THE SWEET LIFE: Nashville manager **Rick Sweet** moved to third all-time for wins in Minor League Baseball history on August 19, 2025. At the start of his 36th season as a minor league manager, Sweet owns a career record of 2,438-2,237 (.507). Sweet begins his sixth consecutive season (7th overall) as Nashville's manager, and 11th year as the Brewers' Triple-A Manager. He is 484-379 (.561) during his Sounds tenure and is already the Sounds all-time winningest manager. The 85 wins in 2025 were the fourth-most in a season in his career and the second time in five seasons he has guided Nashville to 85+ wins. Heading into the start of the 2026 season, Sweet is 59 wins away from moving into second and 93 wins shy of passing Stan Wasiak (2,530) for the most wins in Minor League Baseball history.

PREMIUM PETROL: LHP Robert Gasser (0-0, 0.00 ERA) will get the Opening Day start for the Sounds on the mound Friday night. Gasser checks in as **the no. 17-rated prospect in the Milwaukee Brewers Top 30 Prospects** (MLB Pipeline). The southpaw made 16 total appearances between Nashville, Milwaukee, the Arizona Complex League, and High-A Wisconsin in 2025. He earned 2023 International League Pitcher of the Year honors and was named Brewers Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Year the same season. **During his Nashville Sounds tenure, Gasser is 14-6 with a 3.72 ERA in 44 games (39 GS).** Gasser was recalled to Milwaukee on September 21, 2025, and made two starts to end the regular season with the Brewers and made two relief appearances during Milwaukee's run to the 2025 National League Championship Series.

OPENING YAY: Nashville takes the field on Friday night with a record of 22-25 all-time in season openers. It'll be the very first time taking on Norfolk to begin a season.

ROSTER MAKE UP: Nashville's Opening Day roster features **10 of the top 30 prospects** in the Brewers' farm system, including a pair of Top 100 prospects in baseball in **INF Jett Williams (#3/#51)** and **INF Cooper Pratt (#4/#64)**. Williams was acquired by Milwaukee as part of the trade that sent RHP Freddy Peralta to the New York Mets on January 21 while Pratt is a homegrown prospect the Brewers took in the 6th round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft. Other top prospects including in Nashville's Opening Day Roster include: **RHP Logan Henderson (#7), C Jeferson Quero (#8), OF Luis Lara (#12), 1B/3B Luke Adams (#13), LHP Robert Gasser (#17), 3B Brock Wilken (#22), LHP Shane Drohan (#25), and RHP Coleman Crow (#27).** Half of the 28 active players to begin the season with Nashville appeared with the Sounds during the 2025 campaign.

HIGH TIDE: The Sounds got the better of Norfolk during their 17 matchups during the 2025 season. Nashville won the season series 10-7, including a 6-5 record at Harbor Park. The Sounds also own the head-to-head matchup all-time with a 47-44 record against the Tides and are 23-19 all-time on the road in Norfolk.

RECORD BREAKERS: Nashville set a handful of new single-game and single-season franchise highs during the 2025 season. The team set a single-game high with **seven home runs** (6 previous high) on April 20 at Charlotte. With **eight steals as a team on September 19 at Louisville**, Nashville surpassed the previous high (7). On the season, Nashville shattered their previous single-season stolen base record as a team, finishing with **316 stolen bases** (205 previous high) to lead all Triple-A and finished third overall in the minors. Nashville had **16 shutout wins** (14 previous high) to lead all Triple-A and finish tied for the fourth-most in the minors.

A QUICK GLANCE BACK: Nashville finished the 2025 season with a record of 85-63 and tied for the fifth-most wins in the International League with Durham. The Sounds finished the first half 44-29, 2.0 games behind Jacksonville (47-28) and were 41-34 in the second half, 8.0 games behind Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (49-26). Despite missing the playoffs for the third straight season, the 85 wins were the sixth-most in a single-season in franchise history. It was just the third time since 1990 with 85+ wins in a season. The Sounds are one of just two teams in Triple-A to have a winning record in all six halves since going to the split season format in 2023 along with Oklahoma City. Nashville ended the year 24-12 over their final 36 games and had the most wins in Triple-A during the span, including going 8-2 over the final 10 games and 13-5 in September.

- ✦ Began an eight-game minor league rehab assignment on July 24 with High-A Wisconsin...joined Nashville for the first of five Triple-A rehab starts on August 8.
- ✦ Activated from the 60-day IL and optioned to Nashville on August 30...Made one start and four relief appearances for the Sounds.
- ✦ Recalled to Milwaukee on September 21 and made two starts to end the regular season before pitching twice in relief during the 2025 postseason.

- ✦ Began the 2024 season with Nashville (3 G, 0-1, 5.25 ERA) before having his contract selected on May 10...Made his Major League debut vs. St. Louis...Earned the win and became the first player in franchise history to throw at least 6.0 IP without a run or walk allowed in Major League debut (6.0 IP, 2 H, 4 K).
- ✦ Was 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA in five starts for the Brewers in 2024...Team was 5-0 in his starts and he had two quality starts.
- ✦ First pitcher in Brewers history to win each of his first two Major League games...joined by Logan Henderson in 2025.
- ✦ Placed on the 15-day IL on 6/5/24 with a left flexor strain, later transferred to the 60-day IL on 6/25 after undergoing "Tommy John" surgery.
- ✦ Named 2023 International League Pitcher of the Year and Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Year for the Brewers (Carlos Rodriguez) after going 9-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 26 G (25 GS) for Nashville.
- ✦ Led Triple-A and was second among Brewers farmhands with 166 strikeouts in '23.
- ✦ Brewers Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2023 and Minor League Pitcher of the Month in August 2023.
- ✦ Traded to Milwaukee from San Diego as part of the Josh Hader deal on August 1, 2022...At the time was the no. 9-rated prospect in the Padres organization.
- ✦ Ranked fifth in Minor League Baseball in 2022 with 172 strikeouts in 137.0 IP.
- ✦ Made six starts his first professional season in 2021...Went 0-0 with a 1.20 ERA.
- ✦ Graduated from Oak Ridge HS in California
- ✦ Began his collegiate career at the University of New Mexico before transferring to San Joaquin Delta College where he was named Rawlings/ABCA Pacific Association Division I National Pitcher of the Year as a sophomore (14-0, 2.38 ERA, 102.0 IP, 139 K)
- ✦ Transferred to University of Houston and was a First-Team All-American Athletic Conference as a senior in 2021 (6-6, 2.63 ERA, 85.2 IP, 105 K).
