On this day in 2017, Joey Wendle hit his 94th career double with the Sounds, tying Skeeter Barnes for the franchise lead. Wendle scored the game-winning run in the 9th, trotting home after Mark Canha's

home after Mark Canha's walkoff single in a 3-2 win over Memphis. Wendle has the most doubles by any Sound with 102.

Be Like Trevor Kelley: After spending much of the past several months with Milwaukee, right-handed reliever Trevor Kelley pitched a scoreless frame in Nashville's win last night. In 14 outings with Nashville, Kelley has allowed just one earned run over 14.0 innings for a 0.64 ERA.

Hot Like July: After hitting a rough patch in June, the Sounds have taken their first five games of the month.

Nashville has the second-best batting average (.306) and have scored the most runs (44) and RBI (43) in the

Sweet's Managerial Watch: Rick Sweet has 196 wins as Nashville's manager, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223.

Earn It: The Nashville pitching staff leads Triple-A with a 3.74 ERA. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre checks in at second with a 3.84 ERA. The Sounds also lead Triple-A with eight shutouts.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 5 prospect, left-hander Ethan Small is the No. 8 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.

The Sounds entered the 2022 season with 4,903 stolen bases in franchise history. The team has 82 this year, good for 7th-most in the International League. The team is 15 away from 5,000 in team history.
