Dayton Dragons (4-4) at Great Lakes Loons (6-3)

RH Reynardo Cruz (0-1, 6.75) vs. RH Aidan Foeller (0-0, 1.93)

Today's Game: The Dayton Dragons (affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds) meet the Great Lakes Loons (affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers) in the first game of a six-game series.

Last Game: Sunday: Lake County 7, Dayton 4. The Captains scored three runs before the first out of the game was recorded and held the lead until the end. The Dragons trailed 7-1 going to the bottom of the seventh before Carter Graham's two-run homer made it 7-3, and Ryan McCrystal lined an opposite field home run in the eighth to make it 7-4, but the Dragons did not have another base runner after McCrystal's homer. The Dragons had just five hits and went 0 for 4 with runners in scoring position. McCrystal was 2 for 4 to raise his average to .400. Dayton relievers Brody Jessee and Graham Osman combined to go 4.1 innings while allowing just one run, continuing a string of good performances by the Dragons bullpen.

Series Recap: Dayton 3, Lake County 3. The Dragons outscored the Captains 28-24. Dayton batted .235 in the series (.268 with runners in scoring position). They out-homered Lake County 3-2 in the series. Dayton stole seven bases in the six games and committed nine errors.

Reds Top Prospect is with the Dragons: The Dragons roster is headlined by elite prospect **Alfredo Duno**, the highest-rated prospect currently in the Reds farm system. Duno is listed as the #2 on the Reds prospect list by both Baseball America and MLB Pipeline, trailing only former Dragon Sal Stewart, a Major League player. Duno was selected as both the Most Valuable Player and Best Major League Prospect in the Single-A Florida State League in 2025 while playing for the Daytona Tortugas. Duno led the league in eight of the most important categories including home runs (18), runs batted in (81), extra base hits (52), runs (78), doubles (32), on-base percentage (.430), slugging percentage (.518), and OPS (.948). He finished second in the league in batting average (.287) and base hits (112). Duno is the top-rated prospect ever to play for the Dragons at the catcher position, surpassing future Major League stars Devin Mesoraco and Tyler Stephenson, who were Reds top-10 prospects with the Dragons but not as high on the list as Duno. Duno is the first player to play for the Dragons after winning a league MVP award the previous since Chris Valaika played with Dayton in 2007 after winning the Pioneer League MVP in '06.

- Starting pitcher J.P. Ortiz had the best ERA (2.81) in the Reds farm system in 2025 with Daytona among pitchers with at least 80 innings.
- Outfielder Kien Vu is in his first full season of pro ball after completing his college career at Arizona State, where he led the led the PAC 12 in batting as a sophomore in 2024 at .413. His OPS over his three years at ASU was 1.062 with a career batting average of .351.
- John Michael Faile is the NCAA Division II all-time career leader in both home runs (81) and RBI (337). Faile has hit 17 home runs in his Dragons career and would equal the team's career record of 30 this season if he matches his home run with the Dragons in 2025 (13).

2026 Player and Team Notes:

- The Dayton batter of the week was Ryan McCrystal (6 for 15, .400, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 1.138 OPS). Alfredo Duno and Carter Graham each hit .333 with a home run. Dayton pitcher of the week was Beau Blanchard (6 IP, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 SO, 1-0, 0.83 WHIP). Graham Osman threw five scoreless innings.
- The Dragons bullpen ERA of 2.15 leads the MWL and ranks third in MiLB (120 teams). Dragons relievers have not surrendered a lead after the fifth inning of a game this season. Overall, the Dragons rank third in the Midwest League in team ERA (3.50).
- Dragons opponents are batting just .209 against Dayton pitchers with 56 hits and 91 strikeouts in eight games.
- The Dragons have three .300+ hitters in Ryan McCrystal (.400), Alfredo Duno (.320) and Carlos Sanchez (.308).

Dragons Team Facts

The Dragons compete in the Midwest League (classified as High-A) and play a 132-game schedule (66 home games) from April 2-September 6. The MWL features 12 teams from Ohio, Michigan, Indiana, Illinois, Iowa, and Wisconsin. The Midwest League has been in operation since 1947 and has been known by its current name since 1956.

A total of 158 players that have gone from the Dragons to the Major Leagues, and another 45 Reds players have completed injury rehab assignments with the Dragons, including Jose Rijo, Joey Votto (three times), Homer Bailey, Drew Stubbs, Johnny Cueto, Aroldis Chapman, Brandon Phillips, Luis Castillo, and Jake Fraley. Twenty-four (24) former Dragons (not including players who were in Dayton only as injury rehabs) played for the Reds in 2025 including Elly De La Cruz, Andrew Abbott, TJ Friedl, Hunter Greene, Matt McLain, Tyler Stephenson, Noelvi Marte, Tony Santillan, Nick Lodolo, Sal Stewart, and Chase Burns among others.

Three members of the Reds Hall-of-Fame have served as coaches for the Dragons including Ken Griffey Sr., Chris Sabo, and Tom Browning.

Every season in Dragons history has featured a future Major League player/s on the Dayton roster. Most recently: Chase Burns in 2025; Sal Stewart and Rhett Lowder in 2024; Blake Dunn and Julian Aguiar in 2023; Elly De La Cruz, Rece Hinds, Noelvi Marte, Andrew Abbott, Connor Phillips, and others in 2022.

Attendance Leader: The Dragons finished third in all Minor League Baseball in 2025 in attendance average per game. They have ranked first in attendance at the Single-A level for each of their 25 seasons, and first among all teams below Triple-A for 19 straight seasons. The Dragons have ranked in the top-10 among all classes of the minor leagues for each of their 25 seasons.

Historically Speaking

All-Time Best Dragons: The team named their 12 Greatest Dragons in franchise history as part of last season's 25-year celebration. Those players, listed alphabetically, are Homer Bailey, Jay Bruce, Zack Cozart, Johnny Cueto, Elly De La Cruz, Adam Dunn, Todd Frazier, Hunter Greene, Billy Hamilton, Austin Kearns, Joey Votto, and Jesse Winker.

The First Season: After a 48-year absence of professional baseball in Dayton, the Dragons came to life in 2000. The first home game was played on April 27, 2000, and featured a lineup that included future Reds stars Adam Dunn and Austin Kearns.

Four Great Achievements in Dragons History:

- Austin Kearns hit home runs in eight consecutive games, July 17-24, 2000
- Billy Hamilton stole 103 bases for the Dragons in 2011, most for any player with a single team in Reds history (Major League or Minor League). Hamilton stole 155 the next season, splitting his season between two clubs, the highest total in baseball history.
- Donald Lutz hit for the cycle in reverse order (home run, triple, double, single), all within the first five innings, July 21, 2011.
- Jose Siri broke the Midwest League record for longest consecutive game hitting streak with 39 from June 22-August 3, 2017.

Basics for 2026: This is the sixth year in which the league is classified at the High-A level of Minor League Baseball. The Midwest League was a Low-A league prior to 2021. The 12-team Midwest League operates with two six-team divisions...The Midwest League will continue to utilize a Pitch Timer to encourage a quicker pace of play. Pitchers are required to deliver each pitch within a 15-second time limit (or 18 seconds with a runner on base). Defensive positioning rules require at least two infielders on each side of second base, with at least four infielders positioned on the infield dirt. Pitchers are limited in the number of unsuccessful pick-off throws they can make to a base. The third pick-off throw must result in an out, or the runner will be awarded the next base...Roster limits in 2026 are set at 30 players.
