LAST OUTING: Fernandez took a no decision in a start against Gwinnett on June 16. He went 6.0 innings, giving up two runs (both earned) on five hits. He totaled five strikeouts on 85 pitches (55 strikes).

AGAINST OPPONENT: Fernandez has two career appearances and one start against Memphis. He came out of the bullpen for Triple-A Omaha on August 7, 2017, earning the win for the Storm Chasers at AutoZone Park. He also started against the Redbirds on April 8. Fernandez is 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (6.1 IP/1 ER) and four strikeouts against Memphis.
