home run of the season in game two of the doubleheader on June $\bar{7}$ at New Hampshire.

The Curve were no-hit in a game for the first time since 2023 at Bowie when Rafael Sanchez tossed 7-inning no-hitter against the Curve in the first game of the doubleheader on Saturday, June 7.

During Altoona's week at New Hampshire, which ended with an 11-5 win in which the team picked up a season-high 11 runs on a season-best 17 hits on Sunday, the Curve had the 2nd-fewest runs (13), 4th-fewest hits (32) and 4th-fewest walks (15) by a Double-A club during the calendar week. Ironically, Erie led all Double-A teams with 43 runs scored last week in their series with Richmond.

Altoona was shutout in 5 times in a 7 game stretch, and they rank in the bottom-5 among Double-A clubs in most hitting categories during the month of June. The Curve are 24th in batting average (.205), 29th in on-base percentage (.271) and 29th in slugging percentage (.294).

FARE THEE WELL: Relievers Cam Sanders and Sean Sullivan, two of the team's most reliable arms to begin the season were promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on Tuesday, June 10. Sanders, who held opponents to a .154 batting average against (7th among EL relievers), was unscored upon in 13-of-17 outings to begin the season and his 9 saves for the Curve are 3rd-most among minor league relievers.

Sullivan recorded a 1.15 ERA (2 ER / 15.2 IP) in 7 outings, two starts, for the Curve this season. He allowed just 11 baserunners (7 H, 4 BB) in his time with Altoona this season.

WE'RE AT THE DOTEL HOTEL: Starter Wilber Dotel has used a vastly improved splitter this season to become a true strikeout artist. This season, he holds a 21.7% K-BB% after he recorded an 11.2% mark in 2024 with Greensboro. In his last 9 outings, he's struck out 55 batters in 41.0 IP. He ranks 3rd in the Eastern League in strikeouts (62) and 10th in IP (49.2).

ITALIANISSIMO: Righty Alessandro Ercolani has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 7 of his 11 starts this season, he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under 70 pitches in all but one outing this season, Ercolani is working on the best walk rate of his career, walking only 11 in 39.2 IP. His 2.52 BB/9 innings is the best mark of his career.
