TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Roque Gutierrez (7-3, 5.59 ERA)

- The 24-year-old was signed by the Los Angeles Dodgers as an international free agent on September 10, 2020, out of Mexico.
- In his professional career, Gutierrez is 23-14 with a 5.11 ERA in 131 games (32 starts) while giving up 382 hits, 235 runs, 211 earned runs, 51 home runs and 146 walks with 392 strikeouts in 371.1 IP.
- In 2025, Gutierrez pitched for Great Lakes and Tulsa. He was a combined 7-2 with a 4.69 ERA in 25 games (12 starts) while giving up 95 hits, 53 runs, 49 earned runs, 14 home runs and 42 walks with 103 strikeouts in 94.0 IP.
- In his 14 games (11 starts) for Tulsa in 2025, Gutierrez was 2-2 with a 5.56 ERA while giving up 67 hits, 38 runs, 34 earned runs, 9 home runs and 23 walks with 52 strikeouts in 55.0 IP.
- In his 24 games (7 starts) in 2026, Gutierrez is 7-3 with a 5.59 ERA while giving up 84 hits, 53 runs, 48 earned, 16 home runs and 34 walks with 61 Ks in 77.1 IP.
- In his 38 career games (18 starts) for Tulsa, Gutierrez is 9-5 with a 5.58 ERA while giving up 151 hits, 91 runs, 82 ERs, 25 HRs and 57 walks with 113 Ks in 132.1 IP.
- In his last appearance on September 6 against Wichita, Gutierrez pitched 2.0 innings and gave up 7 hits, 5 runs and 2 walks with 3 Ks.
- In his last start on August 23 against Amarillo, Gutierrez received the loss after pitching 4.0 innings and giving up 8 hits, 2 runs, 1 HR and 1 walk with 3 Ks.
- In his 4 games (1 start) in August, Gutierrez was 0-2 with an 11.57 ERA while giving up 22 hits, 15 runs, 6 HRs and 7 walks with 9 Ks in 11.2 IP.
- In his 3 games (1 start) against NWA, Gutierrez is 1-0 with an 11.74 ERA while giving up 15 hits, 11 runs, 10 ERs, 4 HRs and 3 walks with 7 Ks in 7.2 IP.
- Gutierrez is 4-1 with a 5.12 ERA in 12 games (3 starts) at ONEOK Field. In 12 road games (4 starts), he is 3-2 with a 5.91 ERA.
- In his seven starts, Gutierrez is 2-1 with a 3.95 ERA. In 17 relief appearances, Gutierrez is 5-2 with a 6.48 ERA.
- Right-handed hitters are batting .235 in 183 at-bats against Gutierrez and left-handed hitters are batting .350 in 117 ABs.
- Gutierrez has given up the most runs this season in the fourth inning with 16 with opponents batting .400 in that inning.
- Gutierrez is 3-3 with a 7.39 ERA in 10 day games (3 starts) and is 4-0 with a 4.07 ERA in 14 night games (4 starts).

GAMEDAY NOTES

- The Drillers are 53-62 all-time in the postseason. They are 30-40 in the division series and 9-12 in 21 division series. Tulsa is also 2-7 all-time against Springfield in the division series, losing 0-3 in 2007, 2-3 in 2012 and 0-2 in 2025.
- A win today will mark the Drillers second six-game series sweep this season. Tulsa also swept NWA May 25-31. This week against NWA, Tulsa is batting .238 and has a 2.80 ERA.
- Tulsa has clinched the best overall record in the TL for the first time since the 2018 Drillers finished 74-65.
- The Drillers 64.2% winning percentage puts them on an historic pace as no Drillers team has ever won 60% of its games for an entire season, and it has been nearly 60 years since a Tulsa professional team has won at a better pace. The 1968 Tulsa Oilers, who played in the Triple-A Pacific Coast League, finished with a 95-53 record and a .642 winning % and were the last Tulsa team to win at a higher %. The Drillers 88 wins have topped the 1998 & 2019 squads for the most wins in a season in Drillers franchise history. The Drillers team with the best winning % was the 1992 team. They finished with a 77-59 record and a .566 winning %.
- Jake Gelof has hit 33 home runs to match Tim Wheeler's single season Drillers franchise record of 33 set in 2011. Gelof is also one of five Drillers to ever hit 30 home runs in a season joining Wheeler (33), Kevin Buckley (32), Bubba Smith (32) and Joe Koshansky (31). Gelof has also set a new franchise record for the most sacrifice flies in a season with 11, topping Jud Thigpen (2006), Gerald Laird (2002) and Nolan Arenado (2012) who had 10.
- The Drillers 88 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season.
- Tulsa has recorded 203 stolen bases this season, which is the third most in a season in franchise history. The last Drillers team to steal over 200 bases was the 1980 squad who finished with 210 stolen bags.
- The Drillers 852 runs scored have set a new single-season franchise record topping the 2000 team that had 806. Tulsa has also set new franchise records for RBI (798) and walks drawn (707) this season which also topped the 2000 team who had 731 RBI and drew 661 walks.
- Tulsa's offense leads Double A with the most home runs hit with 197. That mark is also a new franchise record for home runs in a season, topping the 2022 team who hit 196.
- The Drillers have the best record in Double A for September at 10-1. Tulsa is also batting .236 and have a 3.96 ERA for the month.
- Tulsa is batting .288 and has a 4.43 ERA against NWA this season. The Drillers have also hit the most home runs against NWA this season with 49.
- The Drillers have hit 77 home runs in the last 41 games, which is the most in Double A and the second most in all of Minor League Baseball during that span.
- Over the past 74 games, Tulsa has a .254 team batting average, the fourth lowest in the TL, and has drawn 384 walks, the most in the TL during that span. Tulsa starting pitchers are 19-16 and have a 5.49 ERA over the last 74 games, which is the seventh highest in Double A, and the relievers are 27-12 have a 4.00 ERA in that span, which is the second lowest in Double A. Tulsa pitchers have also given up 78 home runs during that span with 70 coming in the last 63 games.
- The Drillers have recorded 472 of their 798 RBI this season and 102 of their 197 home runs while batting .263 against relievers compared to batting .261 against starters.
- Tulsa's 45 home wins are the most in Double A and the most in franchise history. The 43 road wins are also the most in Double A.
- Since the Drillers ended their season-long, five-game losing streak on May 16, they are 68-32 and fifth in Double A batting .267 and are third in hits with 904. Tulsa leads in runs scored (637), home runs (159), walks drawn (524) and OPS (.835). Tulsa has also scored at least six runs in 61 of the last 100 games.
- Tulsa has 48 comeback victories this season with 28 coming at ONEOK Field and 20 on the road. The Drillers have scored 143 combined runs in the eighth and ninth innings, which are the third most in the TL. The Drillers largest comeback win was when they rallied from five runs down twice on April 22 at Frisco in game two of a DH and on June 13 against Wichita.
- The Drillers are 48-15 when scoring first and have scored first in 39 of 68 road games and in 25 of 69 home games.
- The Drillers have allowed a combined 281 runs (253 ER) to score in the first, second and third innings for a 5.54 ERA, which is tied for the sixth highest ERA in those innings in Double A.
- Tulsa's offense is second in Double A for the most combined runs scored in the first, second and third innings with 286.
- Sean McLain has earned a hit in 11 straight games and 15 total during that span. Gelof has also earned a hit in seven straight games.
- Gelof has recorded 101 RBI, the second most in the TL. He joins De Paula as the only two players in Drillers franchise history to record 100 RBI in the same season.
- Josue De Paula finished with 104 RBI and 106 runs scored this season. He is just the second Drillers player, along with Carlos Pena (200), to record 100 RBI and runs scored in a season. His 104 RBI puts him tied with Kevin Buckley (1983) for the third most in a season in Drillers history. De Paula's 106 runs scored also puts him at third for the most in a single season in Drillers history. De Paula was also top 10 in almost every offensive statistical category. He was third in average (.303), fourth in HRs (27), first in RBI (104), third in OBP (.401), third in SLG (.547), second on OPS (.948), first in hits (152), tied for the most doubles (37), third in walks (81), second for extra base hits (66), first in runs (106) and nine in stolen bases (31).

DRILLERS WIN FIFTH STRAIGHT—The Tulsa Drillers used two big innings to score seven of their eight runs to defeat the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 8-4 for their fifth straight win at Arvest Ballpark. Tulsa began by scoring four runs in the third inning using Jake Gelof's RBI single, Kole Myers' sacrifice fly and Frank Rodriguez's two-run double. Tulsa added three more runs an inning later when Joe Vetrano hit a solo homer, and Elijah Hainline blasted a two-run shot. Tulsa scored a final run in the fifth using Joe Izarra's RBI single before the Naturals scored their four runs in the eighth and ninth innings. In the eighth, Northwest Arkansas used an RBI single from Alberto Rodriguez and Connor Scott to score their first two runs, and Angel Acosta and Rodriguez each hit solo home runs in the ninth to produce the Naturals final two runs.

In 2024 with Rancho Cucamonga, was 5-3 with a 5.38 ERA in 28 appearances (4 starts)
Spent much of 2025 with High-A Great Lakes, going 5-0 with a 3.46 ER in 11 games (1 GS) with 51 K in 39.0 IP
He actually opened and finished the last season with Tulsa, going 2-2 with a 5.56 ERA in 14 games (11 GS)
Was on the Injured List from August 3-16
Since returning, has made 4 appearances, 3 in relief and 1 as a starter
In those 4 games, he has combined to allow 13 runs (13 ER) on 23 hits over 13.0 IP (9.00 ERA)
He suffered the loss in two of those games (8/23 at Ama and 8/30 at Mid)
Has pitched in 22 games this season, 17 in relief and 7 as a starter
Is 2-1 with a 3.95 ERA in 7 starts (12 ER in 27.1 IP) and is 5-2 with a 6.48 ERA in 17 relief appearances (36 ER in 50.0 IP)
