**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn and Aberdeen split Wednesday's doubleheader. The IronBirds took the lid-lifter in eight innings, 3-2. The Cyclones captured the nightcap, 3-2. Aberdeen took the opener on a walk-off sacrifice fly by SS **Carter Young**. SS **Mateo Gil** fell a triple short of the cycle in Game 1, registering a single in the second, a solo home run in the fourth, and a double in the sixth. In Game 2, RHP **Jonah Tong** struck out 10 over 5.1 innings of two-run ball to earn his fourth South Atlantic League victory. RHP **Joshua Cornielli** recorded the final five outs to earn his league-high-tying eighth save. The Cyclones scored all three of their runs in the nightcap on ground outs, two of which came off the bat of 2B **Junior Tilden**.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On August 1, 2010, LHP **Angel Cuan** struck out 10 over 5.2 innings, allowing two runs on three hits, en route to his fifth win in a 7-4 win at Staten Island. Brooklyn collected 14 hits that night, led by SS **Ryland Sandoval's** 3-for-5 performance. In 2013, the Cyclones erased a 4-2 seventh-inning deficit, scoring five runs in that frame in a 9-4 win at Williamsport. CF **Jonathan Clark's** two-run triple tied the game before SS **Gavin Cecchini** provided the go-ahead run-scoring single. In 2014, after allowing the go-ahead run to score in the top of the ninth, Brooklyn drew even on a CF **John Mora** sacrifice fly and walked off on an SS **Amed Rosario** RBI single in a 4-3 win vs. Auburn. In 2016, RHP **Erik Manoah Jr.** (7.0 IP), LHP **Taylor Henry** (1.0), and RHP **Joe Zanghi** (1.0) combined on a five-hit shutout in a 1-0 win vs. Aberdeen. The game's only run was scored on a 1B **Pete Alonso** double in the bottom of the fourth.

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks. After earning the win in Game 2 on Wednesday, the 21-year-old is 3-2 with a 2.48 ERA (9 ER in 32.2 IP), allowing only 24 hits and 10 walks, while striking out 50 over his last seven starts since June 20. Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit and is second among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (88). Tong is also fourth in batting average against (.219), sixth in ERA (3.36), seventh in WHIP (1.26), and tied for eighth in innings pitched (64.1). Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season. Among full-season Minor League pitchers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is first in FIP (1.97), second in strikeout rate (36.0%), fourth in strikeouts (124), and fifth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.7%).

**MORABITO BITE:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season. The 21-year-old finished with his 28th multi-hit game of the year in Sunday's win and is currently riding a five-game hitting streak since July 26, going 8-for-20 (.400) with four stolen bases. Morabito has also reached base safely in eight consecutive games since July 23, hitting .379/.471/.379 with a .850 OPS and seven swiped bags. The McLean, Va. native is seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (45). He is also three steals shy of matching OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record (37) set last year. Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (75), is second in stolen bases (34), tied for sixth in runs scored (44), eighth in batting average (.286), and 10th in on-base percentage (.366). The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (34) and seventh in on-base percentage (.366) and batting average (.286) for the season. The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.312), stolen bases (45) and on-base percentage (.408). He is also second in hits (106), tied for second in runs scored (58), and tied for third in total bases (132), fifth in OPS (.796), and tied for fifth in walks (48) and triples (3).

**LET'S PLAY TWO:** The Cyclones played just their third doubleheader of the 2024 season on Wednesday after Tuesday's postponement. After the twinbill split, Brooklyn is now 3-3 in doubleheader games this year and 1-1-1 in doubleheaders overall. The Cyclones swept a double-dip vs. Asheville on April 13, winning Game 1, 6-2, and Game 2, 3-1. On May 16, Brooklyn was swept in a twinbill at Bowling Green, falling, 1-0, in the opener, and, 7-1, in the finale. In 2023, the Cyclones were 0-4-2 in doubleheaders and 2-10 overall.

**GRAB A PINT-ARO:** RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Thursday after finishing his Cyclones tenure on a tear. Despite an 18.1-inning streak without allowing an earned run coming to a close last Sunday vs. Rome, the Pelham, Ala. native was one of the South Atlantic League's best pitchers in July. Over his five outings (four starts), the veteran held a 0.49 ERA (1 ER in 18.1 IP), with 10 hits, three hit batters, five walks, and 19 strikeouts. Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 18.0 innings of work, Pintaro was tied for third in the league in ERA (0.49), fifth in batting average against (.154), and sixth in WHIP (0.82) during the month.

**GUESS WHO'S BACK?:** The Cyclones reinstated three players off the injured list on Monday and Tuesday. INF **Jacob Reimer** was reinstated off Brooklyn's 60-day injured list, while INF **William Lugo** and RHP **Jordany Ventura** were activated from the 7-day IL. Before Wednesday, Reimer had not appeared in a game for the Cyclones this season after suffering an injury during spring training. The Mets' No. 14 prospect per MLB Pipeline and No. 22 by *Baseball America*, appeared in 11 rehab games between the Florida Complex League Mets and Single-A St. Lucie, hitting .250/.400/.313 with a .713 OPS, two doubles, and three runs batted in. Lugo missed a month after being placed on the 7-day IL on June 26. In 59 games with Brooklyn in 2024, the 22-year-old has posted a .179/.347/.296 line with a .643 OPS, 14 extra-base hits, four home runs, and 25 RBI. Ventura landed on Brooklyn's IL on May 28 and joined Single-A St. Lucie on a rehab assignment on July 21. The 24-year-old allowed one unearned run on two hits, no walks, and two strikeouts over 2.1 innings in two appearances (one start) before being reinstated.

**vs. ABERDEEN:** After a nine-game homestand, Brooklyn hits the road for its first six-game series since the All-Star break against the Orioles' High-A affiliate. The IronBirds have five of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (4), LHP **Luis De León** (13), and RHP **Michael Forret** (23). RHP **Juan Núñez** (22) and C **Creed Willems** (27) are currently on the injured list. The Cyclones went 7-5 at home against Aberdeen this year, but dropped 5-of-6 in the previous meeting at Leidos Field (June 25-30). Aberdeen leads the season series, 10-8. In 257 meetings dating back to 2002, the Cyclones led the all-time series, 134-123 (.521).

**TAKING KELLUM 123:** OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since. The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 15 games. Since July 6, he has been hitting .373/.439/.412 with a .851 OPS, seven runs scored, two doubles, and three runs batted in over the 15 games. Clark is second in the South Atlantic League in on-base percentage (.439) since that date, in addition to sitting fourth in batting average (.373) and tied for seventh in hits (19).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton. The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on Sunday and has homered in five of his last 11 games since July 13 at Wilmington. Four of those five home runs have tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead. Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fifth in the South Atlantic League with 33 stolen bases. The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen. Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (70) and is sixth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142).

**SHUT IT:** Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts lately. The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington. The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record. The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League. The Cyclones are also tied for sixth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts. Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season. The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park. The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

**IT'S SO HARD TO SAY GOODBYE:** INF **Wilfredo Lara** and RHP **Kade Morris** were both dealt by the New York Mets at the trade deadline on Tuesday. Lara was dealt to the Miami Marlins in exchange for RHP **Huascar Brazoban**, while Morris was sent to the Oakland Athletics in return for RHP **Paul Blackburn**. Lara and Morris are the first active Cyclones to be traded in-season since RHP **Carson Seymour** and LHP **Nick Zwack** were sent with former Brooklyn LHP **Thomas Szapucki** and INF **J.D. Davis** to the San Francisco Giants for 1B **Darin Ruf** on August 2, 2022. Lara appeared in 78 games for the Cyclones after being reinstated from the injured list on April 14, hitting .244/.349/.343 with a .692 OPS, 16 extra-base hits, four home runs, 29 RBI, and 13 stolen bases. The 20-year-old was on a 10-game on-base streak at the time of the trade and held a .306/.393/.403 line with a .796 OPS in 19 games during July. Morris joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20 and accrued a 4-3 record with a 3.43 ERA (22 ER in 57.2 IP), 19 walks, and 57 strikeouts in 11 appearances (10 starts) for the club. During his time with Brooklyn, the 22-year-old was third in the South Atlantic League in innings pitched (57.2), fourth in batting average against (.221), tied for sixth in strikeouts (57), seventh in WHIP (1.16), and eighth in ERA (3.43). Additionally, RHP **Paul Gervase**, a 2023 SAL Post-Season All-Star reliever for Brooklyn, was sent to the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for RHP **Tyler Zuber**. In all, the Mets traded six former Cyclones at the deadline in 2024, including OF **Rhyan Thomas** (Seattle), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (Washington), and LHP **Josh Walker** (Pittsburgh).

**IT'S A WALK-OFF:** For the third time in the homestand, the second time in the series, and the fourth time this season, the Cyclones walked off winners on Sunday afternoon vs. Rome. Down by two runs with one out in the ninth, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph. The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024. SS **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green. It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season. 3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14. The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins during the homestand on Friday, July 19, on C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on Wednesday, July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome. Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 15.38% of all defeats, including 27.27% of all road losses, while earning 11 walk-off wins. 29 of Brooklyn's 229 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.66%). The Cyclones have also earned 22 wins in their last at-bat.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. The Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), and RHP **Jack Wenninger** (30). Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list. Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Reimer (14), Tong (18), Báez (20), RHP **Galvin Ziegler** (21), OF **Nick Morabito** (24), and Wenninger (28). Ziegler is on the full-season injured list.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned a hold pitching in relief with Single-A St. Lucie last Friday vs. Palm Beach...Entered in support of RHP **Jorge De León** (1.2 IP) and LHP **Jeremy Peguero** (1.1) to start the top of the fourth inning with St. Lucie leading 2-0...Did not allow a run on one hit over 1.2 innings...Did not yield a walk and struck out one...Threw 24 pitches and 13 strikes (54.17%)...Relieved by RHP **Joseph Yabbour** with the bases empty and two out in the top of the fifth and the Mets leading 3-0...Yabbour (2.1) and LHP **Gregori Louis** (2.0) completed the three-hit shutout in a 4-0 win over the Cardinals.

**BACK TO BROOKLYN:** Ventura was reinstated from the Cyclones' 7-day injured list on Tuesday...The 24-year-old was placed on the 7-day IL back on May 28...Ventura started a Minor League rehab assignment with Single-A St. Lucie on July 21...He surrendered one unearned run on two hits over 2.1 innings in two appearances (one start)...Ventura did not walk a batter and struck out two.

**WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES:** One of the biggest changes for Ventura in the 2024 campaign has been a significant decrease in walks, in addition to an uptick in strikeouts...In 10 starts for the Cyclones in 2023, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native held a strikeout rate of 21.70% and a walk rate of 15.57%...So far this season, between Brooklyn and St. Lucie, Ventura has raised his strikeout rate by 3.63% and lowered his walk rate by 8.89%.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Ventura enters the 2024 ranked as the Mets' No. 38 prospect according to *Baseball America*...The publication considered him the franchise's No. 16 prospect in 2023, No. 19 in 2022, and No. 20 in 2021...MLB Pipeline considered the 23-year-old New York's No. 20 farmhand going into the 2023 season.

**2023:** The Santo Domingo, D.R. native began the campaign with Single-A St. Lucie...Posted a 4-3 record with a 5.67 ERA (34 ER in 54.0 IP), 50 walks, and 60 strikeouts in 15 appearances (13 starts)...Transferred to Brooklyn on July 14...Collected a 3-2 mark with a 3.86 ERA (21 ER in 49.0 IP), 33 walks, and 46 strikeouts in 10 starts for the Cyclones.

**COMEBACK TRAIL:** Ventura missed the entire 2021 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery...The right-hander returned in 2022 and made four starts between the Florida Complex League Mets and Single-A St. Lucie...However, Ventura suffered a pectoral muscle injury and was shut down for the remainder of the season.
