An Ode to August

Reading enters the final day of the month with a 12-12 record. A win tonight will give the R-Phils their first winning month of the season. This month, Reading is tied with Somerset for the league lead in homers at 38, and New Hampshire is second with 37. Reading's pitching staff is third in the league in strikeouts this month with 262. Oliver Dunn enters the final day hitting .301, with ten homers and 29 RBI in August. Dunn's ten home runs and 29 RBI are tied with Somerset's Ben Rice for the Eastern League lead. David Parkinson's 1.26 ERA this month leads the league and Mick Abel's .188 average against ranks fourth this month.

Reading continues a six-game series and 12-game homestand tonight against New Hampshire. The Fisher Cats lead the season-series 14-6.

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel turned in another strong start last night. Over his last two starts, Abel has 12 innings, four hits allowed, just two earned runs (1.50 ERA) and eight strikeouts, with opponents hitting .108 against him and a 0.83 WHIP. Abel now ranks ninth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (111), fifth in WHIP (1.29) and leads in batting average against (.197).

Parkinson Powers

David Parkinson was stellar again on Sunday, tossing six-shutout innings. Dating back to July 7, Parkinson is 6-1 with a 1.58 ERA over nine starts. In August, Parkinson went 3-1 with a 1.26 ERA over five starts and only allowed earned-runs in one start (Aug. 22).

Double Trouble

Reading turned two more double plays last night to get up to 25 on the month, which is tied for second in the league. Over the last seven days, Reading's turned seven twin killings, which is second in the league, two back of the leader Harrisburg.

The Phillies fell to the Angels as Bryce Harper hit his 300th career home run. Lehigh Valley beat Syracuse 5-3 as Weston Wilson and Kody Clemens each homered. Jersey Shore defeated Aberdeen 4-2 as Justin Crawford had four hits, including two doubles.

Lundblade scampers home only to be tagged by Bresnahan, who is still holding the real ball in his mitt. After a period of confusion, Lundblade is ruled safe. Meanwhile, Bresnahan is released a day later by Williamsport.

Welcoming the Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight with a 21-29 record in the second half, which is last in the Eastern League, and 56-62 overall record. Last week, New Hampshire won just one-of-five games with Binghamton and Sunday was cancelled. Next week, the Fisher Cats remain on the road at Bowie before finishing the season at home against Somerset. Five of the Blue Jays top-30 prospects are on New Hampshire: Ricky Tiedemann (1), Alan Roden (7), Chad Dallas (14), Damiano Palmegiani (19) and Mason Fluharty (28). Tiedemann ranks No. 33 on MLB Pipeline's Top 100.

Cats Pitcher

CJ Van Eyk makes his Double-A debut as he is set to come off the injured list, where he was placed to begin the season. He made two rehab starts for the FCL Blue Jays and six appearences for Single-A Dunedin. Overall, he had a 3.38 ERA (21.1 IP, 13 H, 6 BB, 26 SO). Van Eyk missed all last season after undergoing Tommy John Surgery in September, 2021. It was 619 days between Van Eyk's last start with Vancouver and first outing with Dunedin this season. In 2021, he was 4-6 with a 5.83 ERA over 19 starts for High-A Vancouver. Toronto selected him in the second round in 2020 out of Florida State. He was also selected by the Mets in the 19th round in 2017, but opted not to sign and attend Florida State.
