CAM CAULEY'S THREE HOME RUNS PROPEL RIDERS TO VICTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders pounded out 10 runs on 14 hits to down the Corpus Christi Hooks 10-5 from Whataburger Field on Wednesday night. Frisco (23-24, 61-54) found the scoreboard first in the third inning when **Aaron Zavala** laced an RBI double and **Frainyer Chavez** then added two more with a two-run double to jump the score to 3-0. Corpus Christi (18-29, 40-75) plated their first run of the game in the fourth on a Pascanel Ferreras RBI single, but the Riders answered with two in the sixth inning on a **Luis Mieses** solo homer and a Julian Brock RBI single to make it 5-1. Sebastian Walcott blasted his 12th home run of the season in the seventh, a new career best, to extend the lead to 6-1 before Frisco scored four more in the eighth. Brock drilled his second RBI single of the game, Marcus Smith added an RBI knock and Cam Cauley blasted his fourth home run in the last two games, a two-run shot, to increase the lead to 10-2. The Hooks scored three times in the bottom of the ninth, but came up short 10-5. Larson Kindreich (5-2) earned the win for Frisco, throwing 1.2 scoreless innings, while Jackson Nezuh (2-9) took home the loss for the Hooks in his start.

CAULEY'S HISTORY NIGHT:

The RoughRiders witnessed an incredible night from **Cam Cauley** against the Hooks on August 19th, when he tied a franchise record with three home runs. He tied his career-best with four RBIs as well. It was the fifth time in franchise history that a RoughRiders player has hit three home runs in a game and the fifth time in Double-A this season that a player hit three home runs in a game. He followed it up with another home run on Wednesday, giving him four home runs in the first two games of the series. In two games, he increased his season OPS from .696 to .740.

WIN, WIN AND WIN SOME MORE:

The Riders have won eight of their last nine games and 11 of their last 13 games. During their last nine games, the Riders are first in the Texas League with a 2.67 ERA as a staff allowing just three home runs. In the 13-game stretch, they are fourth in all of Minor League Baseball with a 2.26 ERA.

THAT'S ZA-BALLGAME:

Aaron Zavala walked off the Midland RockHounds with a home run on Friday night for his first walk-off homer with the Riders and second walk-off hit. In a 13-game on-base streak, he is hitting .286 (14-for-49)/.345/.531/.876 with six doubles, two home runs, 12 RBIs, three walks, nine runs scored and two steals.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ, OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

Frisco's bullpen has struggled this season, but has been great to start August. In 17 games, the Riders bullpen is second in the Double-A with a 2.53 ERA while they are 8-for-12 in save opportunities.

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of Trey Supak and Ben Anderson and the trade of Mitch Bratt, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (Josh Stephan). In the last 18 games, Frisco has a 2.49 ERA for starters which is first in the league and they're also first with a 2.34 ERA in 17 August games. Jose Corniell (15.2 IP, 0 ER), Leandro Lopez (18.2 IP, 5 ER) and David Davalillo (38.2 IP, 7 ER) have been incredible to start their Double-A careers.

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.983) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (69). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .985 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A. They have gone nine-straight games without an error (they are 8-1 in those games), the longest such streak in the Texas League this season.

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been incredible for a 19-year-old in Double-A. This season, his walk rate of 12.0 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.3 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 30 steals over 123 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.

ABOUT DAVID

-In 2021, he was signed by the New York Mets for \$30,000 as a free agent, but did not pitch. After the contract was voided, he then signed with the Rangers for \$10,000 in 2022.

-Father, David, has spent 16 seasons as an MiLB coach in the Mets organization and was named the 2019 Mets MiLB Coach of the Year as the NYM Culf Coast League manager. Both his grandfather, Pompeyo, and great-uncle, Vic, played Major League Baseball. His younger brother, Gabriel, signed with the Angels in January of 2025 as a catcher and is currently their No. 14 prospect.

2025 SEASON

- -Entered the season as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization by *Baseball America*. He also was listed as having the best curveball in the organization by *Baseball America*.
- -No. 28 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.
- -Dominated in first 10 starts in High-A Hub City, going 4-0 with 1.09 ERA while striking out 68 batters in 49.1 innings to just 11 walks.
- -Went 3-0 with 0.96 ERA over five May starts, whiffing 35 in 28.0 innings to just four walks while holding opponents to a .152 batting average against. He was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.
- -Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 4/20.
- -Struggled in final High-A start, allowing a career-high six runs over 1.2 innings against Wilmington on 6/13.

2024 SEASON

-Led all of Minor League Baseball (min. 20 GS) with a 1.88 ERA in 22 games, 21 games started. He never allowed more than three earned runs in a single outing between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.

-Was named Carolina League Postseason All-Star.

2023 SEASON

- -Made state-side debut for the Down East Wood Ducks in one start.
