#### TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express kicks off a 12-game homestand today, starting with six games against the Las Vegas Aviators. Express RHP Aidan Anderson is slated to start up against Aviators RHP Royber Salinas. First pitch is set for 12:05 p.m. CT.

Express Manager, PR & Broadcasting Rylan Kobre handles play-by-play duties.

#### FINISHING OFF THE SERIES

Round Rock beat Albuquerque by a final of 11-1 at Isotopes Park on Sunday. Round Rock put up three runs in the top of the first inning when DH Derek Hill, CF Jose Barrero and C Andrew Knapp scored. The E-Train kept the offense going in the fourth, scoring four to increase the lead to 7-0. SS Jax Biggers brought LF Trevor Hauver and 3B Jantzen Witte home on a single before consecutive basesloaded walks by Knapp and 1B Blaine Crim resulted in two more runs. The Isotopes answered in the bottom the frame as RF Michael Toglia doubled, scoring 2B Coco Montes to cut the Express lead to 7-1. In the sixth, a Hauver base knock and a Witte double plated three more for the Express, increasing their advantage to 10-1. Hill homered in the ninth to make the final score 11-1, Round Rock.

#### AIDAN ANDERSON ON THE BUMP

Express RHP Aidan Anderson is scheduled to make his first start of the season on Tuesday afternoon. Through three relief outings, Anderson has earned one win and two saves. He has thrown 6.0 innings, has not allowed a run and has recorded eight strikeouts. The righty's longest outing of the season has been 3.0 frames.

#### **DOMINATION IN ALBUQUERQUE**

The Express took five of six games from the Albuquerque Isotopes last week. In the six games, Round Rock outscored Albuquerque, 46-18. The E-Train have won 13 of the last 14 meetings, going back to 2023, with the Isotopes and have a run differential of +63 in those games.

#### STARTERS KEEP CRUISING

After RHP Shaun Anderson went 7.0 innings on Sunday, all six starters went 5.0 innings or more against Albuquerque. The last time Round Rock posted five consecutive starts with 5.0 innings or more came August 11-27, 2019 when the Express had 12 consecutive starts of 5.0 innings or more. In 2023, the E-Train did not have a starter go 5.0 innings or more in three consecutive starts.

#### **LAST 14 GAMES**

Round Rock is 10-4 in their last 14 games. After Saturday's win in Albuquerque, the Express are above the .500 mark for the first time since April 12 when the E-Train were 7-6. Round Rock lost seven consecutive games from April 11-18. Since April 19, the Express own the second-best ERA in the PCL at 4.03 (57 ER/127.1 IP).

#### SHAUN ANDERSON SHOW

Express RHP Shaun Anderson recorded a careerhigh 10 strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched while collecting the win on Sunday in Albuquerque. He allowed one run on six hits with no walks. The 10 strikeouts broke his previous high of nine, set on April 28, 2019, when he was a member of the Sacramento River Cats (San Francisco Giants affiliate). Anderson went 2-0 against the Isotopes last week with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP).

#### **ROSTER MOVES**

Express INF Jonathan Ornelas was recalled on Monday while the Rangers take on the Athletics in Oakland. Ornelas made his Major League debut last season with the Rangers in Oakland. The righty was slashing .278/.320/.400 with the E-Train this year.

#### ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

#### **EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS**

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
