#### **SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

TURNING UP THE OFFENSE: The Shuckers tore through July, averaging over seven runs per game and going 15-9 in the month, the most wins in any month this season... The Shuckers also outscored opponents 170-136 (+34) and scored five or more runs in 19 of 24 games in the month.

- The Shuckers 170 runs were the second-most scored in any month in franchise history (since 2015).
- Biloxi's 40 home runs marked the second-time in franchise history that the Shuckers had hit at least 40 in a month (43, July 2018).
- 📚 Biloxi's .386 on-base percentage, .510 slugging percentage and .896 OPS were the best in any month in franchise history, clearing the previous OPS record (.861 OPS, June 2022), by 35 points.

STARRING SINCE THE BREAK: Since the All-Star Break, the Shuckers have won 12 of their last 15 games, the best record out of any team in Double-A.

- Solution Post and Provided Head all of Double-A with a .302 average and a .917 OPS and are second with 26 home runs... Their .917 OPS is 43 points higher than the next best team (Wichita Wind Surge, .874).
- SOF Jackson Chourio is second among all Double-A players with a .446 average since the break and leads all Double-A players with a 1.329 OPS.

CHOURIO'S SMASHING: OF Jackson Chourio hit his team-leading 16th home run on Sunday, becoming the first teenager to hit at least 16 home runs in a Double-A season since OF Giancarlo Stanton reached the mark in 2006 with the Jacksonville Suns.

- Since July 1. Chourio is among the Southern League leaders in stolen bases (3rd. 8), AVG (4th. .388), slugging percentage (4th, .718), home runs (T-4th, 6) and OPS (6th, 1.165).
- Shourio is the first teenager to tally at least 15 home runs in a season in the high minors since INF Fernando Tatis Jr. did so in 2018 with the Double-A San Antonio Missions... Six players have reached the mark since 2005.
- Shourio enters today four home runs away from becoming the first teenager to record a 20/20 season in the high minors since **OF Delmon Young** reached the mark with the Montgomery Biscuits in 2005.

OH, HOW SWEEP IT IS: With a win on Sunday, the Shuckers earned their first six-game series sweep since July 20-25, 2021 against the Mississippi Braves... Their three straight series wins are also the longest series winning streak by the Shuckers since they won three straight series coming out of the All-Star Break in 2022.

№ Over the six-game sweep, the Shuckers outscored the Barons 51-19 (+32)... The Shuckers were among the Double-A leaders last week in runs (2nd, 54), home runs (T-2nd, 11), walks (3rd, 35), OPS (3rd, .902) and stolen bases (T-3rd, 13)... Biloxi scored at least five runs in all six games.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS (4-8, 6.41): RHP Christian Mejias makes his second start at Blue Wahoos Stadium and his 18th start of the year... In his last start, Mejias struck out five over five innings, his most strikeouts in a start since six against the M-Braves on July 2... Over his last two starts, Mejias has allowed three runs in 10.2 innings.
