ROAD WOES: The Stripers enter play still seeking their first road victory of 2025 (0-3 at CLT, 0-1 at NOR) ... Gwinnett has a -20 run differential (18-38) in the four road losses, slashing .212/.323/.336 while posting an 8.64 ERA.

BIG NIGHT FOR THE NEW GUYS: The three newest members of the lineup, **Eddys Leonard** (1-for-5, HR, RBI), **James McCann** (1-for-5, RBI), and **Alex Verdugo** (1-for-3, HR, RBI) combined to drive in three of the Stripers' seven runs last night ... Verdugo (solo off RH Cameron Weston) and Leonard (solo off LH Luis Gonzalez) each blasted their first Gwinnett homers, while McCann tallied a game-tying RBI single with two outs in the ninth in his Stripers debut ... All three players have joined Gwinnett since last Thursday.

MUST LIMIT LONG-BALLS: The Stripers led 1-0 after the first inning last night, but never regained the lead after Jud Fabian's two-run home run off **Hurston Waldrep** in the second ... Gwinnett is 0-6 (.000) when allowing a homer this season, as opposed to 3-0 (1.000) when not allowing a homer ... Last year's club went 36-61 (.371) when allowing a homer and 36-17 (.679) when allowing no homers.

WADDY STOPPED AT SEVEN: Luke Waddell saw his seven-game hitting streak snapped last night (0-for-4), but was hit by a pitch to extend his on-base streak to nine games ... On the hit streak from 3/29-4/5, he batted .444 (12-for-27, 2 2B, 4 R, 3 RBI, 1.050 OPS) ... Overall in his third season with Gwinnett, he's batting a team-best .353 (12-for-34, 2 2B, 4 R, 3 RBI, .875 OPS) in nine games.

EVERYDAY EDDY: Eddy Alvarez has reached base safely in eight of nine games to start his Stripers career, posting a team-best .476 on-base percentage ... Overall, he's batting .241 (7-for-29, 1 HR, 9 R, 3 RBI, 1 SB, .821 OPS).

UP TO NEW TRICKS: Chasen Shreve has made two starts for the Stripers this season, just the second and third of his 16-year pro career (0-1, 5.63 ERA, 1.25 WHIP, .258 BAA) ... In both outings (3/28 at CLT and 4/5 vs. NAS), he matched his career high for innings with 4.0 ... His season debut with Gwinnett on 3/28 was his first appearance with the club since 8/30/14 vs. Charlotte, a span of 10 years and seven months ... It's the longest gap between games in Gwinnett's 16-year history.

STRIDER = STRIPER: Atlanta Braves RHP **Spencer Strider** threw 75 pitches in his second rehab start on 4/4 vs. Nashville (5.1 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 SO), just his second career outing at Coolray Field (first since his Triple-A debut in relief on 9/29/21 vs. Jacksonville) ... On the 15-day IL as he recovers from 2024 internal brace surgery on his right UCL, Strider has a 1.08 ERA (1 ER in 8.1 IP), 0.60 WHIP, .077 BAA, and 15.12 SO/9.0 IP ratio in two starts this year.

SPEEDING UP THE LEADERBOARD: Luke Williams notched his first stolen base of the year on 3/30 in Charlotte ... It was the 36th steal of his Stripers career ... He had 17 stolen bases in 2023 and 18 in 2024.

TONIGHT'S START: Davis Daniel makes his first appearance and start of the season in game two of this six-game series at Norfolk ... It is his Stripers debut ... He was scratched from his first scheduled start on 3/30 at Charlotte.

• **On the Road:** In 12 road starts with Triple-A Salt Lake (LAA) in 2024, went 5-3 with a 4.36 ERA (32 ER in 66.0 IP), 1.35 WHIP, and .280 BAA.

2025 SPRING TRAINING: Made one appearance for the Braves on 2/25 at Pittsburgh, earning a save (2.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 1 SO in 2-1 win) ... Optioned to Gwinnett on 2/26.

HOME COMING: After being traded from the Los Angeles Angels to the Atlanta Braves for LHP Mitch Farris on 12/20/24, Daniel returns to his birth state ... Originally from Atlanta, Daniel went to St. James High School in Montgomery, Alabama and to college at Auburn.

2024 SEASON: Spent time with both Triple-A Salt Lake (22G, 21 starts) and the Los Angeles Angels (6 starts) ... With the Bees, went 9-7 with a 5.42 ERA (71 ER in 118.0 IP), 1.47 WHIP, .289 BAA, and seven quality starts ... With the Angels, went 1-4 with a 6.23 ERA (21 ER in 30.1 IP), 1.48 WHIP, .307 BAA, and one quality start ... His lone MLB win came on 6/27 vs. Detroit (8.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 8 SO in 5-0 victory).

MLB CAREER: Made nine appearances (6 starts) with the Los Angeles Angels from 2023-24 ... Logged three relief appearances during his MLB debut stint in September 2023, going 1-1 with a 2.19 ERA, 1.30 WHIP, and .167 BAA ... Earned his first MLB win on 9/29/23 vs. Oakland (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 2 SO in 5-1 victory).
